

TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO

The undersigned freeholders of the vicinity, respectfully request your Honorable Body to cause to be laid out and established a County Road, forty feet wide as follows:

Beginning on the North line of the Columbus and Granville Plank Road, in Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Ohio, on the line of lands owned by Henry Stanbery and Isdore Fry; thence northward on said line between the lands of said Stanbery and Fry to the North line of Montgomery Township; thence northwardly through the land of Swain Pfeifer, Obed Miller vs. Campbell A. Sackey and John Ranney to some suitable point on the Road leasing from George Ridenhower's to the bridge, across Alum Creek at the farm formerly owned by George Read in Mifflin Township, January 15, 1851, Isdore Frye, Swain Pfeifer, William Rannelsbey, Richard Wall, Christian C. Heysl, William Carlocker (Germans) Samuel Barr, George Hoffner, S. Bush.

Gents:-

We have been appointed by the Commissioners of Franklin County to view and survey a route for a new County Road; beginning on the North line of the Columbus Granville Plank Road in Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Ohio, on the line of lands owned by Henry Stanbery and Isdore Frye; thence northward on said line between the lands of said Stanbery and Frye to the North line of Montgomery Township; thence northwardly through the lands of Swayne Pfeifer, Obed Miller, G. Campbell, A. Sackey and John Ranney, to some suitable point the Road leading from George Ridenhowers to the Bridge across Alum Creek at the farm formerly owned by George Read in Mifflin Township on the _____ . We will therefore meet at the place of beginning on the 8th day of May, 1851 and proceed according to the said copy of which is hereunto annexed.

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TO THE HON. THE Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio

In pursuance to the annexed order, we the subscribers having been first duly sworn according to said proceeded with Joseph F. Smith who was duly appointed as Surveyor to view and examine the ground on which it is proposed to establish the County Road described in the said order and are of the opinion that a good road may be established on said Route; Beginning at a post in the North line of the Columbus and Granville Plank Road on the line between S. Barr and Henry Gotz; thence N. 1° E. with said line and on the line between John Frye and _____ Fogle, Henry Starkey, Isdore Fry and Hoffman & Martin _____ three hundred and nine poles to the north line of Montgomery Township; thence N. 6° 30' East Eleven (11) poles to a hickory the first mile tree; thence continuing the same course through the lands of Swayne Pfeifer and Obed Miller to the line between the heirs of _____ Campbell, deceased and David Mitchell one hundred and fourteen (114) Poles; thence on said line and through the lands of the heirs of _____ Campbell, deceased and A. Lackey N. 1° East, one hundred and twenty-six (126) poles to a post in the South line of the Road leading from George Ridenhowers to the bridge across Alum Creek at the farm formerly owned by George Reed. Making the entire distance one mile and 240 poles according to the Plat of the survey made by the said Joseph F. Smith, herewith returned. We, also report that we are in favor of said road being established forth (40) feet wide. We further report that A. Sackey is entitled to twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) damage and the heirs of G. Campbell are entitled to Twn (10) Dollars damage and that Samuel Barr, Henry Sotz, Henry Stauber, John Fry _____ Fogle, Martin Coon, Isdore Fry, _____ Hoffman, Swayne Pfeifer, Obed Miller and David Mitchell are not entitled to any damages.

Edward Simington, William Bullen, Alex Moobery - VIEWERS

Pursuant to an order of the Commissioners of Franklin County and under and by direction of Alexander Moobery, E. Symington and William Bolen, Viewers being first duly sworn according to Surveyor, I proceeded to survey on the 8th day of May A.D. 1851, in accordance with the said order the following County Road.

Beginning at a post in the N. line of the Columbus and Granville Plank Road on the line between the lands of S. Barr and Henry Sotz; thence with said line N. 1° E. three hundred and nine (309) Poles to the North line of Montgomery Township; thence North 6° 30' eleven poles to a Hickory 15 inches diameter. The first mile tree; thence continuing the same course through the lands of Swayne Pfeifer and Obed Miller one hundred and nineteen Poles (119) to the line between the heirs of G. Campbell, deceased and David Mitchell; thence with said line and through the lands of the heirs of G. Campbell and A. Sackey N. 1° E. 126 Poles to a post in the South line of the Road leading from George Ridenhowers to the bridge across Alum Creek at the farm formerly owned by George Reed.
