Beginning at a point on the farm of the petitioner in the south east quarter of Section 12,Township II (Madison)and Range 21,about midway between the East and West lines of the aforesaid quarter Section, where said road turns and runs in a North Westerly direction to what is known and distinguished as the Lehman Road so as to run in a straight line due West from the first named starting point to the Lehman Road on the half Section line.

The Commissioners met in regular session at the Auditor's Office, and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Now comes Daniel Wright one of the signers of the foregoing petition, and files his bond which is in the words and figures following, to-wit:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Daniel Wright and Jefferson Mosier are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the penal sum of One hundred Dollars, for the true and faithful payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents.

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION ARE SUCH, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Franklin County for the change of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Now, if the said applicant shall pay into the treasury of the said county, the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.

Which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that the foregoing petitioners have fully complied with the law in regard to said petition, it is ordered that John Lisle, Hugh E. Jones and Christian Bachman three disinterested freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and Josiah Kinnear Surveyor of said County and that they meet at County Surveyor's Office or D.Wright's on the 21" day of March/89 at ten o'clock A.M., and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further ordered, that the County Auditor issue the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor, and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this Board, at its next regular session.

Whereupon the County Auditor issued to said Viewers and Surveyor the following order, viz:

Gentlemen: You were appointed by the County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to view and lay out a proposed change in County Road on the following route, as petitioned for by Daniel Wright et al.  
(SEE PETITION)

You will therefore meet on the 21" day of March/89 at the place designated as the beginning of said road, or alteration, and after taking an oath or affirmation, faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of your appointments respectively, you shall take to your assistance two suitable persons as Chain Carriers,

and one Marker, and proceed to view, survey and lay out said road, or alteration, as prayed for in the above petition, or as near the same as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense; taking into consideration the utility, convenience and inconvenience, and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public. And said Viewers shall, in addition to their duties as Viewers, also at the same time assess and determine the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages sustained by any person or persons through whose premises the road is proposed to be established; and the said Viewers shall make and sign a report in writing, stating their opinion in favor of or against the establishment or alteration of said road, or any part thereof, and set forth the reasons of the same; which report, together with the plan and survey of said road or alteration, shall be delivered to the County Auditor by one of the Viewers on or before the first day of our session in June next.. Said Viewer shall also determine the width of said road, which cannot be more than 60 feet wide.

AND FURTHER, it shall be the duty of the Viewers aforesaid, at the same time at which they are required to make their report of the view, to make a separate report in writing, stating the amount of the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages, (if any,) and to whom, which by them have been assessed, and be further governed in their proceedings under this order by the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided.

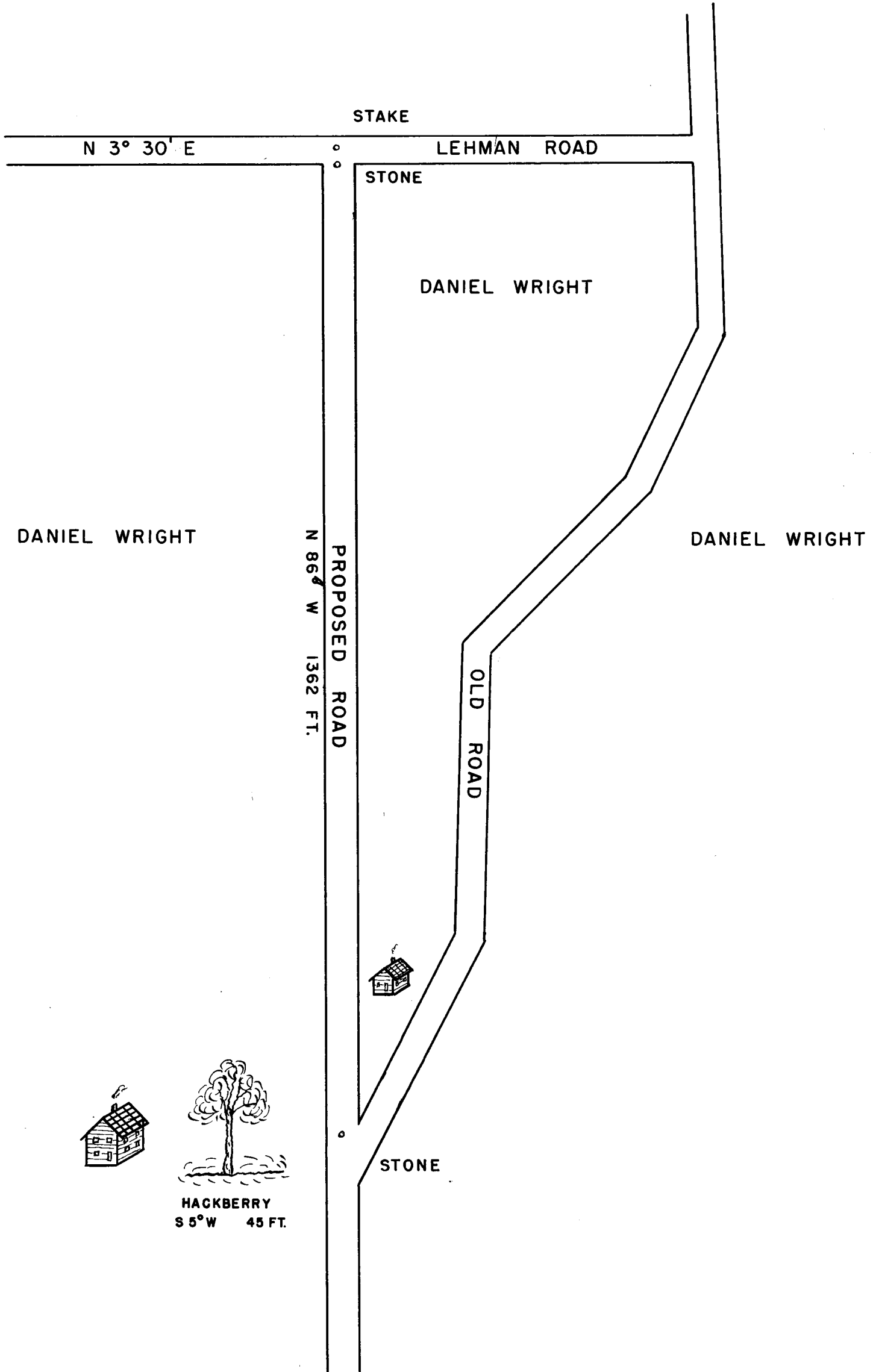
SURVEUOR'S REPORT.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned in obedience to your order dated March 12<sup>th</sup> 1889, proceeded, on the 21<sup>st</sup>. day of March/89 to survey and mark the Daniel Wright change of road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order, issued at your March session, A.D. 1889, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with Josiah Kinnear Surveyor, at Daniel Wright's on March 21/89 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

John Lisle and Hugh E. Jones were selected by us as chain-carriers and E.E. Legg and C. Baughman as Markers, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed change of the Pickerington and Columbus Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as neat the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the change of said road, as follows:

Beginning at a stone in the center of said Pickerington and Columbus Road, on the farm of Daniel Wright's, in the S.E. Quarter of Section 12 Tp. II, Range 21 (Madison Tp.) About midway between the east and west lines of the aforesaid 1/4 Section when said old road makes a turn and runs in a north westerly direction, said stone is witnessed by an Hackberry tree 3 feet in diameter bears S. 5° W 45 feet distant; thence running N. 86° W 1363 feet to the center of Lehman road, passing over a stone on the east side of said Lehman road at 1341 feet.

In our opinion the alteration hereby contemplated render necessary the following described part of the original road, to-wit: Beginning at said stone witnessed by the Hackberry tree and running in a North-westerly direction to Lehman road as marked and designated as the old road on the annexed plat.

We would respectfully report that the said change ought to be made for the following reasons: The line of road will be so extended and will improve the shape of the farming land through which it runs.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such road shall be established forty feet in width.
