

This road record entry is a combination of the original road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Tax Map Department and the WPA transcribed road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Records Department. The WPA information was added to the original record to aid in reading the text or plats.

The information below refers to the WPA transcribed entries and was included in the front of each of those books:

Columbus, Ohio, July 11, 1930

To the Hon. Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio:

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the altering and widening of a public road on the line hereinafter described; and make application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises for altering and widening such road; the same not being a road on the State Highway System:

The following is the general route and termini of said road: Beginning at the intersection of the Cubbage Road (so called) (Road #188) with the Clymer Road (Road #18); thence northwardly with the line of said Cubbage Road to the Northwest corner of John W Boehm's 50 acre tract; thence continuing northwardly with or near the line between the Jos. S Platt 42 acre tract and the John W Boehm 17 acre tract to the intersection of the Cheever Road (Road #19), and there to terminate, being in Blendon Township, and being about 5150 feet in length.

Mr. Westlake offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Vigor.

WHEREAS, J W Boehm et al., on the 22nd day of July, 1930, presented a petition signed by at least twelve freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, residing in the vicinity of the proposed alteration and widening, requesting said Board to alter and widen a public road, the general route and termini thereof to be as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Cubbage Road (so called) (Road #188) with the Clymer Road (Road #18); thence northwardly with the line of said Cubbage Road to the northwest corner of John W Boehm's 50 acre tract; thence continuing northwardly with or near the line between the Jos. S Platt 42 acre tract and the John W Boehm 17 acre tract to the intersection of the Cheever Road (Road #19), and there to terminate, being in Blendon Township, and being about 5150 feet in length.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that August 19, 1930, at ten o'clock A.M. eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the date and hour when the Board of County Commissioners will view the proposed alteration and widening along the general route thereof; and that Wednesday, August 27, 1930, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the time and date for the final hearing on said petition and proposed alteration and widening, at the office of the Board of County Commissioners in the Courthouse of Franklin County, Ohio; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of the time and place for both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and having a general circulation in Franklin County, Ohio, where the proposed alteration and widening is located, and that said notice, in addition to the date and place of such view and place and time of the final hearing shall state briefly the character of the proposed alteration and widening.

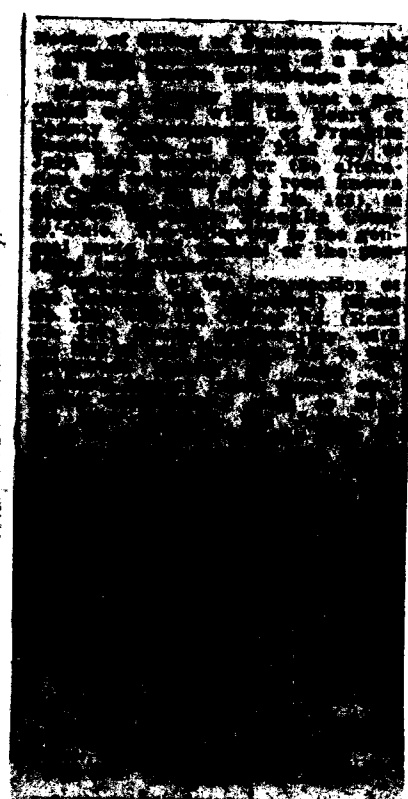

FRANKLIN CO. O., ROAD RECORD No. ~~13~~ Altering and Widening of Cabbage Road

August 19, 1930

In the matter of the petition filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, on July 22, 1930, for the altering and widening of Cabbage Road, in Blendon Township, Mr. Westlake offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Atcherson.

WHEREAS, On the 22nd day of July, 1930, a petition was filed with the Board by J. W. Boehm et al., praying for the altering and widening of Cabbage Road, in Blendon Township, Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, On the 23rd day of July, 1930, said Board of County Commissioners did fix the 19th day of August, 1930, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, on the line of said proposed improvement, as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 27th day of August 1930, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for final hearing on said widening and alteration; and.

WHEREAS, legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said county was given of the time and place for the viewing of said proposed improvement and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 19th day of August, 1930, the day fixed for the viewing of said proposed improvement, meet on the line thereof as described in the resolution, and heard all proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said proposed improvement, and by actual view of the same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto, which are to be affected thereby, does find that said proposed improvement is of sufficient importance to require that the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the Surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a plat and survey of the proposed improvement, an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which will be necessary to be taken, together with the names of each owner; shall set stakes at the termini of each right of way line and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed improvement may be discernible to property owners and others interested, and make report to the board of county commissioners on or before the 27th day of August, 1930, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time. Said report shall set forth the opinion of the County Surveyor either for or against the granting of said improvement, which report, together with the plat and survey of the proposed improvement shall be deposited with the Board of County Commissioners.

Voting Aye thereon: Atcherson and Westlake. Absent and not voting, Vigor.

Columbus, Ohio. August 27, 1930

To the Hon. Board of County Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio.

Gentlemen: As directed by your Board on August 19, 1930, I have surveyed and prepared a plat showing the proposed alteration and widening of the Cabbage Road in Blendon Township, as prayed for by J. M. Boehm et al., which I herewith submit, together with a list of the property owners along the line of said road, and the amount of land to be appropriated by said proposed widening, also the number of rods of fencing required.

I would recommend that said road be altered as shown on plat and widened to a width of fifty feet.

I would recommend the above proposed alteration for the following reason, viz: It will eliminate two very dangerous right-angle turns, providing instead a line of road practically straight.

I would recommend the proposed widening for the following reasons, viz; It will provide a width sufficient to allow of improvement by grading and macadamizing, whereas under the present width it would not be possible to properly improve the same.

Both the above recommendations would be conducive to the public utility and convenience, and I therefore recommend the improvement as specified.

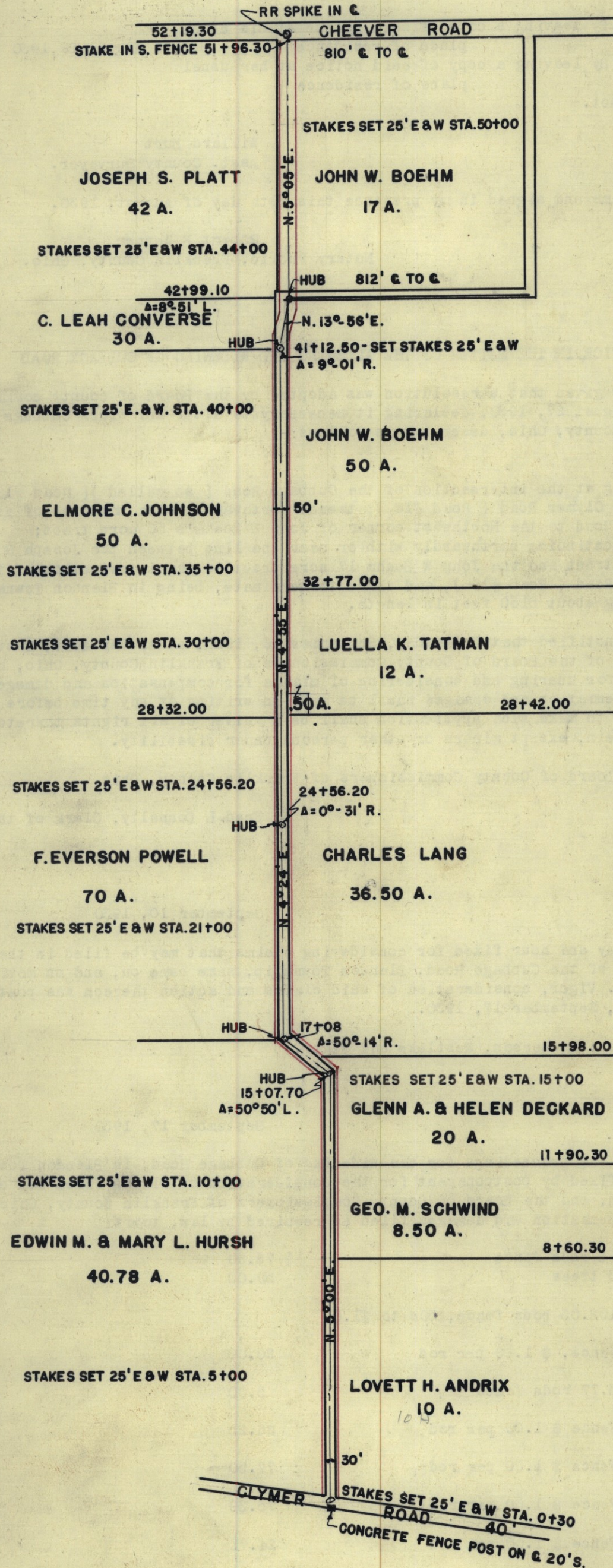

August 27, 1930

In the matter of the petition filed by J W Boekm et al., praying for the altering and widening of Cabbage Road, Blendon Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Westlake offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Atcherson.

WHEREAS, On the 19th day of August, 1930, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, by resolution duly adopted, authorize and direct the Surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, to make report in writing relative to the altering and widening of said Cabbage Road to the Board on or before ten o'clock A M., eastern standard time, of Wednesday, August 27, 1930; said report to be in manner and form prescribed by section 6865 of the General Code; and

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of August, 1930, R S Blackford, deputy county surveyor made report thereon; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, finds that the public utility and welfare require the altering and widening of said road as shown in the report and on the plat submitted by the county surveyor to a width of fifty feet; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that said Cabbage Road, be and the same is hereby found and declared to be of sufficient importance to cause the alteration and widening of said road to a width of fifty feet, and on the line as shown on the plat submitted by the county surveyor and as described in the petition; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Wednesday, September 10, 1930, at eleven o'clock A M., eastern standard time, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and the office of the board of county commissioners the place for hearing claims for compensation and damages, and that all claims for compensation and damages shall be filed in writing with the Board of County Commissioners on or before the time of said hearing; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of such time and place of hearing such claims shall be served on the owner or owners personally, or by leaving a copy of same at the usual place of residence of such owner or owners at least five days before the time fixed for said hearing and that the clerk of the Board shall cause such notice to be given, and make due report thereon as provided in section 6870 General Code of Ohio.
