Seeds and Wm. Seeds, \_\_\_\_\_ line; thence on the line between said Seeds and K. Seeds to the County line between Pickaway and Franklin Counties.

We the undersigned petitioners, respectfully ask the Hon. Commissioners of Franklin County, to grant them a County Road; commencing at South end of the Hoover Road; thence South on the lines of John Martino and Isaac Miller to the line between Shaclet Mitchell and Jonathan Lee, thence South on their said line between said Mitchell and Lee to James Cary and Jane Seeds line; thence on the line between said Cary and Seeds to W.W. Seeds and Wm. Seeds Sr. line; thence on the line between said Seeds and Kenneth Seed's line, to the County line between Pickaway and Franklin Counties to meet a road that is petitioned for in Pickaway County to intersect the Harrisburg Road at John Craw's N.E. Corner.
