NOTICE OF PRESENTING COUNTY ROAD PETITION.

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the Commissioners of Franklin County, at their next session November 25" 1910, praying for the establishment of a County Road on the following line, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the County line between Franklin and Licking Counties where the south line of the Kennedy Township Road (so-called) in Licking County intersects the said County line; thence with said County line north about ten rods to the line between the lands of Wm. Morrison and J. S. Kennedy; thence west on the said line and the line between the lands of Wm. Morrison and H. Woodruff to intersect the Waggoner County Road, and there to terminate, being about one mile and ten rods in length, and being in Jefferson Township, Franklin County, Ohio.

COUNTY ROAD PETITION.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the establishing of a County Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order proper proceedings in the premises to establish such road, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the County line between Franklin and Licking Counties where the south line of the Kennedy Township Road, (so-called) in Licking County intersects the said County line; thence with said County line north about ten rods to the line between the lands of Wm. Morrison and J. S. Kennedy; thence west on the said line and the line between the lands of Wm. Morrison & H. Woodruff to intersect the Waggoner County Road and there to terminate, being about one mile and ten rods in length, and being in Jefferson Township, Franklin County, Ohio.

BOND ON COUNTY ROAD PETITION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, J. S. Kennedy, Scott Rochelle and Wm. Morrison, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the penal sum of Two Hundred Dollars, to the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we do hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Franklin County, for the establishing of a County Road, on the following line, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the County line between Franklin and Licking Counties where the south line of the Kennedy Township Road (so-called) in Licking County intersects the said County line; thence with said County line north about ten rods to the line between the lands of Wm. Morrison and J. S. Kennedy; thence west on the said line and the line between the lands of Wm. Morrison & H. Woodruff to intersect the Waggoner County Road and there to terminate, being about one mile and ten rods in length, and being in Jefferson Township, Franklin County, Ohio.

Now, if the said applicants shall pay into the Treasury of said County, the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case said application shall fail; then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be in full force in law.

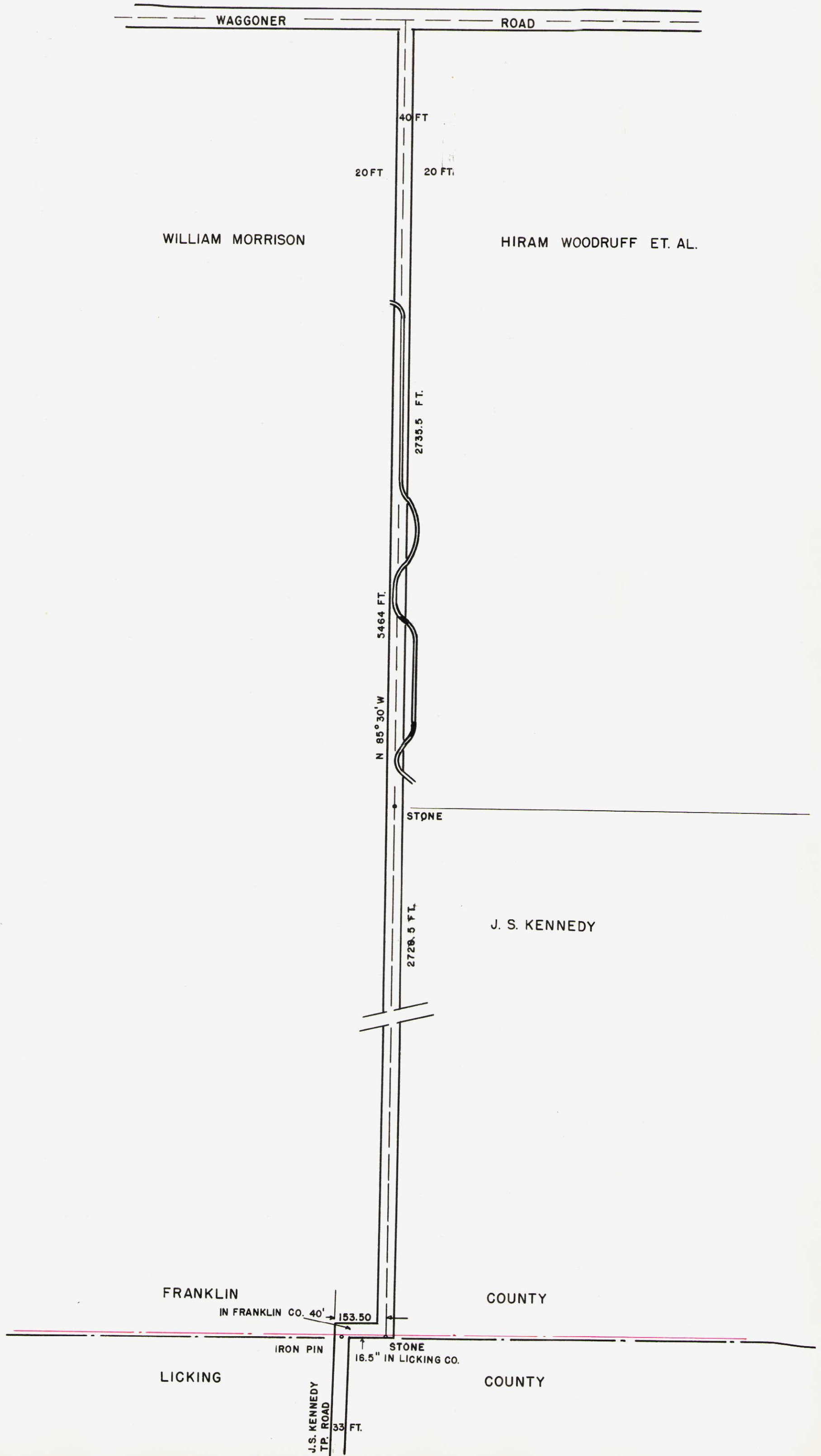
ORDER APPOINTING VIEWERS----COUNTY ROAD. Issued to Viewers and County Surveyor.

Office of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, November 25" 1910..

IN THE MATTER OF THE) J. S. Kennedy Road)

The Petition of J. S. Kennedy and others for the establishing of a County Road along the following route, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the County line between Franklin and Licking Counties, where the center line of the Kennedy Township road in Licking County intersects the said County line; thence with said county line north about 10 rods to the line between the lands of Wm. Morrison & J. S. Kennedy; thence west-erly on said line and the line between the lands of Wm. Morrison and Hiram Woodruff to intersect the Wag-goner Road and there to terminate; having been presented to the Commissioners; and they being satisfied from the proof before them that proper notice of the intention to present such petition has been given acc-ording to law; it is ordered that Phil. J. Dill, Geo. M. Williams and Chas. Salzgeber three disinterested freeholders of this County be and they hereby are appointed Viewers, and the County Surveyor to survey the same.

It is further ordered that an order issue directing said Viewers, with said County Surveyor, to meet at the beginning of said road and proceed on the 5" day of December, 1910, or on their failing to meet on that day, within five days thereafter.



(If either of said Viewers fail to attend at the place specified, at or before ten o'clock A. M. of said day, said Surveyor and two Viewers will fill the vacancy by appointing a judicious disinterested freeholder of this County.) And after taking an oath faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of their appointment respectively to take to their assistance two suitable persons as chain carriers and one marker, and proceed to view, and establish said Road as prayed for in the Petition, or as near the same as in their opinion a good road can be made at reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public, if such road or any part thereof is established also, as a jury, assess and determine the compensation to be paid in money for the properties sought to be appropriated, without deduction for benefit to any property of the owner, and to assess and determine how much less valuable, is any, the land or premises from which such appropriation may be taken, will be rendered by the _____ of such road, being the damages sustained by any person through whose premises the Road is proposed to be _____; (but said Viewers are not required to so assess or award damages or compensation to any person except minors idiots, or lunatics, unless the owner or his agent, having notice as provided by law, files with them a written application, giving a description of the premises on which damages or compensation is claimed;) and also to determine whether the public convenience requires that such Road or any part thereof shall be sixty feet in width, or whether a less width than sixty feet will as well promote the public convenience; and report the width in their opinion, the same shall be _____.

Said Surveyor will survey such road, under the direction of the Viewers, and cause the same to be conspicuously marked throughout, noting the courses and distances, and at the end of each mile cause the number of the same, and also the commencement and termination of the Road or Survey to be marked on a tree or monument erected for that purpose. And said Surveyor will make and deliver to one of said Viewers, without delay, a correct certified return of the Survey of said Road, and a Plat of the same; to be returned with the Reports of said Viewers.

It is further ordered that said Viewers make and sign a Report in writing, stating their opinion in favor of or against the establishing of such Road, or any part thereof, and set forth the reasons of the same, and deliver such Report to the County Auditor, on or before the first day of the _____ session of the Commissioners next ensuing; and at the time said Viewers make such Report, they shall also make a separate Report, in writing, stating the amount of damages, if any, and to whom by them assessed, which would accrue by the establishing of the road; and file the written applications on which such assessments have been made, with the County Auditor.

REPORT OF VIEWERS---COUNTY ROAD.

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your Order dated November, 25th 1910, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said Order, make the following report:

Together with Walter Braun, Deputy County Surveyor, we met at the beginning of said Road on the 5th day of December, 1910, at 10 o'clock, A. M., and after taking the oath required by law, a certificate of which oath is herewith returned; took to our assistance _____ and _____ two suitable persons as chain-carriers, and Frank Brink as Marker, we proceeded to view, survey and lay out the Road as prayed for in the Petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good Road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public, if such road or any part thereof is established as follows:

Fixing the initial point of said Road at the County line at the west end of a Township road, said Surveyor under our direction, surveyed the same along the following route: Beginning at an iron pin in the County line between Franklin and Licking Counties, said pin being the center of the Kennedy Township Road in Licking County, and on the east line of Wm. Morrison's land; thence north with the County line 153 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. to a stone on the line between Wm. Morrison and J. S. Kennedy; thence with said line N. 85 $\frac{1}{2}$ Deg. W. (beginning measurement from County line) 2728 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. to a stone in the southwest corner of said J. S. Kennedy's land and being the southeast corner of Hiram Woodruff's land; thence same course on the line between Morrison & Woodruff 5464 ft. to the center of the Waggoner Road (distance not positive as center of Waggoner road is not established) being about 2735 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet from J. S. Kennedy's southwest corner. Said road is all located in Jefferson Twp.

We further report that our opinion is that said Road ought to be established for the following reasons: it would be a benefit from the fact that the roads in that locality are located a great distance apart and a new line of travel would be established into Licking County.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that said Road should be established and opened 40 feet in width.

A correct certified return of the survey of said Road and a plat of the same is herewith delivered. The notices to the Viewers and Surveyor and also to the Land Owners of the time and place of meeting, with proof of service of the same, are also herewith returned.

The Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, this day met in special session with Richard Sinclair, Morton Hayes and A. M. Gibson, present as members thereof and John Scott, Clerk.

In the matter of the petition of J. S. Kennedy et al, for the establishment of a County Road, the report of the Viewers in favor of the establishment of said road having been publicly read for the third time on the 8th day of March, 1911, and the said Viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation which they have assessed to land owners by reason of the location of the said road through their several premises, which report was also publicly read on the 8th day of March, 1911, and further consideration thereof and action thereon was postponed until this date and the Board after further consideration thereof, being of the opinion that the compensation awarded by said Viewers to the several claimants, to-wit: Wm. Morrison, Compensation \$150.00, Damages \$124.00; Hiram Woodruff, Benjamin A. Woodruff and J. A. Woodruff Compensation \$75.00, damages \$62.00 was reasonable and just; that said road would be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation and damages out of the County Treasury and no petition for review being filed, it is ordered that the County Auditor draw his order upon the County Treasurer in favor of said Claimants for the amount of said Compensation and Damages so awarded to them respectively.

That the several reports of the Viewers with the survey and the plat of said road be accepted, approved and recorded and that said road be established a public highway. 40 feet in width.

On motion by Mr. Hayes, seconded by Mr. Gibson, the above report in said matter was adopted.
