The undersigned Citizens of said County would respectfully represent that a County road is much wanted in the north part of Said County, Commencing at the north end of a new road granted to the petition of A. Brelsford and Others at a point in the Dublin and Worthington road and to Continue to run North along or near the Section line to the north line of Franklin County. Perry Township April 11th 1843. D. 1843.

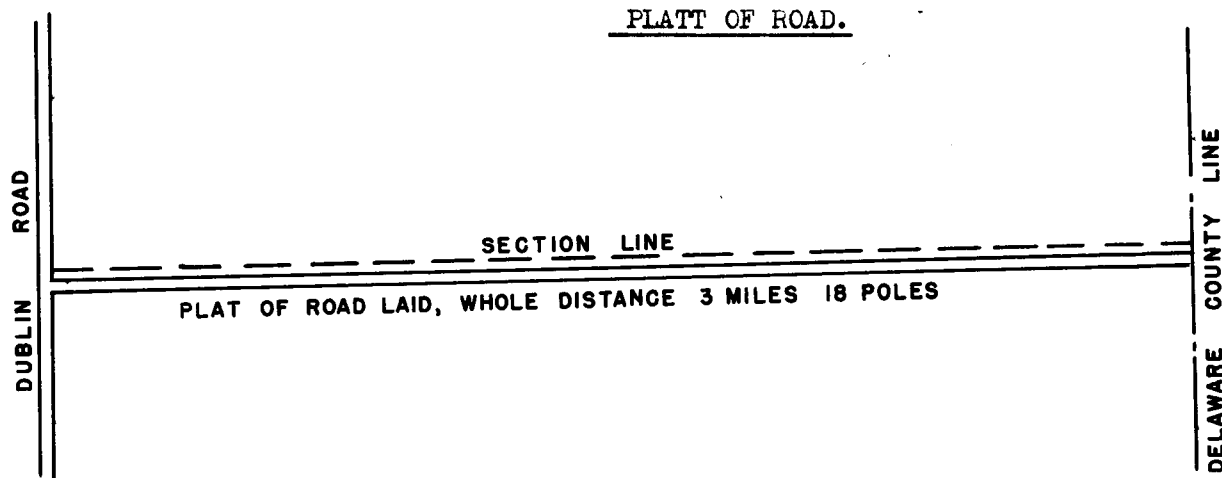
