In obedience to your order issued at your December Session,A.D.1872 and as reappointed Feby.15,1873, we,the undersigned,Viewers,appointed under said order,met with Jno.Courtright Surveyor at David Peters House on the 24" day of February,A.D.1873,and were severally sworn to discharge faithfully and impartially,the duties required of us in said order.

John M.Briggs and Jesse Alkire were selected by us as chain carriers and J.K.Lowe as marker,who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed County Road on the line described in your order and caused the same to be surveyed as prayed for in the petition,or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense,taking into consideration the utility,convenience,and inconvenience,and expense,which will result to individuals as well as the public,by the establishment of said road,as follows:
