Corner of C. Roney's farm it being the N. E. Corner of Survey No. 3009 at the Marysville road and run S. 22 E. 172 poles to two beeches at the S. E. Corner of Said survey and in the North line of No. 3010. Thence S. 5 40' W. 148 poles to 1st Mile Stake, Thence continued S. 5 40' W. 186 3/4 poles crossing Indian Run at 166 to a stake in the South line of said survey No 3010 and northerly Corner to R. Hays and M. Stultz Thence S. 10 E. Crossing post road at 10. 133 1/2 poles to 2nd Mile Stake, Thence S. 10 E. E. 128 poles to J. Hunters North line 4 poles west of his N. E. Corner, Thence S. 17 E. 20 poles to his east line, Thence S 10 E 48 poles to Corner to lands of Hunter C. Sells Avery and Smith, Thence continued 52 poles to a stake, Thence South 72 poles to 3rd mile Stake, Thence South 34 poles, thence S 10 E 38 poles to a Stake in A. Wilcox South line and corner to Smiley and Babcock, Thence with their line S 10 E 68 to County Road, Thence with the road S 10 E 63 poles to a right angle in the present road at Z. 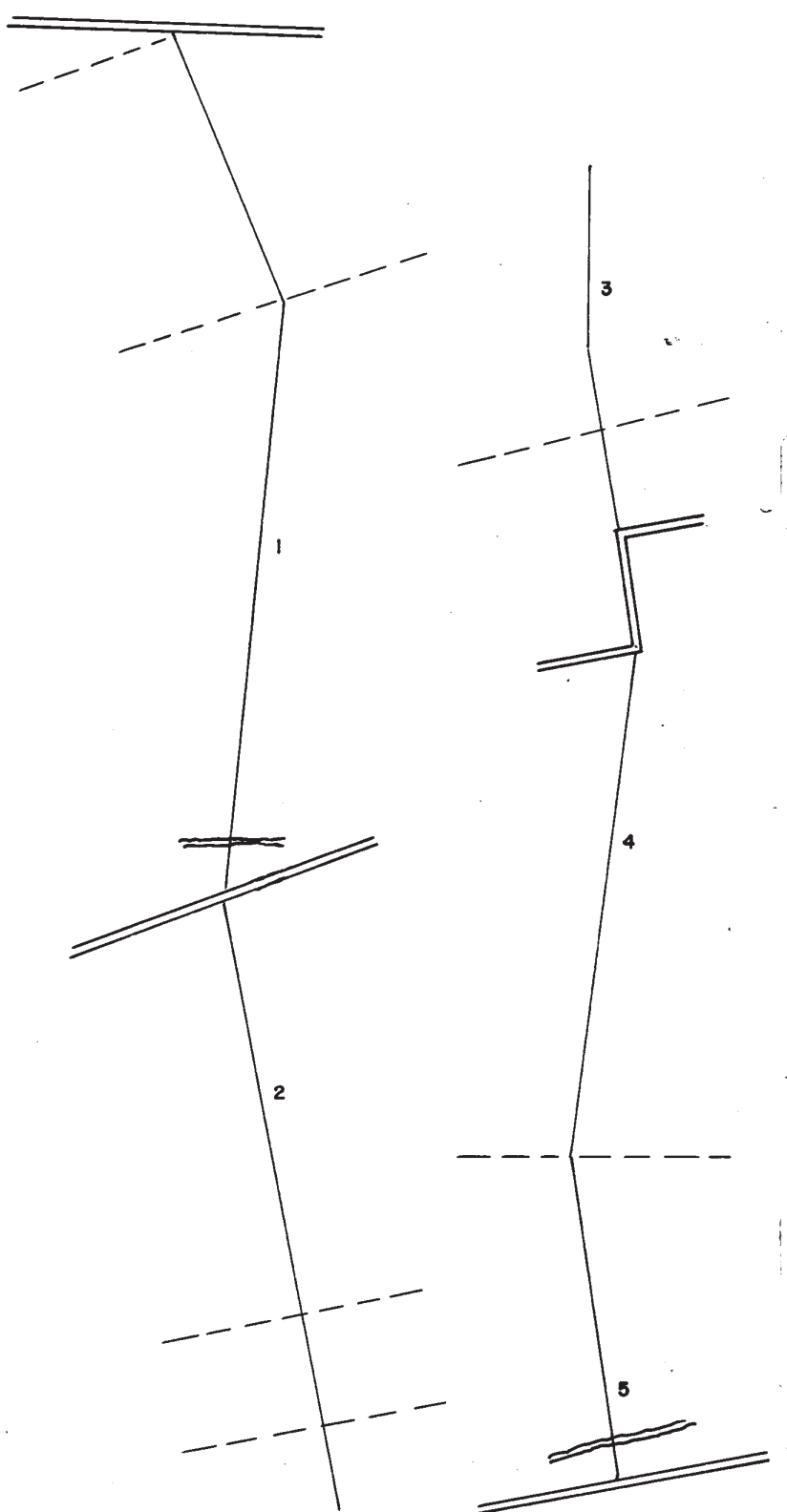
