VIEWERS REPORT.

TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Gentlemen: The undersigned Viewers, of a County Road petitioned for by Wm. Wagner and others, the true course and place of beginning which has become uncertain; respectfully report. That in pursuance of the order issued to them, they with Josiah Kinnear, Surveyor, met at the time and place, or within five days thereafter, specified in said order, to-wit:

At A. Smith's on the 27th day of June A.D. 1873, at 10 o'clock A.M., and being first duly sworn, proceeded to the discharge of their duties of their appointment. That they selected and took to their assistance, David Hand, and Newton Smith, as chain Carriers, and Reuben Miller as a Marker, who were also sworn to discharge the several duties of their appointments. That they fixed as the initial point of said road, a stone in the county line, common corner to J. Kittsmiller and Mrs S. Evans. Thence with the section line North 88° 20' W. 163.90 poles to a stone witnessed by a Locust tree bears N. 58° E 55½ links distant. Thence N. 88° W 116 poles to a stake in a county road, witnessed by N.W. Corner of Brick School House, which bears S. 33½° E. 2.74 poles distant. Said line passing along the lands of J. Kittsmiller, Mrs S. Evans, J. Daily, C.W. Hands, W.D. Strait, A. Smith and T.W. Evans, being the route assigned to said road by the original Viewers, and that they caused the course of said road to be correctly surveyed, and that distinctly marked throughout, as required by law. Having viewed and surveyed said road, The whole distance, we find that the same is now used and travelled is on the line assigned to it by original viewers, and therefore we do not deem it necessary to make further report, in relation thereto.
