REPORT OF VIEWERS---COUNTY ROAD.

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order dated May 20th 1914, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said Order, make the following report: In regard to the opening of a proposed road known as the Foster Road in Blendon Township, as petitioned for by James Hanson, Walter Vincent et al.

Together with Curtis C. Lattimer, Deputy County Surveyor, we met on the line of the road on the 25th day of June, 1914, at 10 o'clock, A. M., and after taking the oath required by law, a certificate of which oath is herewith returned; we proceed to view, survey and establish the Road as prayed for in the Petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consider-

ation the utility, convenience, inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public, if such road or any part thereof is laid out and established, as follows:

Fixing the initial point of said Road at the west end of Electric Avenue at _____, said Surveyor under our direction, surveyed the same along the following route:

Thence in a westerly direction across the right of way of the C. A. & C. Railroad to the Westerville Road, or State St., so-called, and there terminate.

We further report that our opinion is that said Road ought to be laid out and established for the following reasons: There is no public outlet from Electric Avenue to the Westerville Road, or State St., so-called, except across private property, and the opening of the proposed road will furnish a public outlet to Electric Avenue.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that said Road should be established and opened sixty feet in width, making the north line of the proposed road coincide with the north line of Electric Ave., produced.

A correct certified return of the survey of said Road and a plat of the same is herewith delivered. The notices to the Viewers and Surveyor and also to the Land Owners, of the time and place of meeting, with proof of service of the same, are also herewith returned.

The Commissioners met in regular session, and the report of the Viewers and Surveyor appointed to survey and view the road, as described in the Petition, was this day publicly read for the third time, and said Viewers filed a separate report in writing, of the amount of compensation and damages which they have assessed to land owners, by reason of the location of said road thru their several premises, which report was also publicly read, and the Board being of the opinion that the compensation and damages awarded by said Viewers to the several claimants, to-wit:

To the C. A. & C. Railroad Company \$10.00 compensation and \$40.00 damages, are reasonable and

just, that said road will be a public utility, and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of one-half of said compensation and damages, namely the sum of \$25.00 out of the County Treasury and that the petitioners for said road pay the other half thereof namely the sum of \$25.00; and no petition for review being filed, it is ordered that the County Auditor draw his order upon the County Treasury in favor of said Claimant for one-half the amount of said compensation and damages so awarded to the C. A. & C Railroad Company; namely the sum of \$25.00.

It is further ordered that the petitioners pay into the County Treasury, subject to the demand of the said The C. A. & C. Railroad Company forthwith the amounts so as aforesaid assessed to them, namely, the sum of \$25.00 and that no further proceedings be had in the premises until such payment shall have been made.
