Thence east along the south line of said Jacob E.Slyh's land, and the south line of Joseph Beibel's land, crossing the Olentangy and Scioto River free turnpike at the brick school house and continuing east along the north line of Sam'l S.Lisle's heirs land to the Olentangy River free turnpike.

Which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that the foregoing petitioners have fully complied with the law in regard to said petition,it is ordered that Levi Baningartner,Christopher Kaemmerer and James Legg three disinterested freeholders of Franklin County,Ohio,be and they are hereby appointed Viewers,and Josiah Kinnear Surveyor of said County and that they meet at Co. Surveyor's Office on the 2d. day of November/89 at ten o'clock A.M.,and after being duly sworn,proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments,according to law. It is further ordered,that the County Auditor issue the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor,and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this board,at its next regular session.

Whereupon the County Auditor issued to said Viewers and Surveyor the following order,viz:

Gentlemen: You were appointed by the County Commissioners of Franklin County,Ohio,to view and lay out a proposed County Road on the following route,as petitioned for by J.O.Lisle et al.

(Same description as in Road Notice.)

You will therefore meet on the 2d. day of Vovember,A.D. 1889 at the place designated as the begining of said road,or alteration,and after taking an oath or affirmation,faithfully and imprtially to discharge the duties of your appointments respectively,you shall take to your assistance two suitable persons as Chain Carriers,and one Marker,and proceed to view,survey and lay out said road,or alteration,as prayed for in the above petition,or as near the same as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense; taking into consideration the utility,convenience,and inconvenience,and expense which will result to individuals,as well as to the public. And said Viewers shall,in addition to their duties as Viewers,also at the same time assess and determine the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located,and the damages sustained by any person or persons through whose premises the road is proposed to be established; and the said Viewers shall make and sign a report in writing,stating their opinion in favor of or against the establishment or alteration of said road,or any part thereof,and set forth the reasons of the same; which report,together with the plan and survey of said road or alteration,shall be delivered to the County Auditor by one of the Viewers on or before the first day of our session in December next. Said Viewer shall also determine the width of said road,which cannot be more than 60 feet wide.

AND FURTHER,it shall be the duty of the Viewers aforesaid,at the same time at which they are required to make their report of the view,to make a separate report in writing,stating the amount of the Compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the is to be located,and the damages,(if any,)and to whom,which by them have been assessed,and be further governed in their proceedings under this order by the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided.

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order issued at your September session, A.D. 1889, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with Josiah Kinnear Surveyor, at Court House on Nov'r. 2d/89 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

James Legg and G.W. Walcutt were selected by us as chain-carriers and R.Z. Dawson as marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed County road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the location of said road, as follows:

Beginning at a stake in the line of Perry and Clinton Tps., S.E. Corner to S.W. Lakin's land at an angle in the Fairview free pike; thence with said Tp. line N 2 3/4° E. 2.95 chains to a stone corner of J.E. Slyh land and N.W. Corner to land of the Heirs of Martha E. Lisle's; thence south 86 3/4° E along the south line of J.E. Slyh's land and Joseph Beibel's land to a stone in the center of the Olentangy and Scioto River free pike. Distant 58.84 chains. Thence S.E. along the north line of Samuel S. Lisle's heirs land to the Olentangy river free pike. Distance 45.66 chains.

We would respectfully report that the said Lisle Road ought to be established for the following reasons: It will be a great benefit to the Public in general.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such Lisle County Road shall be established fifty feet in width.

Columbus, O. December, 19th A.D. 1889

The Commissioners met in regular session:

In the matter of the petition of J.O. Lisle et al for the location of a County road in Clinton Township.

The report of the viewers in favor of the establishment of said road having previously been read the third time and postponed until this day, and said viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages which they have assessed to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises, said report was also publicly read, and the Board being of the opinion that the compensation and damages awarded by said Viewers to the several claimants, to-wit: To Joseph Biebel \$50.00 Compensation is just and reasonable. And to the Board of Education \$25.00 Compensation is just and reasonable And \$200.00 damages is unreasonable and unjust, and we do not allow the same. That said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation out of the County Treasury, and no petition for review being filed, it is ordered that the County Auditor draw his order upon the County Treasurer on or before thirty days from this date in favor of said claimants, respectively for their full compensation, that the several reports of the viewers with the survey and plat of said road be recorded, and that said road be established a public highway fifty feet wide.

It is further ordered that at and time within thirty days said claimants having accepted their respective awards for compensation, the County Auditor issue in the name of the Board, and order to the Trustees of Clinton Township directing them to cause said road to be opened (50) Fifty feet wide.
