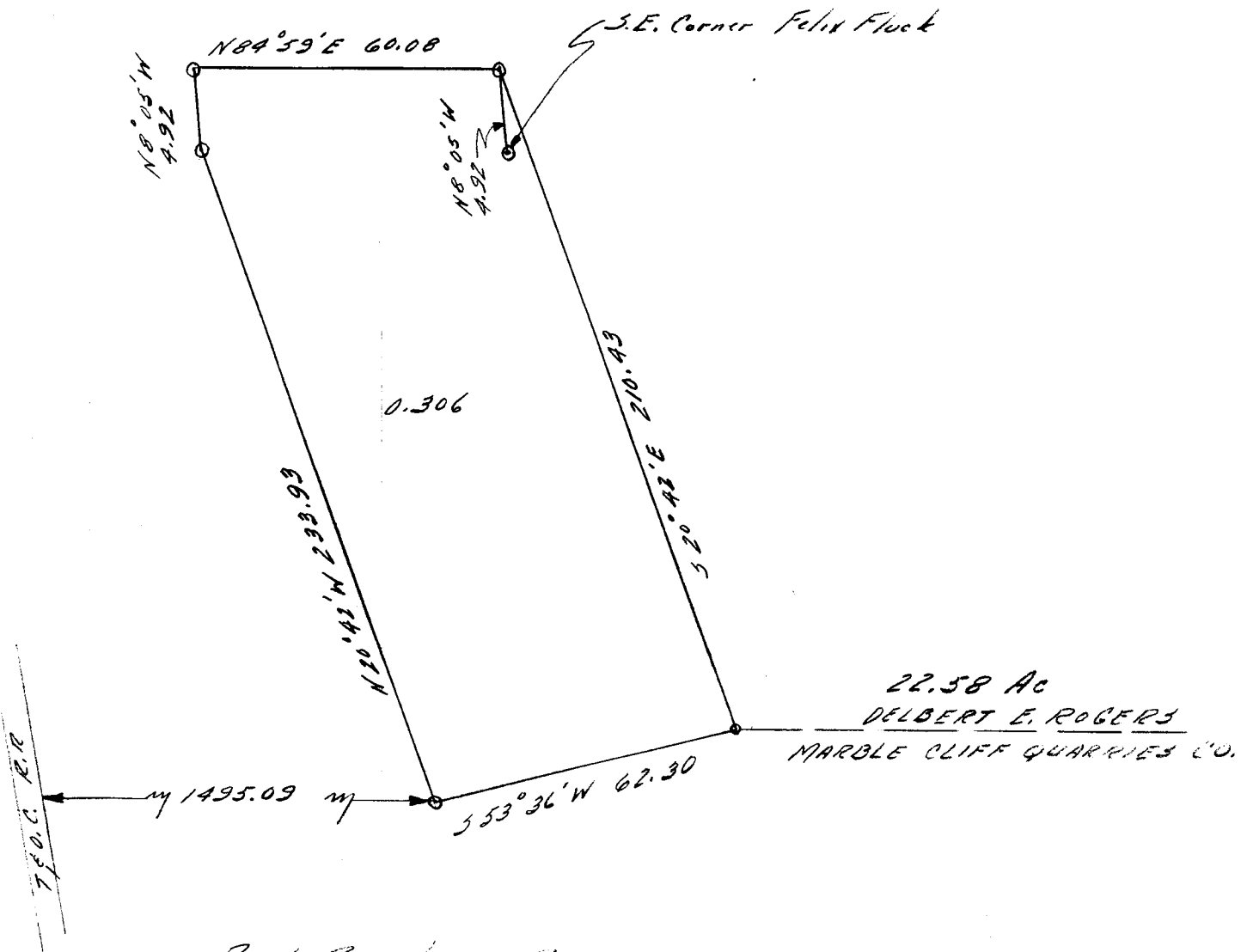

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of June, 1925, Dell E Rogers et al., filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, a petition praying for the establishment of a county road in Norwich Township, Franklin County, Ohio, described in said petition; and

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of June, 1925, said board of county commissioners did fix the 29th day of July, 1925, at 10 o'clock A. M. eastern standard time, on the line of said proposed road, as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 29th day of July, 1925, at 10 o'clock A. M. eastern standard time, at the office of the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for final hearing on said petition; and

WHEREAS, legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said county, was given of the time and place for the viewing of said location and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did on the 16th day of July, 1925, the day fixed for viewing of said proposed road, meet on the line thereof as described in the petition and heard all the proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify and did go over and along the line of said proposed road, and by actual view of the same and the premises along and adjacent thereto, which are to be affected thereby, does find that said establishment of if sufficient importance to require that the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

Commrs. Voting Aye thereon; Atcherson, Barthman and Westlake.

ESTABLISHING OF ROGERS ROAD AND
ABANDONING A PORTION OF MUDSOCK ROAD.

July 28, 1925

To the Hon. Board of County Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio.

Gentlemen: As per your resolution of July 16, a survey for the establishing of a county road known as the Rogers Road, Norwich Township, as petitioned for in a petition presented by Del E Rogers, et al. was completed and a plat of same is herewith attached showing lay-out of same.

In the establishing of this road, it is planned, as prayed for in the petition presented by Del E Rogers et al., to abandon the Mudsock Pike, Norwich Township, beginning at a point in the center of said Mudsock Road 60 feet northeasterly from the northeast corner of a 19.02 acre tract owned by Flora J Lane; thence in a northeasterly direction with the line of said Mudsock Road to the west right of way line of the Robinson Pike and there to terminate, being 1,851 feet in length, which road when vacated will return to the owners of the adjoining property, necessitating an outlet for the remaining part of the Mudsock Road, which outlet will be furnished by the establishing of a new road as petitioned for.

The proposed Rogers Road should be laid out 60 feet in width, and at the intersection of same with the Scioto and Darby Creek Road radii should be turned each way of 100 feet; also a 100 foot radius should be constructed at the intersection of the old Robinson road and the Scioto and Darby Creek road, to facilitate travel coming from the north over the new proposed road.

I would further recommend that no excavation be permitted on either side of the new proposed Rogers Road nor in the south side of the Scioto and Darby Creek road between the T and O C RR and the Robinson Pike within 80 feet of the center line of said roads.

From correspondence on file in your office as of date of June 1., 1925 I find that Mr. W H Rogers, President of the Board of Education of Special District No. 1, Norwich Township, advises that a new site must be secured for the location of the school which now stands on the old Robinson Road, said school being moved because of hazardous conditions, and from this correspondence I am to understand that in order to keep that district as at present a new road would have to be established to make the new site accessible to the traveling public, which is one of the main reasons for the establishing of the new proposed Rogers Road.

I further find correspondence from H J Kauffman, General Manager of The Marble Cliff Quarries Company to the effect that the entire cost of improving said new Rogers Road may be assessed directly against their property.

It is my understanding that the Robinson road from the Scioto and Darby Creek road to the intersection with the proposed Rogers road will remain as a county thoroughfare and not be abandoned at any future date.

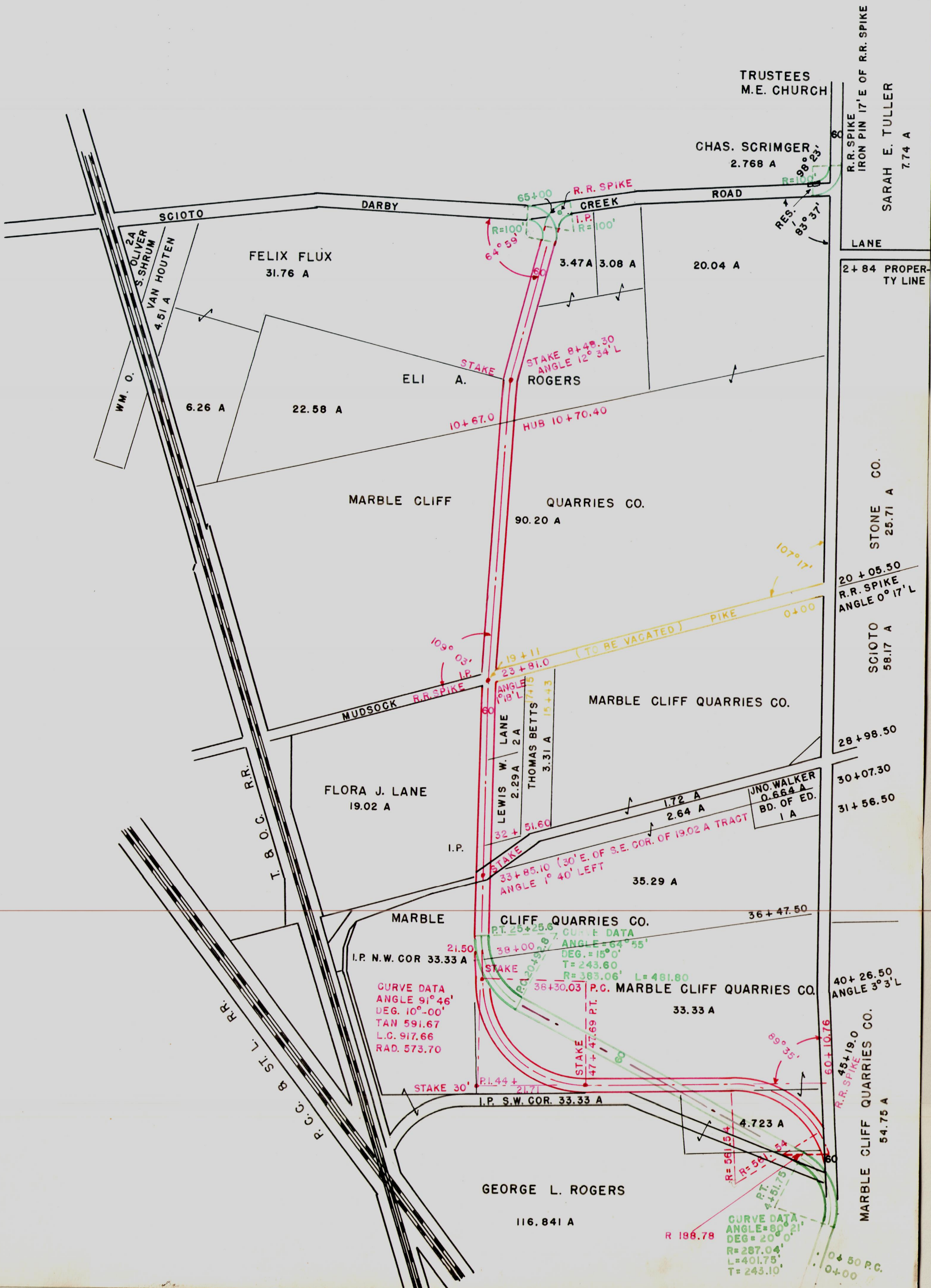
With the above conditions and considerations taken care of, and with the further understanding that Franklin County shall pay no claims for compensation or damages caused by the obtaining of the right of way of the fencing thereof; and that The Marble Cliff Quarries Company pay the entire cost for the preparing of the subgrade by grading and draining; the construction of the necessary culverts and water ways; and for the building of a three-course, 18 ft. bituminous-bound macadam pavement upon the proposed Rogers road (all to be in accordance with Franklin County standard specifications), I would, therefore recommend the establishment of the said Rogers road and the abandonment of the said Mudsock Road, as petitioned for.

M., eastern standard time, of July 29, 1925, said report to be in manner and form prescribed by section 6865 of the General Code; and

WHEREAS, On the 28th day of July, 1925, C C Lattimer, County Surveyor filed a report in said matter; and

WHEREAS, The board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, finds that the public utility and welfare require the establishment of said Rogers Road on the line and in accordance with recommendations shown on plat submitted by the county surveyor; therefore

ESTABLISHING OF ROGERS ROAD AND ABANDONING A PORTION OF MUDSOCK ROAD.....

July 28, 1925.

To the Hon. Board of County Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio.

Gentlemen: As per your resolution of July 16, a survey for the establishing of a county road known as the Rogers Road, Norwich Township, as petitioned for in a petition presented by Del E. Rogers, et al., was completed and a plat of same is herewith attached showing lay-out of same.

In the establishing of this road, it is planned, as prayed for in the petition presented by Del E. Rogers et al., to abandon the Mudsock Pike, Norwich Township, beginning at a point in the center of said Mudsock Road 60 feet northeasterly from the northeast corner of a 19.02 acre tract owned by Flora J. Lane; thence in a northeasterly direction with the line of said Mudsock Road to the west right of way line of the Robinson Pike and there to terminate, being 1,851 feet in length which road when vacated will return to the owners of the adjoining property, necessitating an outlet for the remaining part of the Mudsock Road, which outlet will be furnished by the establishing of a new road as petitioned for.

The proposed Rogers Road should be laid out 60 feet in width, and at the intersection of same with the Scioto and Darby Creek Road radius should be turned each way of 100 feet; also 100 foot radius should be constructed at the intersection of the old Robinson Road and the Scioto and Darby Creek Road, to facilitate travel coming from the North over the new proposed road.

I would further recommend that no excavation be permitted on either side of the new proposed Rogers Road nor in the south side of the Scioto and Darby Creek Road between the T. and O. C. R. R. and the Robinson Pike within 80 feet of the center line of said roads.

From correspondence on file in your Office as of date of June 1, 1925, I find that Mr. W. H. Rogers, President of the Board of Education of Special District No. 1, Norwich Township, advises that a new site must be secured for the location of the school which now stands on the old Robinson Road, said school being moved because of hazardous conditions, and from this correspondence I am to understand that in order to keep that district as at present a new road would have to be established to make the new site accessible to the traveling public, which is one of the main reasons for the establishing of the new proposed Rogers Road.

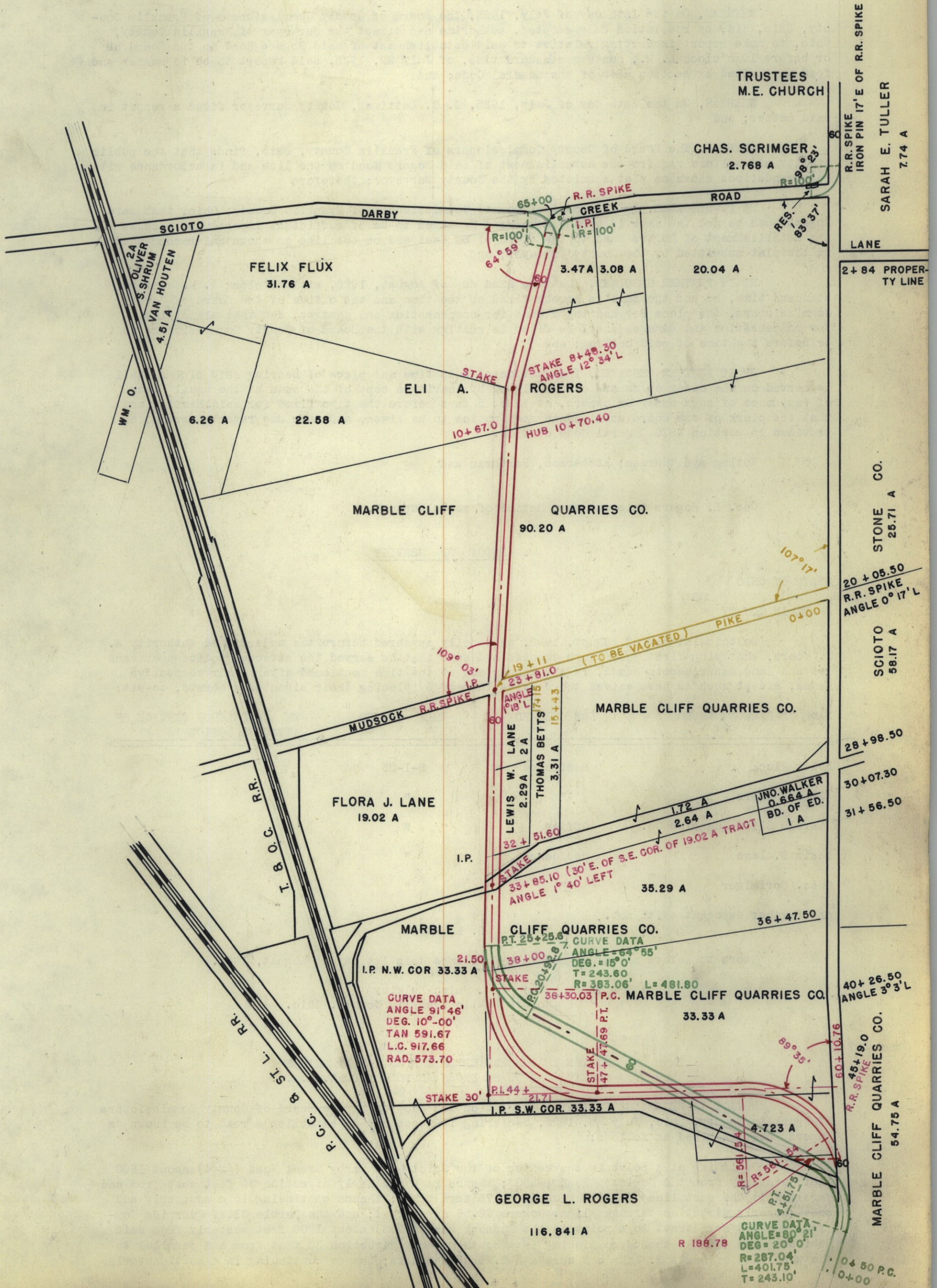
I further find correspondence from H. J. Kauffman, General Manager of The Marble Cliff Quarries Company to the effect that the entire cost of improving said new Rogers Road may be assessed directly against their property.

It is my understanding that the Robinson Road from the Scioto and Darby Creek road to the intersection with the proposed Rogers Road will remain as a county thoroughfare and not be abandoned at any future date.

With the above conditions and considerations taken care of, and with the further understanding that Franklin County shall pay no claims for compensation or damages caused by the obtaining of the right of way of the fencing thereof; and that The Marble Cliff Quarries Company pay the entire cost for the preparing of the subgrade by grading and draining; the construction of the necessary culverts and water ways; and for the building of a three-course, 18 ft. bituminous-bound macadam
