Franklin County, Ohio, Sept. 1844.

To the Honorable Commissioners of Sd County.

We the undersigners do pray that at your next meeting, you will appoint viewers to view and lay out a county road, to commence at the north line of said county in Plain Township at the northwest corner of land owned by Peter Hoover, and the south end of a Road in Delaware County Said contemplated road to run thence South on the West line of farms owner by Peter Hoover, Christian Coons, and Cabbage Needles heirs until it intersects the road leading West to Lees Mill, Land owned joining and west of said rout by George Cramer, Jacob Bevelhymmer, and John Aispaugh, Grant our request and your humble petitioners will ever pray. George Cabbage, Peter Hoover, Jacob Kramer, Samuel Needles, Mathias Dague, James Carpenter, Christian Coons, Jacob Bevelhymmer, James Wagner, Samuel Hoover, Jacob Hoover, Samuel Horlocker, Jarvis Landon, George Kramer, Jonathan Webb, Frederick Henry, Lewis Hall, Thomas Havens, Abraham Wagner, Crin Landon, Abraham R. Shaw, Adam Bear, J. W. Koons.

On the petition of Peter Hoover and others for a new county road to commence at the north line of said county in Plain township at the N. W. corner of land owned by Peter Hoover, Christian Coons, and Cabbage Needles heirs until it intersects the Road leading West to Lees Mill.

Whereupon, the commissioners of Franklin County appointed Daniel Swickard, Noble Landon and Abraham Wagner Viewers, and Archibald Smith Surveyor of said Road, and that they meet at the Office of Isaac Williams Esq. in Plain Township on the 25th day of February 1845. or within five days thereafter, and after being duly qualified according to law, proceeded to view, Survey, mark and locate Said road, and a true plat and survey thereof, along with your report & whether the public Convenience requires that said road shall be sixty feet in width return to this Office on or before the first Monday in the month of March A.D. 1845

Plat and Survey of County Road petitioned for by Peter Hoover and others.

PLAT.

Pursuant to an order from the Commissioners of Franklin County after being qualified according to Law, I proceeded on the 25th of February under the direction of Daniel Swickard, Noble Landon and Abraham Wagner as viewers therein named to make a Survey of the ground for a road petitioned for by Peter Hoover and others as follows, viz: Commencing at the North line of Franklin County in Plain township at the N. W. Corner of land owned by Peter Hoover, thence South on the Section line, three hundred and twenty poles to the first Mile Stake, thence Same Course nineteen poles to the road leading to Lees Mill, to the place of termination Total distance One mile nineteen poles.
