we the undersigned citizens of Jackson township and county aforesaid respectfully ask Your Honorable body to appoint viewers to locate and establish a county road in said Township of Jackson; commencing at a point on the Franklin and Jackson Turnpike road on the line between William Brackenridge and Robert Seeds; thence running west on said line and on the line between Robert Seeds and John Brackenridge, to Geo.W.Ford heirs east line thence North on Fords line to the North east corners of said Ford's land, thence west along the line between said Fords heirs and E W Gwynne; thence between J.White and E.W. Gwynne;thence on the line between John Kivns and E W Kims and E W Gwynne and on the line between J.M.Forsts heirs and said Gwynne to the County

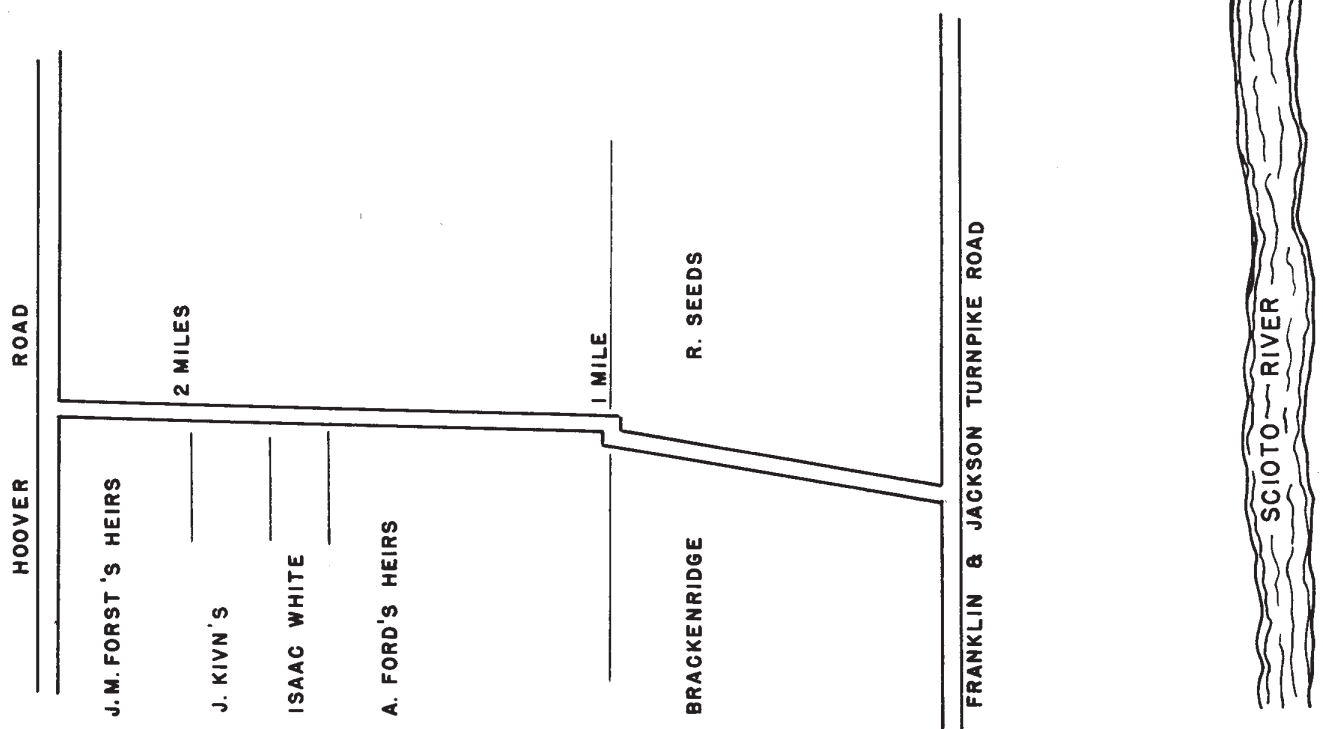
AUDITOR'S OFFICE, FRANKLIN COUNTY.

GENTLEMEN:

You have been appointed by the Commissioners of Franklin County to View and Survey a route for a new County road in Jackson Township; Commencing at a point on the Franklin and Jackson Turnpike Road, on the line between William Brackenridge and Robert Seeds -- Thence running west on said line and on the line between Robert Seeds and John Brackenridge to Geo.M.Ford's heirs east line thence north on Ford's line to the northeast corner of said Ford's land;thence west along the line between said Ford's heirs and E.W. Gwynne;thence on the line between I.M.Forst's heirs land, said Gwynne to the County road known as the Hoover road.

You will therefore meet at Wm.Brackenridge on the 14th day of February A.D. 1852 and proceed in the premises according to law, a copy of which is hereunto annexed. Yours respectfully,

Pursuant to the annexed order I proceeded on the 14th day Feb.A.D.1852 under the direction of John Lisle, Wm.F. Johnson and Hamilton Chain, viewers, to make the following survey of the road set forth in said order, Beginning at a post in the line between Wm.Brackenridge and Robert Seeds where the Franklin and Jackson Turnpike road crosses said line from which a double black walnut bears No. 89°- W 56 line distant-- Thence N 77°-W 290 poles to a post in said line;thence N 26°-W 8 poles to a post in the line of G.Ford's heirs land and Gwynne, near a burr oak- thence with said line N 89°-W 22 poles to a Post one mile from which a burr oak 12 in.Dia. bears N 26-1/2°-W 26-1/4 links distant; thence with said line N 89°-W 212 poles and 17 links crossing a Branch a 118.154 and 193 to a Hickory N.W. Cor. of G.Foru's heirs lands; thence N 87°- W passing N.W.Cor. of Isaac White's land at 45-1/2 poles, 107 poles and 8 links to two mile post in the north line of John Kious land; continued N 87°- W 3 poles and 23-1/2 links to a Stake and Stone N.E.Cor. of John Ford's heirs land. Thence with their north line and Gwynne South line N 85°-10' W 90 poles and 9 links to a post in the Hoover road N.W. Cor. of John Forst's heirs land, total distance run two miles and 94 poles and 6-1/2 links.
