PETITION OF MYRON HARD & RANNEBARGER AND OTHERS

To the Honorable Commissioners of Franklin County: Gentlemen

We the Subscribers citizens land holders of the north part of Said County, and State of Ohio, do represent to your honorable body that a county road is much needed by the citizens in that vicinity: Commencing in the State Road, leading from Franklinton to Delaware, at the northeast corner of one acre of land owner by William Newfer in Perry Township, thence westerly following the line between Tuller and said Newfer, to the north west corner of his land, then South west to the line between John Snoffer and Stephen T. Rannebarger, thence westerly along said line to the point where the road turns south westerly, then South westerly along the line between said Rannebarger and Snoffer to the gate, east of Rannebarger's house: thence south, so as to establish the road on the east end of said Rannebarger's land, and following the same Course to the north line of land owned by Myron Hard; thence Southerly to the County road leading from Scioto to Whetstone. On the petition of Myron Hard and others for a new County road commencing in the State Road leading from Franklinton to Delaware at the north east corner of one acre of land owned by William Newfer in Perry Township, thence westwardly following the line between Tuller and said Newfer to the north west corner of his land, thence southwest to the line between John Snoffer and Stephen T. Rannebarger, thence westwardly along said line to the point where the road turns south westwardly; thence Southwestwardly along the line between said Rannebarger and Snoffer to the gate east of Rannebargers house, thence south so as to establish the road on the east end of said Rannebarger's land and following the same course to the north line of land owned by Myron Hard, thence southwardly to the County road leading from Scioto to Whetstone:

Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed George Whip, Daniel Thomas, and Joseph Davis as viewers, and F. Tuller Surveyor and that they meet at the office of Allen Bowers Esq. in the Township of Perry on the 24th day of December A. D. 1845 or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law proceed to view, survey, mark and locate said road, and a true plat and survey thereof along with your report, and whether said road ought to be sixty feet wide, you return to this office on or before the first Monday in the Month of March 1846.

To the Commissioners of Franklin County: Gentlemen,

In pursuance of the foregoing order and after being duly sworn we proceeded on the 24th day of December 1845. to view, Survey and mark the line therein described, and we are in favor of establishing the Road, for the reasons that the ground is suitable to make a good road at a reasonable expense and that no one through whose land it runs will sustain any great damage and that the inhabitants living in the vicinity of the road will be greatly accomodated, and that forty feet be the width of the road.

In accordance with an order of the Commissioners of Franklin County dated December 2nd 1845. on the petition of Myron Hard and others for the location of a new county road. George Whip, Daniel Thomas and Joseph Davis being appointed Viewers and Flavel Tuller, Surveyor George Snoffer and Samuel Herd were chain carriers and Homer Tuller, Marker, and after being duly sworn, proceeded to run said road according to the directions of the viewers. Commencing in the State road leading from Franklinton to Delaware at the North east corner of one acre of land owned by Wm. Newfer in Perry Township, thence west along the line between said Newfer and F. & H. Tuller 21 rods to the north west corner of Newfer's land; thence south 45 west 2 rods, thence west along the line between Snoffer and Rannebarger to an angle post 40 rods, thence south 35 west 63 rods; thence south on the east line of the lots 176 rods; thence south 30 west 18 rods to a post marked 1 Mile, and continued the same course 20 rods, thence south along the east line of Hard's land 145 Rods to the County road leading from Whetstone to the Scioto River: the whole distance being one mile and 165 Rods- a plat of said Road is herewith, given-
