ROAD PETITION..

FOR THE ALTERATION OF DUBLIN PIKE ROAD IN PERRY TOWNSHIP..

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said County, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the altering of a County road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to alter such road, to-wit: That the State Road known as the Dublin Road in Perry Township, in said County of Franklin should be altered by Straightening said road from a point about five hundred feet north of the South line of the land of Jacob M.Wohrley; thence South-east through the lands of said Wohrley and John F.Reid to a point in the south line of said Reid and connecting with the Scioto River Free Turnpike at its northern terminus, a distance of about 2000 feet; and by vacating said Dublin State road between said points.

Said petitioners therefore ask that the necessary proceedings may be had to establish and order such alteration and vacation according to law..

The Commissioners met in regular session at the Auditor's Office, and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Now comes G.W. Matthews one of the signers of the foregoing petition, and files his bond which is in the words and figures following, to-wit:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we George W. Matthews and John F. Reid are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the penal sum of One Hundred Dollars, for the true and faithful payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated at Columbus this 9th day of April, 1898

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION ARE SUCH, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Franklin County for the Alteration of a State road on the following line, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the State Road known as the Dublin Road, in Perry Township, in said County of Franklin, about 500 feet North of the South line of the lands of Jacob M. W Ehrley; thence Southeast through the lands of said W Ehrley and John F. Reid to a point in the south line of said Reid and connecting with the Scioto River Free Turnpike at its northern terminus. A distance of about 2000 feet.

Now, if the said applicant shall pay into the treasury of the said county the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.

Which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that the foregoing petitioners have fully complied with the law in regard to said petition, it is ordered that W. T. Rees, Nathan Scofield and John W. Garrett three disinterested freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and Henry Maetzel Surveyor of said County and that they meet at Co. Surveyor's Office on the 28 day of April at ten o'clock A.M., and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further ordered that the County Auditor issue the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor, and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this board at its next regular session.

Whereupon the County Auditor issued to said Viewers and Surveyor the following order, viz:

Gentlemen: You were appointed by the County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to view and lay out a proposed County Road on the following route, as petitioned for by Geo. W. Matthews et al.

Beginning at a point in the State Road known as the Dublin Road, in Perry Township, in said County of Franklin about 500 feet North of the South line of the lands of Jacob M. W Ehrley; thence Southeast through the lands of said W Ehrley and John F. Reid to a point in the south line of said Reid and connecting with the Scioto River Free Turnpike at its northern terminus. A distance of about 2000 feet.

You will therefore meet on the 28th day of April 1898, at the place designated as the beginning of said road or alteration, and after taking an oath or affirmation, faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of your appointments respectively, you shall take to your assistance two suitable persons as Chain Carriers, and one Marker, and proceed to view, survey and lay out said road, or alteration, as prayed for in the above petition, or as near the same as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense; taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public. And said Viewers shall, in addition to their duties as Viewers, also at the same time assess and determine the compensation to be made to the owners of the lands across which the road is to be located, and the damages sustained by any person or persons through whose premises the road is proposed to be established; and the said Viewers shall make and sign a report in writing, stating their opinion in favor of or against the establishment or alteration of said road, or any part thereof, and set forth the reasons of the same; which report together with the plan and survey of said road, or alteration, shall be delivered to the County Auditor by one of the Viewers on or before the first day of our session in _____ next. Said Viewers shall also determine the width of said road, which cannot be more than 60 feet wide..

AND FURTHER, it shall be the duty of the Viewers aforesaid, at the same time at which they are required to make their report of the view, to make a separate report in writing, stating the amount of the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages, (if any,) and to whom, which by them have been assessed, and be further governed in their proceedings under this order by the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided.

SURVEYOR'S REPORT.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order dated April 9th 1898, proceeded, on the 28th day of April to survey and mark the line of said road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order, issued at your April 9th session, A.D. 1898, we, the undersigned, Viewers, appointed under said order, met with Henry Maetzel Surveyor, at the residence of Geo. W. Matthews on April, 28, 1898 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

Walter Braun Dpty. Co. Surveyor was selected by us as Chain-carrier, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed alteration of the Dublin State Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as parayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience, and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Alteration of said road, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the old Dublin Road 622 1/2 ft. N.W. from an iron pin in the line between John F. Reid and Jacob M. W Ehrley; thence S. 41 1/4° E. crossing the east line of said Dublin road; * thence S. 36 3/4° E. crossing the line between John F. Reid and Jacob M. W Ehrley at 110 1/2 ft. where is located an iron pin 932 ft. to an iron pin in the line between George W. Matthews and John F. Reid and there to terminate. *-at 100 ft. to an iron pin at an angle in the road.*

In our opinion the alterations hereby contemplated render unnecessary the following described part of the original road, to-wit:

Beginning at the starting point of the new road then following the old road around the foot of the hill to the end of the contemplated alteration. This portion should be vacated.

We would respectfully report that the said road ought to be granted for the following reasons: The present road is low lying at the foot of the hill and is subject to overflow, It is also a poor road to travel owing to the steep grade descending and ascending the hill, The new road would be on high ground and obviate steep grades, thereby being a great public convenience.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such road shall be established Sixty feet in width.

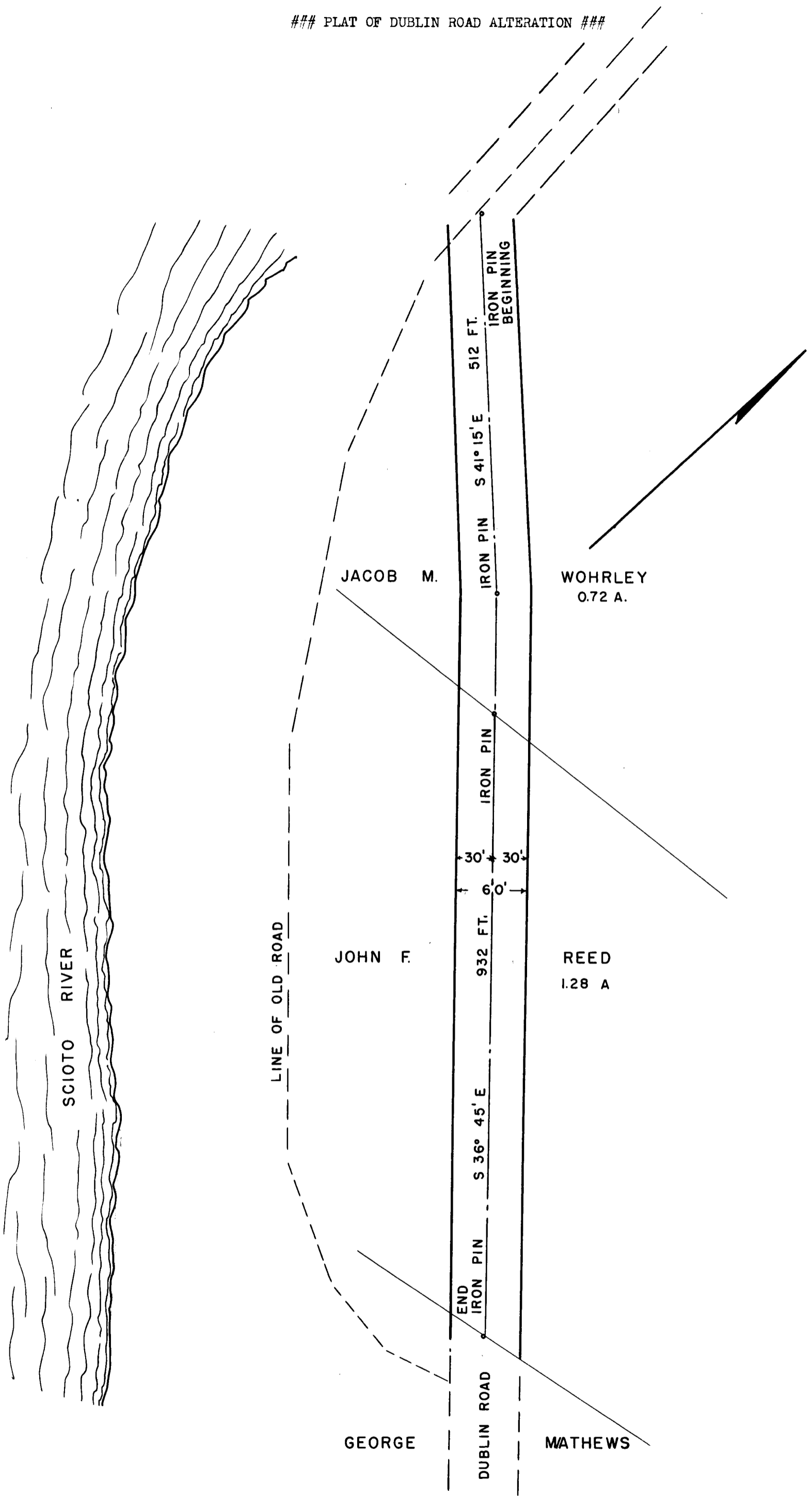
