NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That a petition will be presented to the Commissioners of Franklin County, at the next session, December, A.D. 1892, praying for the Vacation of a County Road on the following line, to-wit: Beginning at a point about ten rods east of lands owned by Robert Barb in Truro Township on the road known as the Hebron road, thence northwesterly to the northeast corner of lands of said Robert Barb; thence west to intersect the Graham road and between the lands of Robert Barb and J.L.Graham.

Also to vacate such road, to-wit: Beginning at a point about ten rods east of lands owned by Robert Barb in Truro Township on the road known as the Hebron road. Thence southeasterly through M.G.Palmer's land and between the lands of J.Ashton and R.Barb and between said Ashton and N.Orcutt to the Graham road and Pickerington. Road.

ROAD PETITION.

FOR THE VACATION OF A COUNTY ROAD IN TRURO TOWNSHIP.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said County, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Vacating of a County road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to Vacate such road, to-wit: Beginning at a point about ten rods east of lands owned by Robert Barb in Truro Township on the road known as the Hebron Road. Thence southeasterly through M.G.Palmer's lands between the lands of Ashton and Barb, and between Ashton, Orcutt to the Graham and Pickerington Roads.

For the reason that said road has become useless and that a new road has been established rendering the above unnecessary and for the further reason that unless said portion of road above described is vacated will require construction of a bridge.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we M.G.Palmer and B.H.Harmon are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the penal sum of One Hundred Dollars, for the true and faithful payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated at Columbus, Ohio this 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1892

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION ARE SUCH, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Franklin County for the Vacation of a part of the Hebron County road on the following line, to-wit:

Beginning at a point about ten rods east of lands owned by Robert Barb in Truro Township on the road known as the Hebron Road. Thence southwesterly through M.G.Palmer's land and between the lands of Jos. Ashton and Robert Barb and between Ashton and Orcutt to the Graham and Pickerington roads.

Now, if the said applicant shall pay into the treasury of the said county the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.
