KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, Wm. F.Havens and D.W.Brooks, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio for the use of Franklin County in the just and full sum of One Hundred Dollars the payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, &c, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Witness our hands \_\_\_\_\_ seals this 2nd day of June, 1863.

The condition of this obligation is such, That whereas the above bound Wm.F.Havens and D.W.Brooks has this day petitioned the County Commissioners of Franklin County to establish a new County Road to commence at the West side of Licking County near Cooks Heirs South East Corner, running thence west to Reeses Mill, and their ending. Now if the said Wm. Havens shall succeed in his said petition, - then this obligation to be void and of no effect; otherwise to remain in full force in law.

R E P O R T .

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY:

The undersigned, Joseph Edgar, Samuel Keelar, and Henry M. Alberry, appointed Viewers by your order of June the 8th, 1863, to view, survey and assess the compensation or damages by reason of establishing a certain County road, to wit: Commencing at the west line of Licking County near the land of Wm. Cooks Heirs South East corner, running thence on west to Reeses Mill and thence ending, made the following report. As there was no written claims filed with us for damages, none were by us assessed. We have determined that the public convenience does not require the road to be more than 30 feet wide.

SURVEYORS REPORT.

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TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned Uriah Lathrop in obedience to your order dated June 8, 1863, and directed to Joseph Edgar, Samuel Keelar, and Henry Alberry, Viewers, and myself as Surveyor, proceeded in company with and under the direction of said Viewers, having first been sworn according to law, and taking to my assistance Charles Lathrop and A.Fravill as chainmen, and John Havens as marker, and administered to them the proper oath, proceeded to survey and mark the road as directed by said Viewers as follows, to wit: Beginning at a stake in the line between Licking and Franklin Counties witnessed by an elm 15 inches in diameter, bearing S. 84°-30 W. 6 rods and 15 links and a white oak 8 inches in diameter bears N. 19°-30' W. 34 links and run N. 88°-W.320 poles to 1 mile post. Thence N. 87°-45' W. 160 Rods crossing the County road at 10 poles; thence N. 88-1/4 W. 760 poles to 2nd mile post; thence N. 88°-30' W. (crossing) Black Lick at 80. Sec. line at 160-196 poles to a stake; thence N. 34-1/2 W. 20-1/2 poles to John Haven South line; Thence N. 88-1/2 W. 103-1/2 poles to 3rd mile Post. Thence S. 88-1/2 W. crossing the Township Road at 72-1/2, 187-1/2 Poles to S. and S. mans corner; thence North 57 W. crossing Rocky Fork at 44- 59-3/4 Rods to termination in the County Road leading to Bahanna, making a total distance of 1207. 25 poles or 3 miles and 77/100 of a mile as will more fully appear by reference to the plat and field notes hereto attached, and here by made a part of this report. And I hereby certify that said plat is a correct representation of said road from actual survey made on the ground on the seventh day of July, 1863. Respectfully submitted,
