

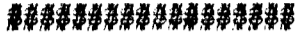

FOR AN ALTERATION OF THE DUBLIN ROAD IN PERRY TOWNSHIP:

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said County, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the alteration of the Dublin road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to alter the course such road to-wit: Beginning at a point in said Dublin Pike, on the South line of the farm formerly owned by J.R.Trapp, in Perry Township, Franklin County, Ohio, containing 124.32 Acres, at a stake, which is N.85° 50' W.4648.65 feet, measured along said South line of said farm formerly owned by J.R.Trapp, from the Southeast corner thereof; thence N.16° 54' W.704.3 feet to a stake(iron pin 30 feet right on the North line of J.R.Trapp, deceased); thence N.3° 36' W. 542.75 feet to a stake(iron pin 30 feet right); thence N.16° 36' W.307.75 feet to a stake (iron pin on the North line of G.W.Lakin's premises, 30 feet right); thence N.18° 24' W.930 feet to a stake (iron pin 30 feet right on the North line of the premises of Charles W.Toy); thence N.4° 23' E.945 feet a-

That we Henry Bohl, H.O.Pond and Fred J.Immel are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the penal sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000), for the true and faithful payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents.

Which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that the foregoing petitioners have fully complied with the law in regard to said petition, it is ordered that Washington Reese, W.L.Jones and George D.Ulry three disinterested freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and Walter Braun Surveyor of said Franklin County and that they meet at The J.R.Trapp farm on line of proposed road, on the 5th day of July, 1904 at ten o'clock A.M., and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further ordered that the County Auditor issue the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor, and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this board at its next regular session.

Gentlemen: You were appointed by the County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to view and lay out a proposed alteration of Dublin Road on the following route, as petitioned for by The City of Columbus et al.

You will therefore meet on the 5th day of July, 1904 at the place designated as the beginning of said road, or alteration, and after taking an oath or affirmation, faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of your appointments respectively, you shall take to your assistance two suitable persons as Chain Carriers, and one Marker, and proceed to view, survey and lay out said road, or alteration, as prayed for in the above petition, or as near the same as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense; taking into consideration

the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as to the public. And said Viewers shall, in addition to their duties as Viewers, also at the same time assess and determine the compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages sustained by any person or persons through whose premises the road is proposed to be established; and the said Viewers shall make and sign a report in writing, stating their opinion in favor of or against the establishment, or alteration of said road, or any part thereof, and set forth the reasons of the same; which report, together with the plan and survey of said road, or alteration, shall be delivered to the County Auditor by one of the Viewers on or before the first day of our session in September next. Said Viewers shall also determine the width of said road, which cannot be more than 60 feet wide.

AND FURTHER, it shall be the duty of the Viewers aforesaid, at the same time at which they are required to make their report of the view, to make a separate report in writing, stating the amount of compensation to be made to the owners of the land across which the road is to be located, and the damages, (if any,) and to whom, which by them have been assessed, and be further governed in their proceedings under this order by the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided,

REPORT OF VIEWERS....

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order, issued at your June 23 session, A.D. 1904, we, the undersigned, Viewers, appointed under said order, met with Walter Braun Surveyor, on Dublin Pike, at the South line of the farm formerly owned by J.R. Trapp, on 5th day of July, 1904 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impart-

ially, the duties required of us in said order.

We then proceeded to view said proposed _____ on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience, and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Alteration of said road, as follows:
