To the Honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County.

The undersigned, Citizens of Franklin County, would represent to your Honors, that there exists an uncertainty in the boundary line on the east of Brown township in said County of Franklin. We therefore respectfully pray your Honors to cause to be surveyed and located the said east line of Brown on a direct course with the commencement of said line, and with the County road as established with said line so far as the South line of Norwich township; thence to the present Southeast corner of Brown or, to such corner as may be established in accordance with a petition already in circulation; or to continue the course of the North part of said line till opposite the South line of the said township of Brown. And your Petitioners will ever pray.

Dixons Survey N. 8953 crosses the North line of Norwich Township, from thence Southwardly on the West line of Peter Pelham's Survey N. 6366 and same course continued to the South west corner of Norwich Township; from thence a direct course to the Northeast corner of P. Parvells Survey N. 5237; thence with the east line of said Survey to the Northeast corner of a lot of fifty acres belonging to Wm. Claiborne said Survey.
