ROAD NOTICE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That there will be a petition presented to the Com's of Franklin County, O., at thier next Regular Session. For the Alteration of the Columbus and Dublin Road, on the west side of the Scioto River. Commencing in the center of the road near the North -east vorner of Asa Davis Orchard; thence northerly east of L.D.Sullivan's House on the most suitable land for the road until it intersects the said Columbus and Dublin at the Bridge built by J.D.Hall, on said line of road in Norwick Township

TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

We the undersigned citizens of Franklin County, O., ask for the following alteration to be made in the Columbus and Dublin Road running on the west bank of the Scioto River, to-wit:

Commencing in the center of the road near the North-east corner of Asa Davis' Orchard. Thence northerly running east of L.D.Sullivan's Residence on the most suitable land for the proposed road until it intersects the said road, (as recently established) at the bridge built by J.D.Hall on said recently established road in Norwick Tp.

That we Asa Davis are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio for the use of Franklin County in the just and full sum of One Hundred Dollars the paymnet of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs etc etc jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Witness our hands and seals this 5th day of December, A.D.1870

THE CONDITION OF THE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That Whereas the above bound Asa Davis, has this day petitioned the County Commissioners of Franklin County, O., for the alteration of the Columbus and Dublin Road on the west side of the Scioto river, Commencing in the center of the road, near the north east corner of Asa Davis Orchard. Thence northerly, east of L.D.Sullivan's house, on the most suitable land for the road until it intersects the said Columbus and Dublin road at the Bridge built by J.D.Hall on said line of road in Norwick Township.

Now, if the said Asa Davis shall succeed in his said petition, then this obligation to be void and of no effect; otherwise to remain in full force in Law.

VIEWERS REPORT.

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned Viewers of a County road petitioned for by Asa Davis and others submit the following report:

That in pursuance of the order issued to them they with Josiah Minnear the Surveyor of said road met at the time or within the time limited for holding the view, to-wit; at Asa Davis on the 27th day of December, A.D.1870 at 12 o'clock A.M. , and being sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their duties of their appointments. That they selected Daniel Slyh and William Delashman as Chain Carriers and Hirman Richards Marker, who were sworn to discharge the several duties of their appointments. That they fixed as the initial point of said road a stake in the center of the old road and terminus of the B.Sells alteration of Columbus & Dublin Road. Thence laid out said or alteration and caused the same to be surveyed along the following described route, to-wit:

Beginning at the above named stake. Thence N 17 1/2 W through the lands of Asa Davis, Michael Walton and L.D.Sullivan's to a stake. Thence N. on said Sullivan's, Samuel Wilcox and Brunks Heirs land, to the center of the Bridge on the north side of the Brunks house in the Sells Road, being as near the route proposed by the petitioners, as in the opinion of the undersigned, a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and expense, which will result to individuals as well as the public. If said road or any part thereof should be established.

That they are of the opinion that said road ought to be established because the publics Convenience requires it and that a good road can be made along the line surveyed at a trifling expense and labor.

They are further of the opinion that the public Convenience will be fully subserved if said road is established sixty feet in width.

AND BE IT REMEMBERED, That on the 6th day of March, A.D. 1871 it being the 1st day of their Regular Session, the Commissioners read the foregoing Viewers & Surveyor's Report for the 1st time, and that on the second day of their regular March 7th the Viewers & Surveyor's report was read the second time.

AND BE IT REMEMBERED, That on the 8th day of March A.D. 1871, it being the 3rd day of their Regular Session. The Commissioners of Franklin County read the said report the 3rd time and being satisfied the law had been complied with in all respects. The road was ordered to be established by the Petitioners paying all damages and assuring all damages by reason of said alteration in any Bridge Contracts or previous to said alteration, and petitioners to build all bridges on said new alteration.

VACATION OF ROAD.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN. A petition will be presented at the next Regular Session of the Board of County Commissioners, Franklin County, signed by twelve freeholders of said County, praying for the Vacation of a portion of a certain road in Madison Township in said County.

The portion of the road which the petitioners will ask to have vacated, commences at a point on the Columbus and Canal Winchester Turnpike and runs thence in a southwesterly direction through the lands of George W. Needles and John W. Kile until it intersects a road recently opened and established on petition of John McGuffey and others. The reason assigned for the vacation of said road is that it has become unnecessary to the public convenience.
