

From Commissioners Minutes, March, 5th, 1878
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The Viewers report on the vacation of a road petitioned for by Frank Lee & others in Blendon Tp., was taken up and read the third time. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that said road has become useless, and no objection being made it was ordered that the road as described in the said petition, viz: As beginning at Nash & Gillispies Distillery and ending on the road from Scotts to Duncan Plains, so much of it as is included from their North line to six rods east of their dwelling in Blendon Tp., as aforesaid, be and the same is hereby vacated. And the Auditor ordered to notify the Trustees of said Tp., of these proceedings.

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WARRANTY DEED.

GEORGE W. & MARY A. MATTHEWS

to

COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY---

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WE George W. and Mary A. Matthews, of Franklin County, State of Ohio, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid by the Commissioners of Franklin County, State of Ohio, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey to the said County Commissioners for the use of a Public and County road, in place of the old one to be vacated; described as follows: Beginning in the center of the Dublin road on the east side of the Scioto River, Perry Tp., Franklin County, Ohio. Thence S. 61 1/2° E. to a stake on George W. Matthews farm, witnessed by a Black Walnut tree; bears N 21 1/4° E. 58 1/2 feet distant; thence S. 35 1/2° E. 506 feet, to a Hickory stump witnessed by a Black Walnut bears N. 78 1/4° W. 31 feet distant; thence S. 27 1/2° E. 521 feet to a stake. Thence S. 21 3/4° E. 144 feet to a stake; thence S. 14° E 325 feet to a stake in the old traveled road, witnessed by a Blk Walnut bears S. 45 1/2° E. 62 feet distant. The above described line to comprise, twenty five feet on each side, in width, for the use and benefit of the public in common, for a public highway, (or County road)

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the only proper use for a public road as aforesaid.

AND THE SAID George W. and Mary A. Mathews for themselves and for their heirs, executors and administrators, do hereby Covenant with the said County Commissioners, and their successors in Office, that we are the true and lawfull owners of the said premises, and have full power to cinvey the same; that the Title so conveyed, is Clear, Free and Unincumbered; and further; that we will Warrant and Defend the same against all claim, or claims, of all persons, whomsoever for the purpose aforesaid.
