FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN PERRY TOWNSHIP:

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said County, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the laying out & establishing of a County road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to establish such road, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the Dublin Pike about 50 feet north of the intersection of the switch of the P.C.C. & St.L. Ry. Co. to Marble Cliff Quarries with said Dublin Pike; thence Southeastwardly with a width of 60 feet, and East of said switch to a point in Fifth Avenue about 50 ft. east of the roadway of said P.C.C. & St.L. Ry. Co. being a distance of about 2000 feet.

Said petitioners therefore ask that the necessary proceedings may be had to lay out and establish such County road, according to Law.

The Commissioners met in regular session at the Auditor's Office, and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Now comes J.F.Reid one of the signers of the foregoing petition, and files his bond which is in the words and figures following, to-wit:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John F.Reid and George W.Matthews are held and firmly bound unto the state of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the penal sum of One Hundred Dollars, for the true and faithful payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated at Columbus, Ohio this 9<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1898

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION ARE SUCH, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said County for the establishment of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Dublin Pike in Perry Township in said County of Franklin, about 50 feet North of the intersection of the Switch of the P.C.C. & St.L.Ry.Co., to Marble Cliff Quarries in the said Dublin Pike; thence southeastwardly with a width of 60 feet, and east of said switch to a point in Fifth Avenue, about 50 feet east of the roadway of said P.C.C. & St.L.Ry.Co. Being a distance of about 2000 feet.

Now, if the said applicant shall pay into the treasury of the said county the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.

And it appearing that the foregoing petitioners have fully complied with the law in regard to said petition, it is ordered that W.T.Rees, N.Scofield and J.W.Garrett three disinterested freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and that they meet the Co.Surveyor's Office on the 28 day of April at 1:00 o'clock P.M., and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further ordered that the County Auditor issue the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor, and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this Board at its next regular session.

Whereupon the County Auditor issued to said Viewers and Surveyor the following order, viz:

Gentlemen: You were appointed by the County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to view and lay out a proposed County Road on the following route, as petitioned for by J.F.Reid et al.

Beginning at a point in the Dublin Pike in Perry Twp. in said County of Franklin, about 50 feet North of the intersection of the switch of the P.C.C. & St.L.Ry.Co. to Marble Cliff Quarries in the said Dublin Pike; thence South-eastwardly with a width of 50 feet, and east of said switch to a point in Fifth Avenue about 50 feet east of the roadway of said P.C.C. & St.L.Ry.Co. Being a distance of about 2000 feet.

You will therefore meet at the Co.Surveyor's Office at the place designated as the beginning of said road, or alteration, and after taking an oath or affirmation, faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of your appointments respectively, you shall take to your assistance two suitable persons as Chain Carriers, and one Marker, and proceed to view, survey and lay out said road, or alteration, as prayed for in the above petition, or as near the same as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense; taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as to the public. And said Viewers shall, in addition to their duties as Viewers, also at the same time assess and determine the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages sustained by any person or persons through whose premises the road is proposed to be established; and the said Viewers shall make and sign a report in writing, stating their opinion in favor of or against the establishment or alteration of said road, or any part thereof, and set forth the reasons of the same; which report, together with the plan and survey of said road or alteration, shall be delivered to the County Auditor by one of the Viewers on or before the first day of our session in \_\_\_\_\_ next. Said Viewers shall also determine the width of said road, which cannot be more than 60 feet wide.

AND FURTHER, it shall be the duty of the Viewers aforesaid, at the same time at which they are required to make their report of the view, to make a separate report in writing, stating the amount of the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages, (if any,) and to whom, which by them have been assessed, and be further governed in their proceedings under this order by the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided.

SURVEYOR'S REPORT:

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order dated, April, 9, 1898, proceeded, on the 28" day of April to survey and mark the line of said proposed road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

REPORT OF VIEWERS:

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order, issued at your April 9" session, A.D. 1898, we, the undersigned, Viewers, appointed under said order, met with Henry Maetzel County Surveyor, at the beginning of said road on April 28" and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

Walter Braun and Rob't. S. Blackford were selected by us as chain-carriers, and Clark Baumgartner, as Marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same, as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the establishment of said road, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the North line of 5th Avenue 86 ft. East of the center of the P.C.C. & St. L. Ry. track and 30 ft. East of the stone fence on the railroad right of way line; thence keeping 30 ft. from stone fence N. 36 1/4° W. 134 ft. N. 41° W. 126 ft. N. 48° W. 186 ft. N. 52 3/4° W. 127.75 ft. N. 58° 10' W. 167.5 ft. N. 59 1/2° W 107 ft. N. 58 1/4° W. 14 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 45° 5' W. keeping 50 ft. east of center of railway switch crossing James T. Miller's driveway at 413 ft. at 1328 center line crosses old hedge 1450 to angle in road; thence N. 48 1/2° W. 1715 to and iron pin in center of old road 30 ft. from hedge fence and 50 ft. from center of railroad switch curve.

We would respectfully report that said road ought to be granted for the following reasons: The public will be greatly benefited by having a road which does not cross the railroad tracks and which when established will be at a safe distance from the railroad tracks.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such road shall be established Sixty feet in width.

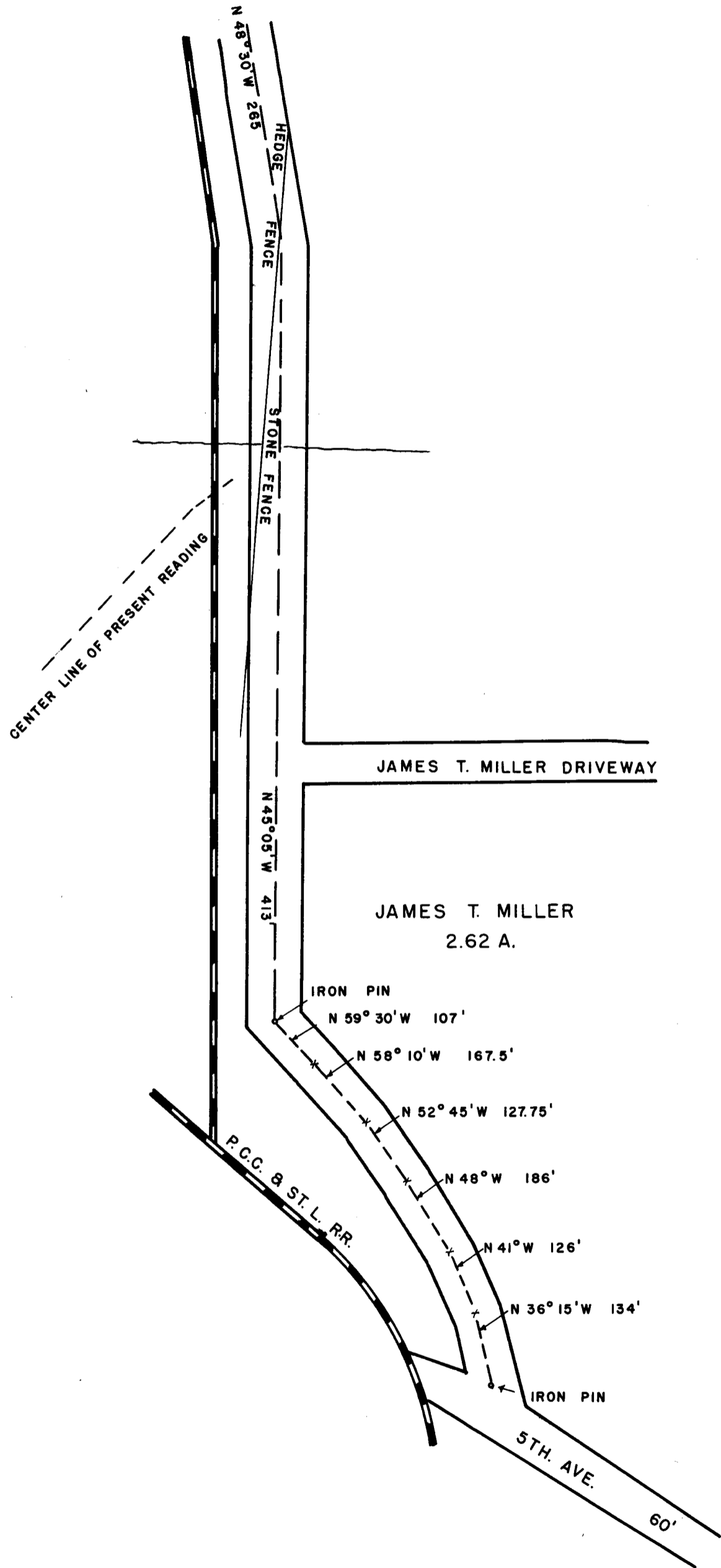
COLUMBUS, OHIO, June, 14, 1898

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MET:  
PRESENT: Bellows, and Brown.

In the matter of the County Road petitioned for by J.F.Reid and others in Perry Township, postponed from June 8, 1898, was again taken up. No petition for review or alteration has been presented. On motion the Viewers and Surveyor's report was accepted. The Viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the compensation allowed to James T. Miller for 2 62/100 Acres of land sought to be appropriated, amounting to Five hundred and Twenty four Dollars, which also was publicly read, and the amount is reasonable and just, that said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation out of the County Treasury. And it is ordered that the County Auditor draw his warrant upon the County Treasurer in favor of said James T. Miller for the amount. That the several reports of Viewers and the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway..
