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J. McELLIOTT'S ROAD IN BROWN TOWNSHIP

TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY:

The undersigned, petitioners, would respectfully represent to your honorable body that a County road is much wanted to correct the following named point- and to accomodate the intermediate settlers; Viz: Beginning at the corner of John Helser's and D. C. Vanshock, in the County road leading from Smiley's to Fuller's Mill, thence with their line to their north corner, thence N. 40-1/2°-W to the south east corner of Alex. McC Elliotts' land, thence with their line N. 36°-W to his northeast corner, continuing the same course through the lands of John Stephenson to the County road that leads past Francis Hoachard's. We would requested that Viewers -- may be appointed and the legal steps taken to make this a County road, and your petitioners will ever pray, &C. October 29, 1853.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we A. McC. Elliott and Thomas C. Elliott, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the just and full sum of one hundred dollars, the payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, &C, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Witness our hands and seals, the sixth day of December, in the year 1852.

The condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas the above bound A. McC. EL LIOTT has this day petitioned the County Commissioners for a new County road, beginning at the corner of John Helser and D.G. Vanskock, in the county road leading from Smiley's to Fuller's Mills, thence to the County road that leads past Francis Hockard's.

Now if the said A. McC. Elliott shall succeed then this obligation to be void and of no effect, other wise to remain in full force in law.

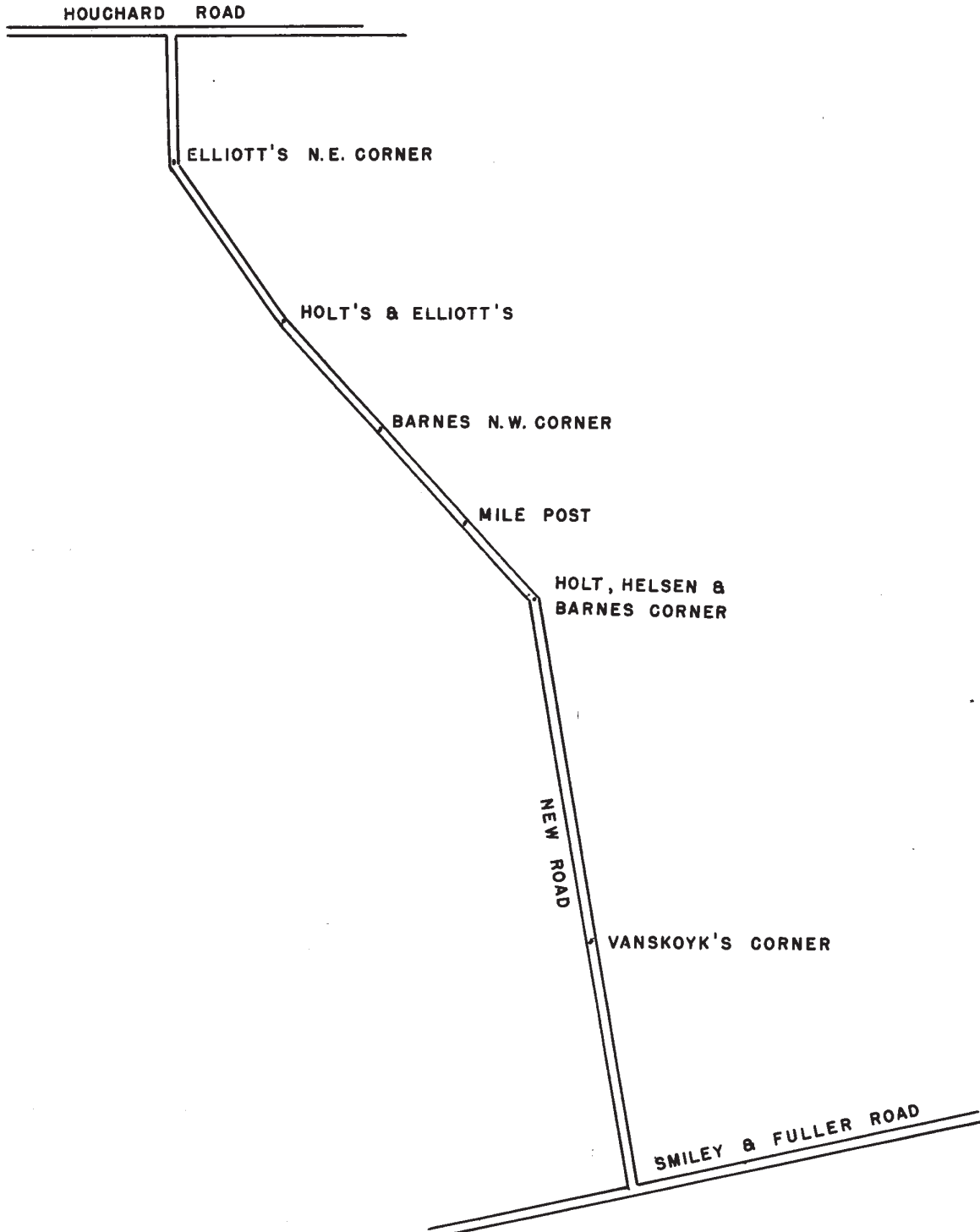

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Pursuant to an order from the Commissioners of Franklin County on the application of Alexander McC. Elliott and others for a new county road in Brown township I proceeded on the 25th day of February A.D. 1853, after being duly sworn according to law, under the direction of Daniel Wright, Benjamin Sells and Samuel S. Davis, Viewers, to make a survey and location of said road as follows Viz: Beginning at a stone in Smiley and Fuller Road, at the south corner of John Helser's and D. G. Van-Koyh's land, and running thence N. 9°-45' W. along their west line 113-1/2 poles to their N.W. corner continuing the same bearing and direction 280 poles in all to a corner common to Holt, Helser and Barnes, thence N. 40°-30' W. 40 poles to a mile post, continuing same bearing and direction passing Barne's N.W. corner at 102-1/2 poles and 153-1/2 poles in all to Holt's and Elliott corner, thence N. 36°-W. 104 poles to the said Alexander Elliott N.E. corner thence through the land of John Stephenson (bearing from that named in the order changed by consent of said Stephenson) N. 0°-30' W. 53 poles to a post in the road leading past Francis Houchard's. Distance 1 mile, 272 poles.
