VACATION OF COUNTY ROAD IN BROWN & PRAIRIE TPS.

PETITION OF T. T. KAIN et al

To the Commissioners of Franklin County: Gentelmen,

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders and residents of said County, respectfully ask, that so much of the county roads, petitioned for by Israel Brown and others, and Thomas W. Crabb and others; be Vacated, as follows Viz: of Brown's road from the south east corner of Thomas Crabb's land, to the Amity road; and of Crabb's road, from the south east corner of Joshua Clover's heirs, land to William Brown's lane, for the following reasons; that so much thereof have become useless, on account of alterations of said roads, and your petitioners therefore respectfully ask ect. Monday March 2nd 1846. the above petition was presented to the board and laid over to the June term.

Monday June 1st. 1846: The petition of T. T. Kain and others for the vacation of parts of certain County roads, was read in open Session and laid over to the last day of the Session.

Tuesday June 9th 1846; The petition T. T. Kain and others for the vacation of parts of certain roads therein named was taken up this being the last day of the Session of the board, and it was ordered that the parts of roads, mentioned in said petition be vacated.
