Hayes Road - alteration in the southwest quarter of Section 32

To the Commissioners of Franklin County Ohio.

We the undersigned petitioners would represent to you that their disadvantage and ill convenience brings them under the obligation of requiring of you to use lawful measures to effect the alteration of a part of a County road in the County aforesaid Viz. Said alteration to commence at the S. E. corner of the S. W. quarter of section thirty two, Township Eleven and Range Twenty One, thence North five poles and Sixteen links; thence West to the west side of said quarter, thence South five poles and sixteen links to intersect the line of said road again, and your petitioners as in duty bound will ever ect. Frederick Bunner, Philip Pontius, Charles Pontius, James J. Needles, Parker Rarey, Charles Rarey, Moses Groom 1st Henry Bunn, Alexander Cameron, Wm. H. Rarey, George Rohr, John Rohr, On the petition of William Rarey and others for the alteration of a part of a certain county road laid out in the County aforesaid Viz. Said alteration to commence at the Southwest corner of the Southwest quarter of section thirty two, Township eleven and Range twenty One, thence North five poles and Sixteen links, thence West to the West side of Said quarter, thence South five poles and Sixteen links to intersect said Road, Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed Jacob Swisher, Jacob Weaver and J. W. Kile Viewers, and John Cox Surveyor, and that they meet at Parker Rarey's in Madison Township on the 9th day of February 1843, or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law, proceed to view, survey, mark and locate said road, and a true plat and survey thereof, along with their report they return to this Office on or before the first Monday in the Month of March 1843.

Agreeably to an Order from the Commissioners of Franklin County to us to view and survey a contemplated alteration of a part of a certain County road, Said alteration to Commence at the S. E. Corner of the Southwest quarter of section thirty two, Township eleven and Range twenty One, thence North five poles and Sixteen links, thence West to the west line of Said quarter Section, thence South five poles and sixteen links to intersect to intersect said road.

After having been Sworn according to law, we proceeded to view said alteration, and do represent, that in Our opinion Said alteration is necessary for the following reasons, Viz, It will make the road on much better ground, will do less private damage and will only increase the distance two Chains and eighty two links.
