The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Franklin County, for the laying out and establishing of a County Road, on the following line, to-wit :

Beginning at the road known as the Columbus and Jersey Road, and at the intersection of said road with the boundary line between Franklin and Licking Counties, and being about one hundred rods south of the northeast corner of Jefferson Township; thence extending south on the line between said Counties of Franklin and Licking about six hundred rods, to the intersection of said line with the road now running east from Havens Corners and there terminate. Laying out and Establishing

The Petition of Wm. C. Dixon and others for the laying out and establishing of a county road along the following described route, to-wit: Beginning at the road known as the Columbus and Jersey Road, and at the intersection of said road with the boundary line between Franklin and Licking Counties, and being about one hundred rods south of the northeast corner of Jefferson Township; thence extending south on the line between said Counties of Franklin and Licking about six hundred rods to the intersection of said line with the road now running east from Havens Corners and there terminate. About two hundred rods of the South end of said distance being now opened with a road thirty feet wide; having been presented to the Commissioners; and they being satisfied from the proof before them that proper notice of the intention to present such petition has been given according to law; it is ordered that H. D. Kennedy, Sylvester Condon and Chas. Salzgaber three disinterested freeholders of this County be and they hereby are appointed as Viewers, and the County Surveyor to survey the same.

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It is further ordered that an order issue directing said Viewers, with said County Surveyor, to meet on line of said proposed road and proceed on the 7th day of April, 1914, or on their failing to meet on that day, within five days thereafter.

(If either of said Viewers fail to attend at the place specified, at or before ten o'clock A. M. of said day, said Surveyor and two Viewers will fill the vacancy by appointing a judicious disinterested freeholder of this County.) And after taking an oath faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of their appointment respectively, to take to their assistance two suitable persons as chain carriers and one marker, and proceed to view, survey and lay out and establish said Road, as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in their opinion a good road can be made at reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public, if such road or any part thereof is laid out and established also, as jury, assess and determine the compensation to be paid in money for the properties sought to be appropriated, without deduction for benefit to any property of the owner, and to assess and determine how much less valuable, is any, the land or premises from which such appropriation may be taken, will be rendered by the laying out and establishing of such road, being the damages sustained by any person through whose premises the Road is proposed to be laid out and established; (but said Viewers are not required to so assess or award damages or compensation to any person except minors idiots, or lunatics, unless the owner or his agent, having notice as provided by law, files with them a written application, giving a description of the premises on which damages or compensation is claimed;) and also to determine whether the public convenience requires that such Road or any part thereof shall be sixty feet in width, or whether a less width than sixty feet will as well promote the public convenience; and report the width in their opinion, the same shall be laid out and established.

Said Surveyor will survey such Road, under the direction of the Viewers, and cause the same to be conspicuously marked throughout, noting the courses and distances, and at the end of each mile cause the number of the same, and also the commencement and termination of the Road or Survey to be marked on a tree or monument erected for that purpose. And said Surveyor will make and deliver to one of said Viewers, without delay, a correct certified return of the Survey of said Road, and a Plat

of the same; to be returned with the Reports of said Viewers.

It is further ordered that said Viewers make and sign a Report in writing, stating their opinion in favor of or against the laying out and establishing of such Road, or any part thereof, and set forth the reasons of the same, and deliver such Report to the County Auditor, on or before the first day of the June session of the Commissioners next ensuing; and at the time said Viewers make such Report, they shall also make a separate Report, in writing, stating the amount of damages, if any, and to whom by them assessed, which would accrue by the laying out and establishing of the Road; and file the written applications on which such assessments have been made, with the County Auditor.

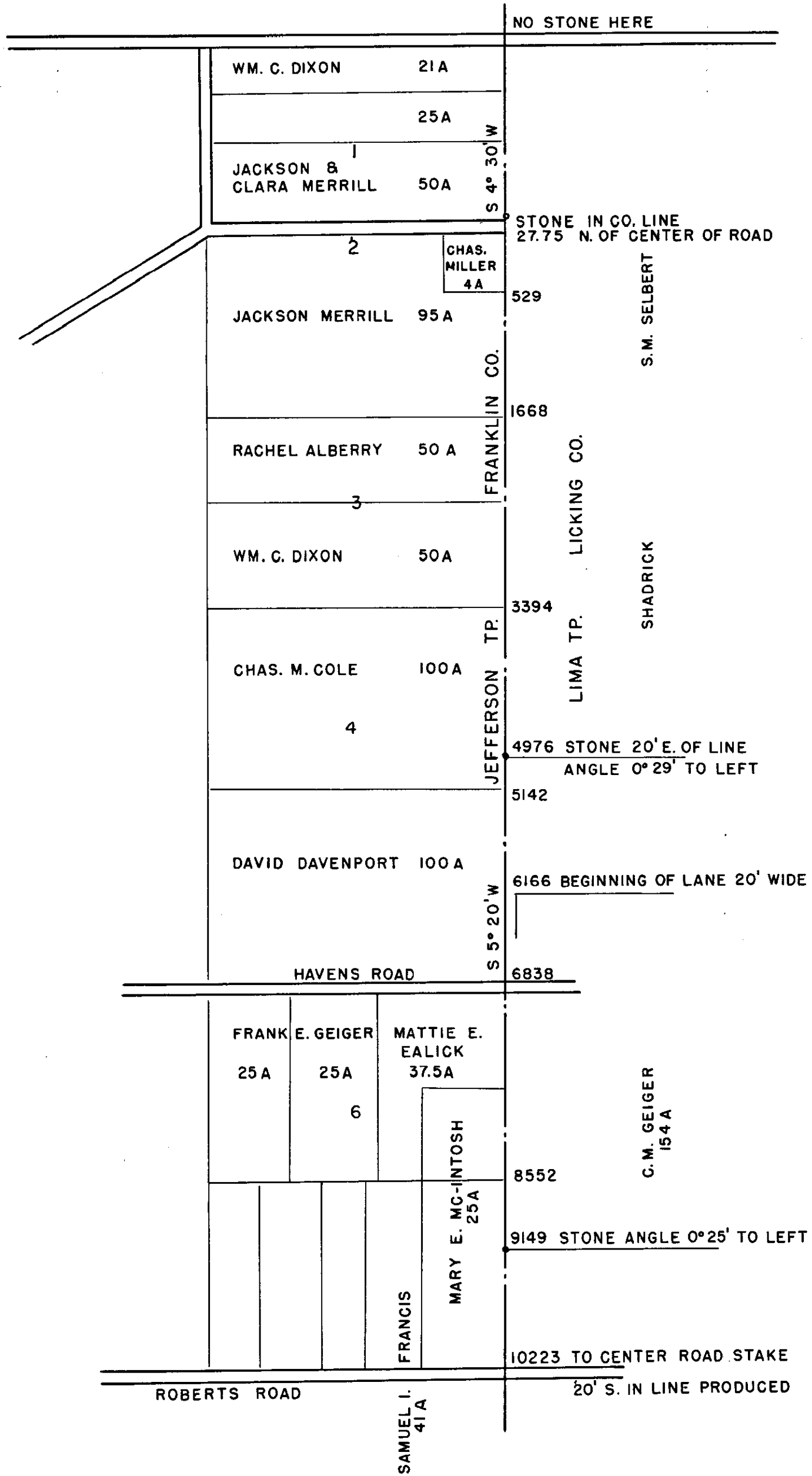

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TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN AND LICKING COUNTY, OHIO:

In obedience to your order dated March 11, 1914, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said Order, make the following report: H. D. Kennedy, Chas. Salzgaber, Sylvester Condon Viewers of Franklin County, Ohio, T. F. Hilbrant, Geo. W. Stinson, T. B. Hirst, Viewers of Licking County, Ohio.

Together with R. S. Blackford, Deputy County Surveyor, we met at the line of the road, on the 7th day of April, 1914, at 10 o'clock, A. M., and after taking the oath required by law, a certificate of which is herewith returned; took to our assistance _____ and _____ two suitable persons as chain-carriers, and _____ marker, we proceed to view, survey and lay out the Road as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good Road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals, as well as to the public, if such road or any part thereof is laid out and established.

We further report that our opinion is that said Road ought to be laid out and established for the following reasons: The road will be a benefit to the general public and a relief in giving an outlet to property that now has no outlet.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that said Road should be established and opened 40 feet in width.

This day came the parties and thereupon this cause came on to be heard upon the pleadings and the evidence. On consideration whereof, the Court find that the facts stated in the petition of Plaintiffs are true and that the road sought to be established by the joint proceedings of the County Commissioners of the Counties of Franklin and Licking, ought not to be located upon the line as designated and set out in said proceedings. But it appearing to the Court that since the commencement of this action, the County Commissioners of Franklin & Licking, having determined that the boundary line between the Counties of Franklin and Licking and between the beginning and ending points of said Road, as designated in the petition therefor were not sufficiently ascertained and definite have proceeded as provided by Sections No's. 2464 and 2465 General Code of Ohio, and have thereby established the true line between said Counties along the line of said proposed road, and have caused said road to be laid out forty (40) feet wide along said line, with 20 feet thereof lying on each side of said line and have caused monuments and stakes to be placed thereon; indicating the boundaries of said Road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be and the same is located and established on the true County Line between Franklin and Licking Counties for the distance described in the petition for such proceedings, the same to be 40 ft. wide along said County line with 20 ft. thereof lying on each side of said line, as indicated by the monuments and stakes as above set forth line, as indicated by the monuments and stakes as above set forth and as indicated by the Surveyor's survey and plat of record in case No. 76,275 Common Pleas Court, Franklin County, Ohio, and Case No. _____ Licking County, Ohio, said record having been made conformable to Sections 2464 and 2465 General Code of Ohio.

And it is further ordered that all of the owners and occupiers of land adjacent to and over which said road so located shall pass shall forthwith remove their fences from the said road and to the line of the stakes of said road so surveyed by the Surveyor's in said proceedings of said County Commissioners, except that the Plaintiff, Charles M. Geiger shall not be required to take up and set back any part of his fence along his entire tract of land now forming the east boundary line of said road so long as it shall not be necessary to reconstruct said fence, but the same shall be allowed to remain where they now stand until such time as said fences or any part thereof shall be required to be reconstructed by a new fence and when it shall become necessary to reconstruct said fence or any part thereof the part so constructed shall be placed upon the line indicated by the stakes set by said Surveyor's between the lands of said Charles M. Geiger and the said road.

And all persons are hereby enjoined from interfering with the said fences of said Geiger in their present location, notwithstanding that they may encroach somewhat upon the line of said road thereat, so long as the same shall not be re-constructed. And the said road is hereby established along said County line as hereinabove indicated. And it is further ordered that the costs be paid by the Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, and the Commissioners of Licking County, Ohio, in equal proportions.

Mr. Mulby, as a member of the Joint session of the Boards of Commissioners of Franklin and Licking Counties, held this 29th, day of April 29, 1919, offered the following preamble and resolution, and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Douglass, also a member.

WHEREAS, On the 2nd day of July, 1914, at a joint meeting of the Boards of Commissioners of Franklin and Licking Counties, Ohio, said Commissioners established a forty foot county road known as The Dixon Road on the boundary line between Licking and Franklin Counties, beginning at the road known as the Columbus and Jersey Road, and at the intersection of said road with the boundary line between Franklin and Licking Counties, and being about 100 rods south of the northeast corner of Jefferson Township; thence extending south on the line between said Counties of Franklin and Licking about six hundred rods to the intersection of said line with the road now running east from Havens Corners and there terminate, the same being established twenty feet on each side of said County boundary line; and

WHEREAS, In a certain proceeding had in the Court of Appeals in Licking County, Ohio, wherein the Commissioners of said Counties were defendants in error and Charles M. Geiger was Plaintiff in error, said cause being numbered 1454 in said Court, the Court of Appeals made the following order:-

This day came the parties and thereupon this cause came on to be heard upon the pleadings and the evidence. On consideration whereof, the Court find that the facts stated in the petition of Plaintiffs are true and that the road sought to be established by the joint proceedings of the county Commissioners of the Counties of Franklin and Licking, ought not to be located upon the line as designated and set out in said proceedings. 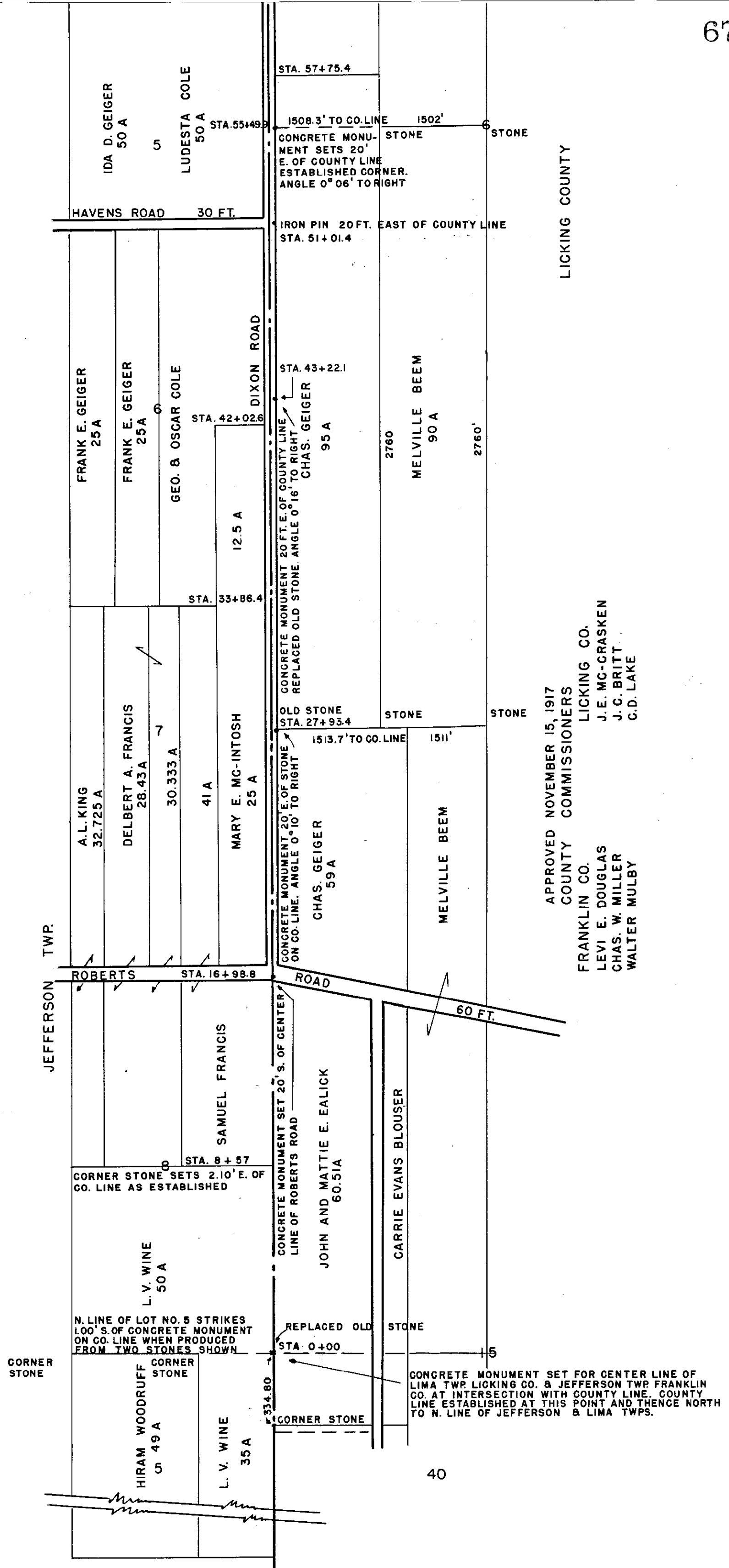

tion for such proceedings, the same to be 40 ft. wide along said county line with 20 ft. thereof lying on each side of said line, as indicated by the monuments and stakes as above set forth line, as indicated by the monuments and stakes as above set forth and as indicated by the Surveyor's survey and plat of record in case No. 76,275 Common Pleas Court, Franklin County, Ohio, and case No. _____, Licking County, Ohio, said record having been made conformable to Sections 2464 and 2465 General Code of Ohio.

And it is further ordered that all of the owners and occupiers of land adjacent to and over which said road, so located, shall pass, shall forthwith remove their fences from the said road and to the line of the stakes of said road so surveyed by the surveyors in said proceedings of said County Commissioners, except that the Plaintiff Charles M. Geiger, shall not be required to take up and set back any part of his fence along his entire tract of land now forming the east boundary line of said road so long as it shall not be necessary to re-construct said fence, but the same shall be allowed to remain where they now stand until such time as said fences or any part thereof shall be required to be re-constructed by a new fence, and when it shall become necessary to re-construct said fence, or any part thereof, the part so re-constructed shall be placed upon the line indicated by the stakes set by the Surveyors between the lands of said Charles M. Geiger and the said road.

And all persons are hereby enjoined from interfering with the said fences of said Geiger in their present location, notwithstanding that they may encroach somewhat upon the line of said road thereat, so long as the same shall not be re-constructed. And the said road is hereby established along said County line, as hereinabove indicated. And it is further ordered that the costs be paid by the Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, and the Commissioners of Licking County, Ohio, in equal proportions.

therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Commissioners of Licking and Franklin Counties, Ohio, all of said Commissioners being present and voting in favor thereof, that the former order of this Joint Board be and the same is hereby amended in conformity with said order of the Court of Appeals of Licking County, Ohio, and that said County road known as The Dixon Road, be and the same is hereby established on the true line between said Counties as indicated by the monuments and stakes as set forth by the surveyor's survey and plat of record in Case No. 76,275 Common Pleas Court, Franklin County, Ohio, and Case No. _____, Court of Common Pleas, Licking County, Ohio; said road to be established and laid out forty feet wide along said line, with twenty (20) ft. thereof lying on each side of said county boundary line, commencing at the point hereinbefore mentioned and ending at the point hereinbefore indicated, said distance being about 600 rods; and that the surveyors' of Franklin and Licking Counties, Ohio, be ordered to open up said road on the line herein indicated, according to law.
