The petitioners ask your Honorable Body to appoint viewers to locate and establish a County Road 60 feet wide in Hamilton Township, commencing as follows: At the Columbus and Portsmouth Turnpike Road on the section line, between the lands of David Williams, heirs and John McCarty's Heirs opposite the junction of the present traveled road leading from Cottage Mills to the said Turnpike Road to run the nearest and best point to intersect the County Road running east (on the same Section line) from Hanes Old Mill, and in duty bound your humble petitioners will forever pray, Adin G. You have been appointed by the Commissioners of Franklin County to view and survey a route for a new County Road in Hamilton Township: Beginning at the- Columbus and Portsmouth Turnpike Road on the section line between the lands of David Williams and John McCarty opposite the Junction of the present traveled Road leading from Cottage Mill to the said Turnpike Road to run the nearest and best Route to intersect the County Road running East on the same section line from \_\_\_\_\_ Old Mill.

TO THE HON. THE COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Agreeable to an order to us directed from your Honorable Body in answer for a new County Road; We have examined the ground and caused a location of the Road as designated by the annexed Plat and Survey; and are of opinion that said Road if established would be of Public Utility; and that 50 feet would be of sufficient width for said Road.

Caleb Racky, Jacob Fisher and Thomas Wright - Viewers

Pursuant to the annexed order I proceeded on the 22nd day of May, 1851 under the direction of Caleb Rackey, Jacob Fisher and Thoms Wirght - Viewers to make a survey and location of a New County Road petitioned for by A. Hibbs and others- as follows:

Beginning at a stake in the Columbus and Portsmouth Turnpike and on the Section line between the lادن of David Williams, heirs and John McCarty's heirs opposite the junction of the present traveled Road leading from Cottage Mills to the said Turnpike Road; from thence on said Section line East 116 poles to a stake in said Section line near the West bank of Big Walnut Creek; thence down said Creek South 3 1/2° East, 18 Poles to a stake; thence South 23° East, 18 Poles to a stake; thence South 54° East 18 Poles to a stake; thence to a stake; thence up said Creek North 22° West, 20 poles to a stake; thence North 4° West 10 poles to a stake in the section line; thence on said Section line East 100 poles to a stake in said Section line; thence leaving Section South as to pass a house and stable South 82° East 10 poles to a stake marked 1 mile, same course, 26 poles to a stake in the County Road leading from Lockbourne Road to \_\_\_\_\_ Old Mill whole one mile, 26 poles.

I certify the above field notes to be correct as taken by me on the ground and that the Plat is a line protraction of the same.
