Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the Commissioners of Franklin County, at their next session January 20, 1913, praying for the laying out and establishing of a County Road on the following line, to-wit: Being a road sixty feet wide, thirty feet on each side of a center line described as follows: Beginning at a point in the north line of the road running east and west along the south side of Columbus Terrace and 30 feet west of the west right of way line of The Scioto Valley Traction Company; thence northerly parallel with and 30 feet west of the said west right of way line 1259 feet to a point; thence north 35 Deg. 51 Min. East 201.5 feet crossing the tracks of the Scioto Valley Traction Company to a point in the west line of the Groveport Pike and being in Sec. 14, Hamilton Township, Franklin County, Ohio.

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the laying out and establishing of a County Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order proper proceedings in the premises to lay out and establish such road, to-wit: Being a road sixty feet wide, thirty feet on each side of a center line described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the north line of the road running east and west along the south side, of Columbus Terrace and thirty feet west of the west right-of-way line of the Scioto Valley Traction Company; thence northerly parallel with and thirty feet west of the said west right-of-way line 1259 feet to a point; thence north 35 Deg. 51 Min. That we, N. E. Rees and Frank A. Davis, are held and firmly bound to the State of Ohio, for the use of Franklin County, in the penal sum of Two Hundred Dollars, to the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we do hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators.

Signed by us and dated at Columbus, this 6th day of December, 1912.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Franklin County, for the laying out and establishing of a County Road, on

the following line, to-wit:

Being a road 60 feet wide, 30 feet on each side of a center line described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the north line of the road running east and west along the south side of Columbus Terrace and 30 feet west of the west right of way line of The Scioto Valley Traction Company; thence northerly parallel with and 30 feet west of the said west right of way line 1259 feet to a point; thence north 35 Deg. 51 Min. E. 201-5 feet crossing the tracks of The Scioto Valley Traction Company to a point in the west line of the Groveport Pike, and being in Sec. 14, Hamilton Twp. Franklin County, Ohio.

Now, if the said applicants shall pay into the Treasury of said County, the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case said application shall fail; then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be in full force in law.

ORDER APPOINTING VIEWERS----COUNTY ROAD.

Issued to Viewers and County Surveyor.

IN THE MATTER OF THE) Office of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, January, 20, 1913.

Laying out and establishing

The Petition of E. A. Sandridge and others for the laying out and establishing of a County Road along the following described route, to-wit: Being a road 60 feet wide, 30 feet on each side of a center line described as follows: Beginning at a point in the north line of the road running east and west along the south side of Columbus Terrace, and 30 ft. west of the right-of-way line of The Scioto Valley Traction Company; thence northerly parallel with and 30 feet west of the said west right of way line 1259 feet to a point; thence north 35 Deg. 51 Min. E. 201-5 feet crossing the tracks of The Scioto Valley Traction Company to a point in the west line of the Groveport Pike, and being in Sec. 14, Hamilton Twp., Franklin County, Ohio; having been presented to the Commissioners; and they being satisfied from the proof before them, that proper notice of the intention to present such petition has been given according to law; it is ordered that Chas. Salzgeber, S. Condon and Harry Kennedy three disinterested freeholders of this County be and they hereby are appointed as Viewers, and the County Surveyor to survey the same.

It is further ordered that an order issue directing said Viewers, with said County Surveyor, to meet on line of said proposed road and proceed on the 3rd day of February, 1913, or on their failing to meet on that day, within five days thereafter.

(If either of said Viewers fail to attend at the place specified, at or before ten o'clock A. M. of said day, said Surveyor and two Viewers will fill the vacancy by appointing a judicious disinterested freeholder of this County.) And after taking an oath faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of their appointment respectively, to take to their assistance two suitable person as chain carriers, and one marker, and proceed to view, survey and lay out and establish said Road as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in their opinion a good road can be made at reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public, if such road or any part thereof is laid out and established also, as a jury, assess and determine the compensation to be paid in money for the properties sought to be appropriated, with out deduction for benefit to any property of the owner, and to assess and determine how much less valuable, is any the land or premises from which such application may be taken, will be rendered by the laying out and establishing of such Road, being the damages sustained by any person through whose premises the Road is proposed to be laid out and established; (but said Viewers are not required to so assess or award damages or compensation to any person except minors idiots, or lunatics, unless the owner or his agent, having notice as provided by law, files with them a written application, giving a discription of the premises on which damages or compensation is claimed;) and also to determine whether the public convenience requires that such Road or any part thereof shall be sixty feet in width, or whether a less width than sixty feet will as well promote the public convenience; and report the width in their opinion, the same shall be laid out and established.

Said Surveyor will survey such Road, under the direction of the Viewers, and cause the same to be conspicuously marked throughout, noting the courses and distances, and at the end of each mile cause the number of the same, and also the commencement and termination of the Road or Survey to be marked on a tree or monument erected for that purpose. And said Surveyor will make and deliver to one of said Viewers, without delay, a correct certified return of the survey of said Road, and a Plat of the same; to be returned with the Reports of said Viewers.

It is further ordered that said Viewers make and sign a Report in writing, stating their opinion in favor of or against the laying out and establishing of such Road, or any part thereof, and set forth the reasons of the same, and deliver such Report to the County Auditor, on or before the first day of the March session of the Commissioners next ensuing; and at the time said Viewers make such Report, they shall also make a separate Report, in writing, stating the amount of damages, if any, and to whom by them assessed, which would accrue by the laying out and establishing of the Road; and file the written applications on which such assessments have been made, with the County Auditor.

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order dated January 20th 1913, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said Order, make the following report:

Together with Clark Baumgartner Assistant County Surveyor, we met on the line of the road on the 3rd day of February, 1913, at 10 o'clock, A. M., and after taking the oath required by law, a certificate of which oath is herewith returned; took to our assistance _____ and _____ two suitable persons as chain-carriers, and _____ marker, we proceed to view, survey and lay out and establish the Road as prayed for in the Petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public, if such road or any part thereof is laid out and established, as follows:

Fixing the initial point of said Road at _____ at _____, said Surveyor under our direction, surveyed the same along the following route:

Beginning at a point in the north line of the Road running east and west along the south side of Columbus Terrace Subdivision and 30 feet west of the west right-of-way line of The Scioto Valley Traction Company; thence northerly parallel with and 30 feet west of said west right-of-way line 1259 feet to a point; thence north 35 Deg. 51' east 201½ feet, crossing the tracks of The Scioto Valley Traction Company, to a point in the west line of the Groveport Pike, and there terminate, being in Section 14, Hamilton Township, Franklin County, Ohio.
