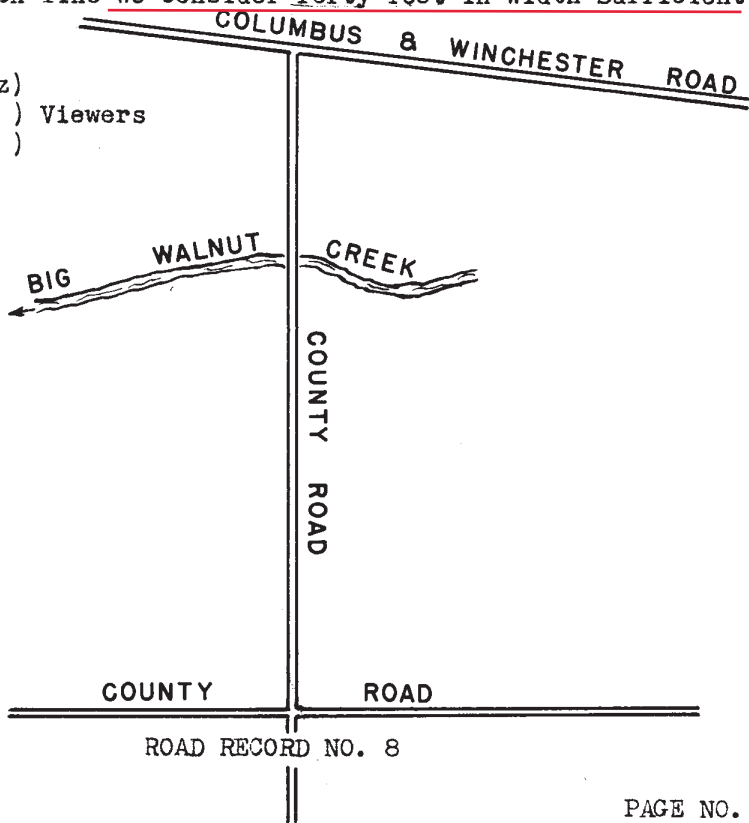

Agreeably to an order from the Commissioners of Franklin Courty Ohio, We the Undersigned Viewers After being duly Sworn proceeded to View the Route for a New County Road, Petitioned for by Jacob Miller and Others in Madison Township Beginning at the North West Corner of Section No 16. in Township No 11 of Range 21 thence North on the line dividing Section No 8 & 9 and Section 4 & 5 to where the road from Columbus to Winchester Crosses Said Section line, And we do report favor- bly to the location of Said road for the following reasons; the land is Such that A good road can be Made at a reasonable expence it extends a road already located from Groveport North and Will Connect two County roads runing East and West and Will do but Very little private damage running all the Way on a section line We consider forty feet in Width Sufficient for the Above road.
