Know all men by these presents: That we Phillip Haughn and H. S. Mitchell are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio for the use of Franklin County in the just and full sum of one hundred dollars, the payment which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, vx. jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Witness our hands and seals, the 7th day of March, in the year 1853.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the above bound Philip Haughn has this day petitioned the County Commissioners for a new county Road in Jackson Township.

Now if the said Philip Haughn shall succeed, then this obligation to be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force in law.

You will therefore meet at the house of Philip Haughn, in Jackson Township on the 3rd day of May, 1853, and proceed to view and survey the same and make return of your proceedings according to law.

Surveyor's Plat and Report.

Pursuant to the annexed order, I proceeded on the 3rd day of June A.D. 1853, under the direction of Jacob Stimmel, Wm. S. Miner and Adam F. Miller, viewers, to make the following survey of the Road set forth in said order; Beginning at a stake S.E. corner of Jos. Martino's land; in the County Road known as the Lee Road, thence N. 1° 35' E. 310 poles and 20 links to a stake in the Cottage Mills Turnpike Road from which a White oak 30 in. diameter bears S. 67° W. 101 links distant total distance run 310 poles and 20 links.
