VIEWERS REPORT..

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order, issued at your June session, A.D. 1874, we, the undersigned, Viewers, appointed under said order, met with John Courtright Surveyor, at James Wilcox on the 12th of June, and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

Noah Orr, John Dunn and R.Z. Seeds were selected by us as chain carriers, and Samuel Davis, as a marker who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience, and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the establishment of said road, as follows:

Beginning at a stone in the center of the Amity Road it being the N.E. corner E. Douglass farm & the S.E. corner of F. Forney's farm & in the west line of James Wilcox farm. Thence N. 7° W. 80 poles to a stone; thence N. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 80.52 poles to a stone, the N.E. Corner of F. Forney farm & the S.E. corner of A.M. Forney farm & in the west line of James Wilcox farm. Thence N. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 76.32 poles to an Ash tree the N.E. corner of A.M. Forney farm & the S.E. corner of John Westerweller farm & in the west line of James Wilcox farm; thence N. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 803.16 poles to a stake marked one mile. Thence N. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 0.44 poles to a stone, the N.E. Corner of John Westerweller's farm, it being a corner to James Wilcox farm; thence through James Wilcox farm N. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 49.72 to the S.W. corner of George McCann's farm it being a corner to James Wilcox; thence N. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W 26.92 poles to a stake the N.E. corner to James Wilcox farm it being a corner of said George McCann farm, terminus of said road. Total length One Mile & 80.08 poles.

We would respectfully report that the said Road ought to be granted for the following reasons; that the public convenience require a Road on said line.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such a County road shall be established forty feet in width. All of which is respectfully submitted.
