NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That a petition will be presented to the Commissioners of Franklin County, at the next session June A.D.1883, praying for the Location of a County Road on the following line, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the county road on the line between Clinton and Marion Twps. and at the northeast corner of lands owned by T.E. Miller and John Joyce. Thence southward on the line between the land of T.E. Miller, John Joyce, A.W. Green, D. Gray and Jacob Bliss on the west and Wm. Monpeny & W.W. Bliss on the east. Then continue southward through the land of Theodore Leonard to Leonard Ave., at the Rail Road.

FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN MARION TOWNSHIP.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said County, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the location of a County road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to locate and establish such road, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the county road on the line between Clinton & Marion Twp and at the northeast corner of land by T.E. Miller & John Joyce. Thence southward on the line between lands of T.E. Miller John Joyce, A.W. Green, D. Gray & Jared P. Bliss on the west and Wm. Monypeny and M.W. Bliss on the east. Thence continue southward through the land of Theodore Leonard to Leonard Avenue at the rail road crossing.

The Commissioners met in regular session at the Auditor's Office, and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Now comes John Joyce one of the signers of the foregoing petition, and files his bond which is in the words and figures following, to-wit:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John Joyce and J.P. Bliss are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the penal sum of One hundred Dollars, for the true and faithful payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated at Columbus this 4 day of June 1883.

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION ARE SUCH, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Franklin County for the location of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the County road on the line between Clinton and Marion Tps., and at the northeast corner of lands owned by T.E. Miller & John Joyce and northwest corner of 17 Acres owned by Wm. Monpeny. Thence southwardly on the line between T.E. Miller & Jno. Joyce, A.W. Green, D.S. Gray and Jared P. Bliss on the west and Wm. Monypeny and W.W. Bliss on the east. Then continue southwardly through the lands of Theo Leonard to Leonard Ave., at the R.R. Crossing in Marion Tp.

Now, if the said applicant shall pay into the treasury of the said county, the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.

Which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that the foregoing petitioners have fully complied with the law in regard to said petition, it is ordered that J.M. Montgomery, C.W. Hess and D. Matheny three disinterested freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and B.F. Bowen Sur-

veyor of said County Road and that they meet at Scraped Factory on the 17 day of Aug. at ten o'clock A.M.. and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further ordered, that the County Auditor issue the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor, and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this Board, at its next regular session.

Whereupon the County Auditor issued to said Viewers and Surveyor the following order, viz:

Gentlemen: You were appointed by the County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to view and lay out a proposed County Road on the following route, as petitioned for by John Joyce.

Beginning at an iron pin in the Center of the County road on the line between Clinton & Marion Tps. And at the northeast corner of lands owned by T.E.Miller & Jno. Joyce and northwest corner of 17 Acres owned by Wm.Monypeny. Thence southwardly on the line between T.E.Miller, Jno.Joyce, A.W.Green, D.S.Gray, & Jared P.Bliss on the west and Wm.Monypeny & W.W.Bliss on the east. Thence continue southwardly through the lands of Theo Leonard to Leonard Ave., at the R.R.Crossing in Marion Tp.

You will therefore meet on the 17th of August at the place designated as the beginning of said road, or alteration, and after taking an oath or affirmation, faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of your appointments respectively, you shall take to your assistance two suitable persons as Chain Carriers, and one Marker, and proceed to view, survey and lay out said road, or alteration, as prayed for in the above petition, or as near the same as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense; taking into consideration the utility, convenience and inconvenience, and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public. And said Viewers shall, in addition to their duties as Viewers, also at the same time assess and determine the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages sustained by any person or persons through whose premises the road is proposed to be established; and the said Viewers shall make and sign a report in writing, stating their opinion in favor or against the establishment or alteration of said road, or any part thereof, and set forth the reasons of the same; which report, together with the plan and survey of said road or alteration, shall be delivered to the County Auditor by one of the Viewers on or before the first day of our session in Sept. next. Said Viewer shall also determine the width of said road, which cannot be more than 60 feet wide.

AND FURTHER, it shall be the duty of the Viewers aforesaid, at the same time at which they are required to make their report of the view, to make a separate report in writing, stating the amount of the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages, (if any,) and to whom, which by them have been assessed, and be further governed in their proceedings under this order by the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided.

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SURVEYOR'S REPORT.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned in obedience to your order dated June 5, 1883, proceeded, on the 17 day of Aug. to survey and mark the County Road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

Beginning at an iron pin in the County Road on the line between Clinton & Marion Tps. and northwest corner of a 17 Acre lot owned by Wm.Monypeny. Thence on the line between the land of said Monypeny, Jared P.Bliss and Theo Leonard on the east & T.E.Miller, Jno.Joyce, A.W.Green and D.S.Gray and the hrs of Jno.McNutt and the P.C.& St.L.R.R.Co., S 3 W 2130 ft to the center of said R.R. Then continue same course about 100 feet to the center of Leonard Ave. near the Scrapper Factory.

The above described line is intended for west line of the road, and all of the road is taken off of the lands of Monypenny & Bliss & Leonard, all of which is more clearly shown on the plat hereunto attached and made a part of this report.

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REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order, issued at your June session, A.D. 1883, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with B.F.Bowen Surveyor, at Scrapper Factory on 17, Aug. 1883 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

The Mechanical part of the survey was dispensed with for the reason that the said Bowen had very recently surveyed the same line, fixed the corner and measured the distance.

We then proceeded to view said proposed County Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the location of said road, as follows: Beginning at an iron pin in the County Road on the line between Clinton & Marion Twps., and at the Northwest corner of a 17 Acre lot owned by Wm.Monypeny. Thence southwardly on the line between said Monypeny, Jared P.Bliss and Theo Leonard on the east and T.E.Miller, Jno Joyce, A.W.Green & D.S.Gray, the hrs of Jno. McNutt and the P.C.& St.L.Railway Company on the west to Leonard Avenue near the Scrapper Factory. The land line above described is intended for the west line of the road. And the full width of the road is to be taken off of the lands of Wm.Monypeny, Jared P.Bliss and Theo Leonard.

We would respectfully report that the said County Road ought to be established for the following reasons: That a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, and that said road will be a public convenience.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such Co.Road shall be established sixty feet in width.
