D. 1850 we have examined the ground for the alteration of roads as petitioned for by John Farber and others, Our opinion is that the prayer of the petitioners is reasonable and that said alteration ought to be made as it does not place the road on worse ground, The distance of said alteration is 112 poles and the distance of the old road is 116 $\frac{1}{2}$  poles, July 24<sup>th</sup> A. D. 1850.
