ROAD NOTICE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That a petition will be presented to the Commissioners of Franklin County, at the next session September, A.D. 1889, praying for the establishing and location of a County Road on the following line, to-wit: Beginning at the junction of what is known as the Joseph Mock Farm road, with the North Columbus Free Turnpike at the Southwest corner of John Kiner's farm in Clinton Township, Franklin County, Ohio, and running from thence northerly over and with the line of said Mock Farm road over lands belonging to Lida Howey and Jno.G.McGuffey to and terminating in the County road known as the Henry Innis Road at a point just east of the garden and house where Charles E. Mock now resides. The course and line of said road to be as nearly on the line of said Mock farm road as practicable and extending said line northerly to said Innis Road, its north terminus. That said road be established sixty (60) feet wide.

The Commissioners met in regular session at the Auditor's Office, and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Now comes Jno.G.McGuffey one of the signers of the foregoing petition, and files his bond which is in the words and figures following, to-wit:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Jno.G.McGuffey and Lida Howey are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio,for the use of Franklin County,in the penal sum of \$100.00 Dollars,for the true and faithful payment of which,well and truly to be made,we bind ourselves jointly and severally,our heirs,executors and administrators,by these presents.

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION ARE SUCH, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Franklin County for the establishment & location of a County road on the following line,to-wit:

Now,if the said applicant shall pay into the treasury of the said county the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon,in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted,or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established,then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.

Which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that the foregoing petitioners have fully complied with the law in regard to said petition,it is ordered that L.Beck,Josiah Lunn and Jno.F.Clarke three disinterested freeholders of Franklin County,Ohio,be and they are hereby appointed Viewers,and Josiah Kinnear Surveyor of said County and that they meet at County Surveyor's Ofcs. on the 3d day of October /89 at ten o'clock A.M.,and after being duly sworn,proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments,according to law. It is further ordered that the County Auditor issue the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor,and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this board at its next regular session.

Gentlemen: You were appointed by the County Commissioners of Franklin County,Ohio,to view and lay out a proposed County Road on the following route,as petitioned for by Jno.G.McGuffey et al,in Clinton Tp.

(SEE ROAD NOTICE FOR DESCRIPTION)

You will therefore meet on the 3d day of October 1889 at 10 o'clock A.M. at the place designated as the beginning of said road,or alteration,and after taking an oath or affirmation,faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of your appointments respectively,you shall take to your assistance two suitable persons as Chain Carriers,and one Marker,and proceed to view,survey and lay out said road,or alteration,as prayed for in the above petition,or as near the same as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense; taking into consideration the utility,convenience and inconvenience,and expense which will result to individuals,as well as to the public. And said Viewers shall,in addition to their duties as Viewers,also at the same time assess and determine the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located,and the damages sustained by any person or persons through whose premises the road is proposed to be established; and the said Viewers shall make and sign a report in writing,stating their opinion in favor of or against the establishment or alteration of said road,or any part thereof,and set forth the reasons of the same; which report,together with the plan and survey of said road,or alteration,shall be delivered to the County Auditor by one of the Viewers on or before the first day of our session in December next. Said Viewers shall also determine the width of said road,which cannot be more than 60 feet wide.

AND FURTHER, it shall be the duty of the Viewers aforesaid,at the same time at which they are required to make their report of the view,to make a separate report in writing,stating the amount of the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located,and the damages,(if any,) and to whom,which by them have been assessed,and be further governed in their proceedings under this order by the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided.

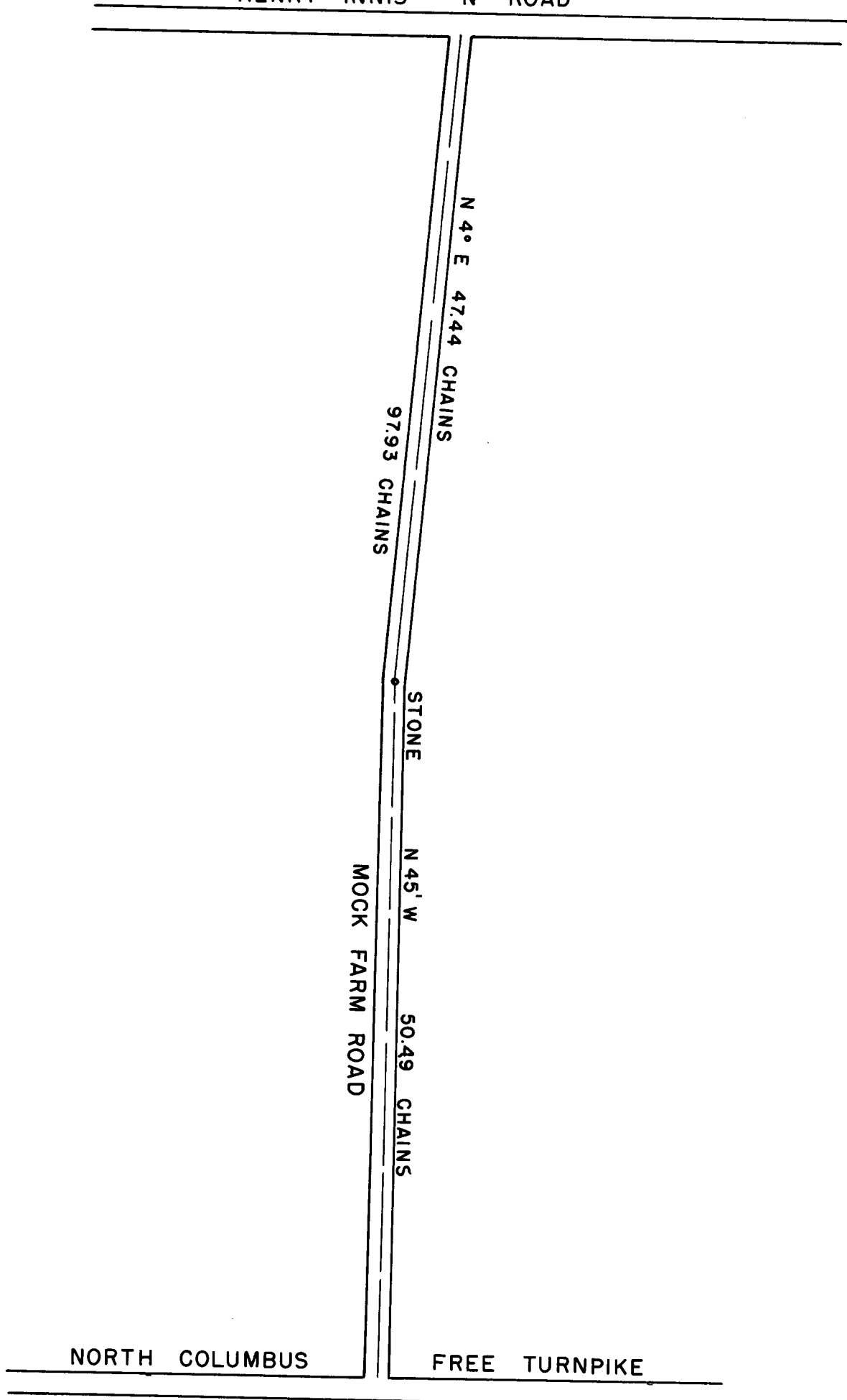

SURVEYOR'S REPORT.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order dated September 4th. 1889, proceeded, on the 3d day of October 1889 to survey and mark the County Road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order, issued at your September session, A.D. 1889, we, the undersigned, Viewers, appointed under said order, met with G.S. Innis Surveyor, at Jno. Kinners' farm on Oct. 3/89 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

L. Beck failed to appear, and W.H. Richards was appointed in his place.

J.C. Lunn and W.H. Richards were selected by us as chain-carriers, and Elmer E. Pegg as marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed County Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the establishing and location of said road, as follows:

Beginning at a stake in the junction of the Mock Farm road and the North Columbus Free turnpike and in the south west corner of the John Kiner Home Farm, from which stake a Hickory tree in said Kinners' yard bears N 44° E 43 links distant to its centre; thence N 2 1/4° with the said farm road 50.49 chains to a stone in the north end of said farm road; thence N 4° E 47.44 chains to the Henry Innis Road. And there ending, 24 1/2 links west of a Cherry tree 6 inches in Diameter and 12 inches north of the board fence.

We would respectfully report that the said County Road ought to be established for the following reasons: That it would be a great benefit to the public and no great damage to individuals, and further more the ground is such that a good road can be constructed along said route at reasonable expense.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such County Road shall be established thirty feet in width.
