REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order, issued at your \_\_\_\_\_ session, A.D. 18\_\_\_\_, we, the undersigned, Viewers, appointed under said order, met with R.S. Blackford Surveyor, at North end of said Road as prayed for and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

Lewis M. Ring and \_\_\_\_\_ were selected by us as chain-carriers, and Jacob M. Ring as marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the \_\_\_\_\_ of said road, as follows:

Beginning at a stake in centre of the Alton & Darby Creek Free Turnpike, on the line between the lands of Edward Jones on the East and Elizabeth Jones (20 ft lane) on West; thence with said line S 1° 15' W. 817 ft to end of said Eliz Jones 20' lane and her N.E. Corner, continuing same course 1390 ft to Edward Jones S.W. and John P. Jones N.W. corner; continuing same course 4224 ft to John P. Jones South and Sarah Humphreys' N. line, also Eliz Jones S.E. and John P. Jones S.W. corner; thence with said line between said S. Humphreys and John P. Jones S. 86° 55' E. 160.50 ft to Sarah Humphreys' N.E. and Edward Jones N.W. corner; thence with line between said Humphreys and Ed. Jones S 7° 20' E. 541.50 ft to Ed. Jones' S.W. and Evan Jones N.W. corner; continuing same course on line between Evan Jones and the said Sarah Humphreys 1081.50 ft to Evan Jones S.W. and Reese Jones' N.W. corner; continuing same course on line between Reese Jones and the said Sarah Humphreys 2570 ft to center of the Geyer free Turnpike (to a stone S.W. and Sarah Humphreys' S.E. corner, the end of said improvement. 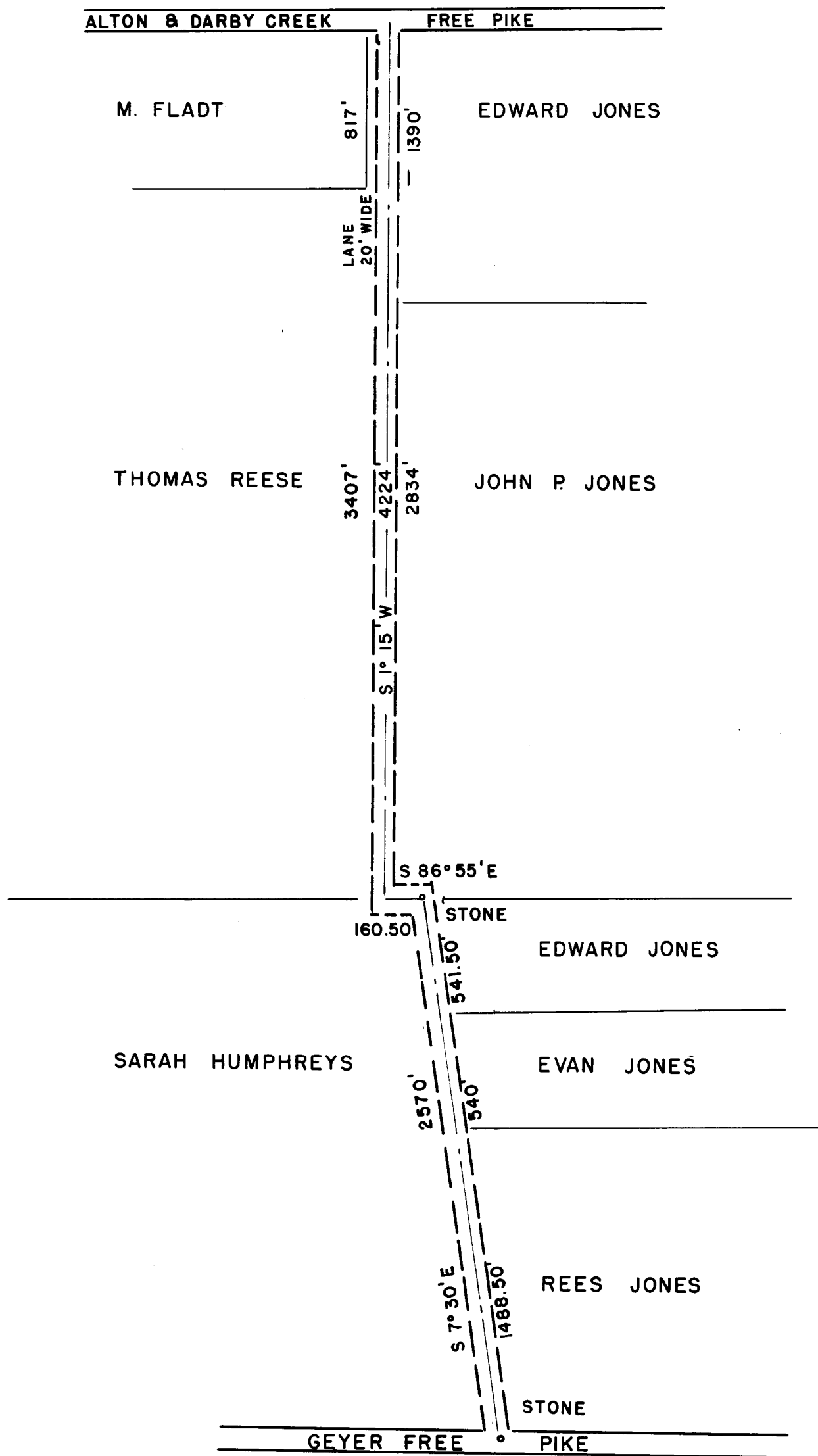
