To the Honorable the Commissioners of the County of Franklin Greeting.

We the undersigned Citizens of Franklin County do hereby petition to your Honorableness to give a grant for a road Commencing at a point on the Ohio Canal (Wolfs Bridge) running down said Canal to the line of Widow Wolf and Parkers land, thence due South along Said line to intersect a road in Pickaway County leading to ashbrooks Mill, hoping that you will give the above your due deliberation and the petitioners will ever pray. John Soffet, Benjamin Hoff, Wm. Rohr, Henry Plum, John Rohr, George Rohr, Charles Rohr, Wm. Miller, Betsey Hamler, Catharine Parker, C. Ombert, Adam Henry, Wm. McClish, Isaac Pensler, John Giberson, S. Hoff, N. Groom, Jacob Plum, Peter Stimmel, Alfred Thompson, Thos. Vause, Josiah Hulva, An. Boalse, Widow Wolf, Widow Rexroad,

On the petition of Samuel Hoff and others for a new County Road Commencing at a point on the Ohio canal (Wolfs Bridge) running down said canal to the line of the Widow Wolf and Parkers land, thence along said line due south to Pickaway County, line to intersect a road leading to Ashbrooks Mill,

Whereupon, The Commissioners of Franklin County appointed Francis Johnston, David Strohm and Abram Shoaf as Viewers, and William Johnston as Surveyor, and that they meet at the Office of Z. P. Thompson Esq. in the Township of Hamilton on the 3rd day of August 1842. Or within five days thereafter, and after being duly qualified according to law, proceed to view survey mark and locate said road; and a true plat and survey thereof, along with their report they return to this Office on or before the first Monday in the Month of December 1842.

Pursuant to the annexed Order I proceeded on the third day of August 1842. under the direction of Francis Johnston, David Strohm and Abram Shoaf Viewers, to make a survey and location of a new County road petitioned for by Samuel Hoff and others as follows, viz. Beginning at a point in the County road leading from Sharps Warehouse to Reeses Mill and on the east side of the ohio canal where Wolfs Bridge Crosses said Canal, from thence down said Canal S. 78 W. 13 poles to a post, thence S. 39 W. 72 poles to a post in the line dividing the land of Widow Wolf and Parkers (the half Section line) thence with Said line South 235 Poles to a post and a beech Marked 1 Mile, Same Course 320 Poles to a Post and an elm Marked 2 Miles, Same Course 318½ poles to a Stone in the Pickaway County line, whole distance 2 miles 318½ poles.

I Certify that the above field Notes are Correct as taken by me On the ground, and that the plat is a true protraction of the Same.

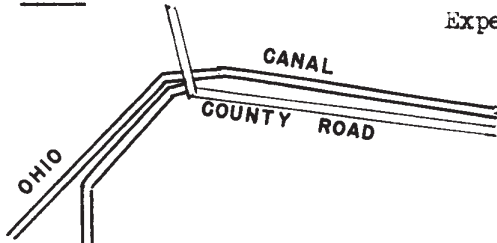
