To the Commissioners of Franklin County Gentlemen,

The undersigned petitioners would respectfully represent to your honorable body that a road would be of public utility and is much needed, running east and west through the township of Mifflin as there is at present no road leading through the township in that direction- Your petitioners would humbly pray for the location and establishment of a County road on the following ground and points (to wit). Commencing at the road leading from Columbus to Mt. Vernon on the land of John Agler late of Mifflin Township Decd. at or near his old Barn where there is now a private road running east through the farm of the said Agler, following said private road through the land of the Said Agler so as to strike the line between the said Agler's land and James Parks east tract of land, Thence East on said line to the East end of Parks land, Thence on the line between Beetly and A. B. Denune to the west line of Jesse Baughman's land, Thence south with said line to the North line of the land of John Saul, Thence East on said line to Gahanna Creek, Thence the best rout to intersect the road leading North and South On the east side of So. Gahanna Creek, near the Lutheran Church in Mifflin Township and there terminate. For which your petitioners ever Pray. Wm. McCutcheon, Ebenezer Border, K. J. Elliott, Silas Parks, James Park, John Patterson, Geo. W. Agler, Asa Bills, Henry Zinn, Peter Agler, Thomas Schrock, Fredk. Agler, James Goodrich, Henry Baughman, H. S. Holmes, Benjn. Beattey, Daniel Carr, Amos Park, Frederick Rader, John Kissinger, Philander Patterson, David Beers, Edward Dill, John Myers, Alexander Denoon, John Saul, Jesse Baughman.

On the petition of William McCutcheon and others for a new County road, Beginning at the road leading from Columbus to Blendon a few rods north of John Aglers old Barn in Mifflin Township where there is now a private family road running east through the farm of said Agler so as to intersect the line between the lands of James Parks and John Agler. Thence east with said line to the land of N. B. Denune, thence east On the line between said Denune and Benjamin Beetley to the West line of the land of Jesse Baughman, thence south with said line to the North line of the land of John Saul, thence east on the line between said Saul and Baughman to Gahanna Creek, thence East On the best ground to the road running North and South on the east side of said Creek near the Lutheran Church and there terminate

Whereupon, The Commissioners of Franklin County appointed George White Edwd. Livingston Jr. and John Barr as Viewers, and John Graham Surveyor, and that they meet at the Office of David Beers Esq. on the 20th day of April A. D. 1843. Or within five days thereafter, and after being duly qualified according to Law, proceed to view, Survey- mark and locate said road, and a true plat and Survey thereof along with their Report return to this Office on or before the first Monday in the Month of June A. D. 1843.

Personally came before me David Beers a Justice of the Peace in and for Franklin County the within named Edwd. Livingston and George White Viewers, and John Graham Surveyor and were by me duly sworn to discharge their respective duties as said Viewers and Surveyor, Given under my hand this 20th of April 1843.

Pursuant to the annexed Order on the 20th Inst. I proceeded under the direction of George Wright and Edward Livingston Jr. two of the viewers named in said Order to survey and mark the road described in said Order as follows.

Beginning in the centre of the road leading from Columbus to Blendon a few poles north of John Aglers Barn in Mifflin Township where there is now a private family road running East through said Aglers farm, and running thence East with said private road crossing small Branch at 142 and 170 poles 320 poles to a beech 1 Mile tree, Thence Continued same Course passing James Parks S. W. Corner at 60 poles and corner between A. B. Denune and Benjamin Beetly at 221 poles, and another corner between said Denune and Beetlys at 313 poles 320 poles to a beech 2 mile tree. Thence Continued Same Course 92 1/2 poles to the West line of the land of Jesse Baughman Thence with said Baughman line South 68 poles to Said Baughmans S. W. Corner, and N. W. Corner to J. Saul, thence with said Baughman and Sauls line East 159 1/2 poles to 3 mile Stake, thence Continued Same Course 42 poles to the West bank of Gahanna Creek, thence S 67 1/2 E crossing Said Creek 24 poles to a Stake in the Centre of the road running North and South on the East Side of Said Creek the place of termination, While distance 3 miles and 66 poles-
