ROAD PETITION.

FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN PLAIN TOWNSHIP.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said County, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the establishment of a County road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to establish such County road, to-wit: Beginning at the Johnstown Road on the line between the lands now owned by Alexander Doran and Jacob Clouse and running thence North to the County line between Delaware and Franklin Counties, be made a County Road thirty (30) feet wide.

Your petitioners therefore ask that such proceedings may be had as are authorized and required by law for the same.

The Commissioners met in regular session at the Auditor's Office, and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Now comes Jacob A. Bevelhymer one of the signers of the foregoing petition, and files his bond which is in the words and figures following, to-wit:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Jacob A. Bevelhymer, John and David Barnhard are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the penal sum of One Hundred Dollars, for the true and faithful payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated at Columbus O, this 7th day of December 1885

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION ARE SUCH, that whereas application has been made to the board of Commissioners of said Franklin County for the establishment of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Beginning at the Johnstown Road on the line between the lands now owned by Alexander Doran and Jacob Clouse and running thence North to the County line between Franklin and Delaware Counties.

Now, if the said applicant shall pay into the treasury of the said County, the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.

Which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that the foregoing petitioners have fully complied with the law in regard to said petition, it is ordered that Timothy Ryan, Wm. A. Stygler and Rufus S. Clark three disinterested freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and Josiah Kinnear Surveyor of said County and that they meet at New Albany on Friday the 8th day of Jan'y 1886 at ten o'clock A.M., and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further ordered, that the County Auditor issue the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor, and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this board, at its next regular session.

Whereupon the County Auditor issued to said Viewers and Surveyor the following order, viz:

Gentlemen: You were appointed by the County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to view and lay out a proposed County Road on the following route, as petitioned for by Jacob A. Bevelhymer, et al.

Beginning at the Johnstown Road on the line between the lands now owned by Alexander Doran and Jacob Clouse and running thence North to the County line between Delaware and Franklin Counties.

You will therefore meet on the 8th day of January, 1886 at the place designated as the beginning of said road, or alteration, and after taking an oath or affirmation, faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of your appointments respectively, you shall take to your assistance two suitable persons as Chain Carriers, and one Marker, and proceed to view, survey and lay out said road or alteration, as prayed for in the above petition, or as near the same, as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense; taking into consideration the utility, convenience and inconvenience, and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public. And said Viewers shall, in addition to their duties as Viewers, also at the same time assess and determine the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages sustained by any person or persons through whose premises the road is proposed to be established; and the said Viewers shall make and sign a report in writing stating their opinion in favor or against the establishment or alteration of said road, or any part thereof, and set forth the reasons of the same; which report, together with the plan and survey of said road or alteration, shall be delivered to the County Auditor by one of the Viewers on or before the first day of our session in March next. Said Viewer shall also determine the width of said road, which cannot be more than 60 feet wide.

AND FURTHER, it shall be the duty of the Viewers aforesaid, at the same time at which they are required to make their report of the view, to make a separate report in writing, stating the amount of the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages, (if any,) and to whom, which by them have been assessed, and be further governed in their proceedings under this order by the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided.

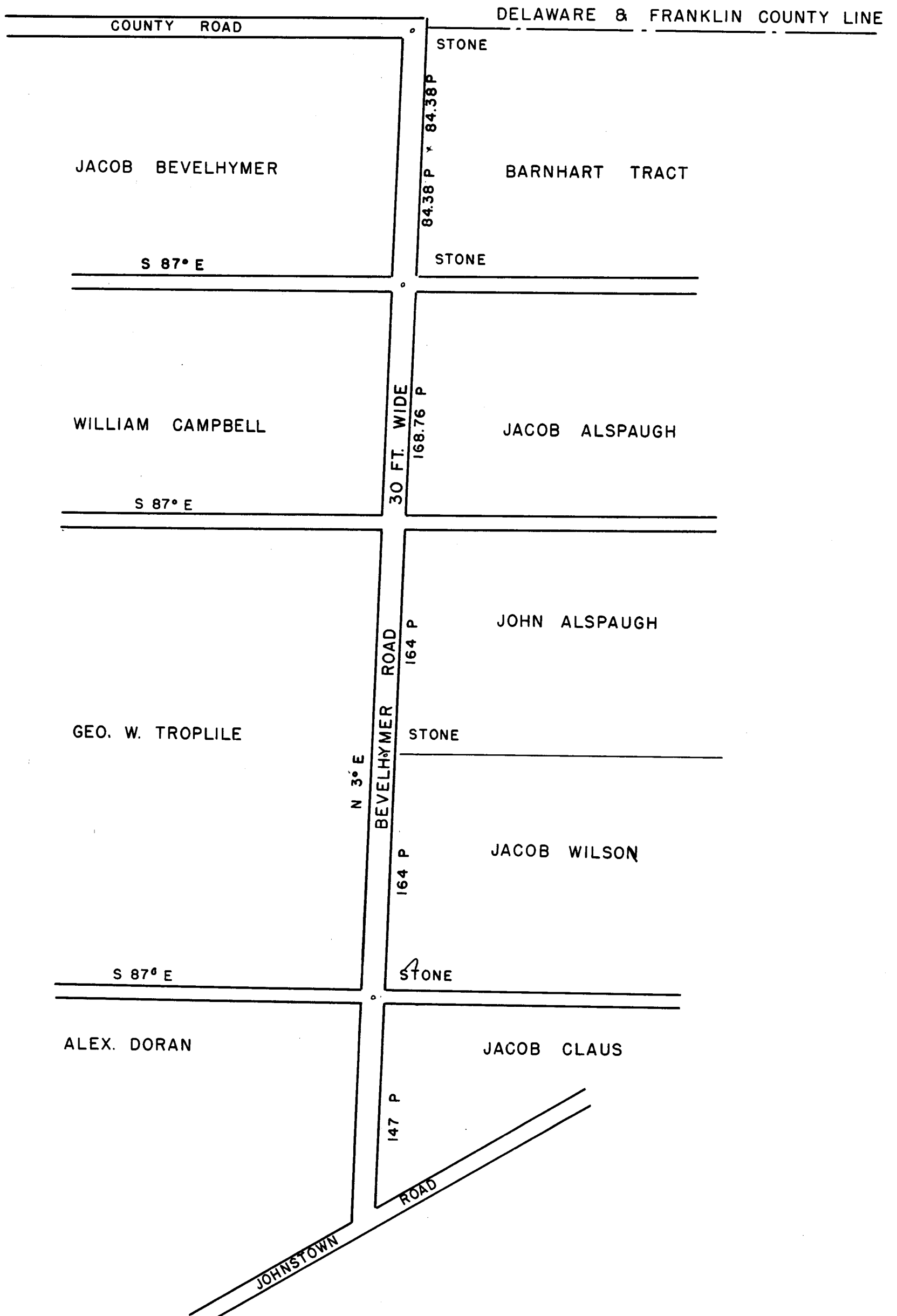

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order, issued at your December 9th session, A.D. 1885, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with Josiah Kinnear Surveyor, at New Albany on Jan'y 8-1886 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order.

G.S. Williamson was selected by us as chain-carrier and E.F. Kinnear as marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed County Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the establishment of said road, as follows:

Beginning in the center of the Johnstown Road and in the one half section line of section number 12 of Plain township, thence N 3° E. with said 1/2 section line of sections 9 and 2 S. 12 poles to the S. line of Delaware County, Ohio, following the 1/2 section stones corners of the above named sections.

We would respectfully report that the said road ought to be established for the following reason: For the public convenience.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such County Road shall be established thirty (30) feet in width.

It is further ordered that the County Auditor issue an order in the name of the Board directing the Trustees of Plain township to cause said road to be opened according to law.
