Said petitioners ask for a county road commencing on the Livingston Road, at the N. E. corner of Section 27. (in Montgomery township) thence south along the Section line till it intersects the Lancaster Road: and you will meet on the 16 day of August next for the purpose of discharging the duties of your appointment.

In accordance with the accompanying Order, We the undersigned viewers therein named after first having been duly Sworn

Proceeded on the 16th day of August 1847 to view the ground along which it is proposed to Locate a county Road Commencing at the Livingston Road at the N. E. corner of Sec 27. in Montgomery Township and running South along the section line to the Lancaster Road. And having Caused the same to be surveyed and marked agreeable to Law. A Plat of which with the notes of the Survey made by the Surveyor U. Lathrop is hereunto annexed; and having taken into consideration the utility Convenience, and inconvenience and expence, which will result to Individuals, as well as to the public by the establishment of Said Road. are of the opinion that Said Road should be established and opened Sixty feet Wide. 30 ft. on the East Y 30 feet on the west Side of the said Section line.

Samuel Barr, and Bela Latham viewers therein named, I proceeded on the 10th day of August inst. after having been duly sworn to Survey and mark a county Road Commencing at the Livingston Road at the N. E. corner of Sec 27 in Montgomery Township and S 1 W. along the Section Line 320 poles to first mile stake at an oak stump Then Continued S 1 W. 320 poles to 2nd miles post near 2 Walnuts, Thence continued crossing Road at 5 poles 45 poles to the center of the Lancaster Road making the whole distance Two miles and 45 poles. Setting Stakes at the commencement and Termination of the Same and at every 80 Rods along the Line of the Road.

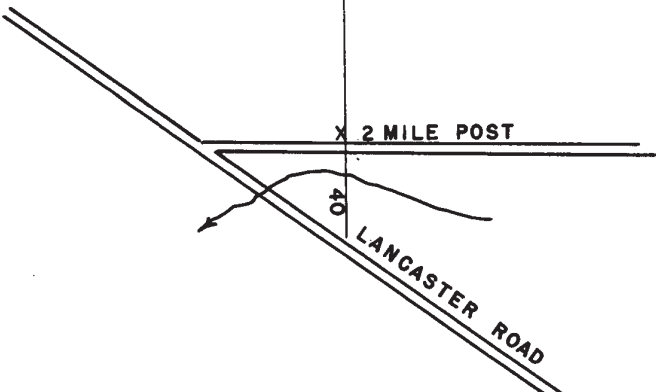

At a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of said County of Franklin held in June 1848, and on the 10th of said month, the Report of the viewers last aforesaid assessing damage, to the persons therein named was laid before the Board, and thereupon it is ordered by said Board of Commissioners that when the damages awarded in said report are paid or satisfied, and the evidence of that fact filed in the office of the commissioners, the Clerk of the Board shall issue an order for opening the same forty five feet wide, and from thence forth the same shall be considered a public highway

Sept. 15. 1849 Saml. McClelland filed in this office the receipt of all the several persons to whom damages had been assessed in the foregoing proceedings; and thereupon an order was issued for the opening of said road according to the foregoing order of the Board
