

This road record entry is a combination of the original road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Tax Map Department and the WPA transcribed road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Records Department. The WPA information was added to the original record to aid in reading the text or plats.

The information below refers to the WPA transcribed entries and was included in the front of each of those books:

PUBLIC ROAD PETITION

To the Hon. Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio.

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the establishment of a public road on the line hereinafter described; and make application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises, for the establishment of such road; the same not being a road on the State Highway System.

The following is the general route and termini of said road:

Beginning at the intersection of North Main Street with Merion Street in the Village of Galloway, Ohio; thence continuing in a southwesterly direction along said Merion Street to Walnut Alley; thence continuing in a westerly direction across Lot No. 78 and across North High Street; thence crossing Lot No. 88 and there terminate; said point being the intersection with the present O'Harra Road leading west from Galloway, said road to be established to the width of forty feet, all located in Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio.

Mr. Vigor offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Shade.

WHEREAS, Frank H. Neer et al., on the 6th day of April, 1932, presented a petition signed by at least twelve freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, residing in the vicinity of the proposed establishment requesting said Board to establish O'Harra Road Extension, the general route and termini thereof to be as follows:-

Beginning at the intersection of North Main Street with Merion Street in the Village of Galloway, Ohio; thence continuing in a southwesterly direction along said Merion Road to Walnut Alley; thence continuing in a westerly direction across Lot No. 78 and across North High Street; thence crossing Lot No. 88 and there terminate; said point being the intersection with the present O'Harra Road leading west from Galloway, said road to be established to the width of forty feet, all located in Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that Friday, the 22nd day of April, 1932, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the date and hour when the Board of County Commissioners will view the proposed establishment along the general route thereof; and that Wednesday, April 27, 1932, at 10:30 o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the time and date for the final hearing on said petition and proposed establishment at the office of the Board of County Commissioners in the Court House of Franklin County, Ohio; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That notice of the time and place for both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Columbus Dispatch, a newspaper published in and having a general circulation in Franklin County, Ohio, where the proposed establishment is located, and that said notice in addition to the date and place of such view and place and time of the final hearing shall state briefly the character of the proposed establishment.

ment of a road to be known as O'Harra Road Extension, in Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio,
Mr. Vigor offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which
was duly seconded by Mr. Shade.

WHEREAS, On the 6th day of April, 1932, Frank H. Neer et al., filed with the Board of
County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, a petition praying for the establishment of a county
road in Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, described in said petition; and

WHEREAS, On the 6th day of April, 1932, said Board of County Commissioners did fix the 22nd
day of April, 1932, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, on the line of said proposed road
as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 27th day of April, 1932, at
ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of
Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for final hearing on said petition; and

WHEREAS, Legal notice by publication in the Columbus Dispatch, a newspaper published in and
of general circulation in said Franklin County was given of the time and place for the viewing
of said location and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 22nd day
of April, 1932, the day fixed for the viewing of the said proposed road, meet on the line thereof
as described in the petition, and heard all the proof offered by parties interested in and affect-
ed thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said
proposed road, and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto, which are
to be affected thereby, does find that the establishment of the said proposed road is of sufficient
importance to require that the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to
make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County Ohio, that the
Surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a plat and
survey of the proposed road, an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which
will be necessary to be taken, together with the names of each owner; shall set stakes at the
termini of each right of way line and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other
points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed road may be discernible to
property owners and others interested, and make report to the Board of County Commissioners on or
before the 27th day of April, 1932, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time. Said report
shall set forth the opinion of the County Surveyor either for or against the granting of said peti-
tion, which report, together with the plat and survey of the proposed improvement shall be depo-
sited with the County Commissioners.

Subject: Establishment of O'Harra Road Extension

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio.

Gentlemen: As directed by your Board on April 22, 1932, I have made a survey and prepared a plat of the proposed O'Harra Road Extension in Prairie Township, which I herewith submit together with a list of the property owners directly affected by said improvement, or establishment; also giving the amount of property to be appropriated.

I would recommend that the road be established on the line as amended and as shown on plat herewith submitted and to a width of forty feet.

I would recommend that the road be established for the following reasons, viz: It will be creating officially a road that has been in existence for many years across property over which it had no legal right, and will thereby put an end to a controversy that has existed for some years. It will also be of general public benefit and convenience.

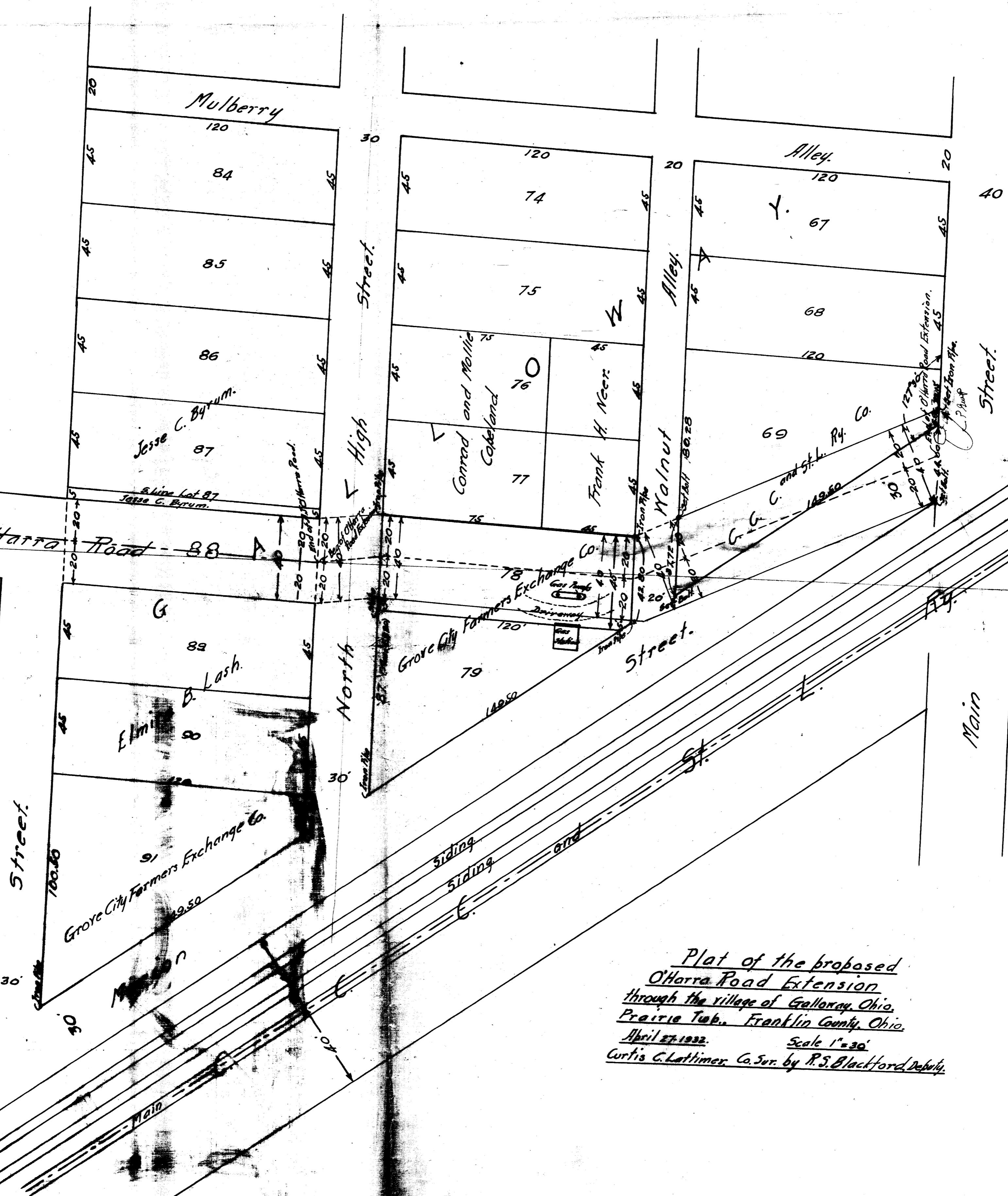

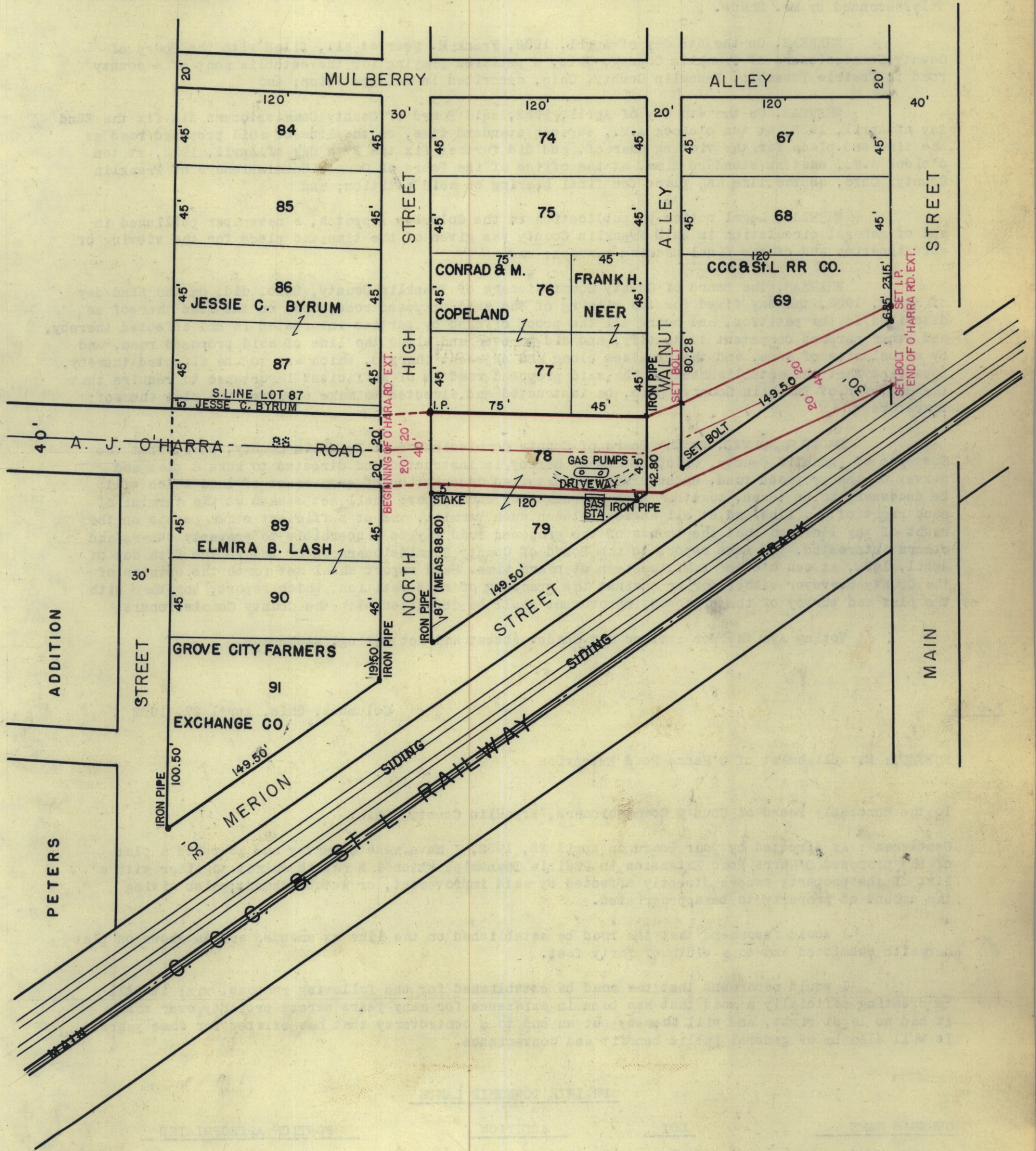

WHEREAS, On the 22nd day of April, 1932, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, by resolution duly adopted, authorize and direct the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, to make report in writing relative to the establishment of O'Harra Road Extension, to said board on or before 10:30 o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, of April 27, 1932; said report to be in manner and form prescribed by section 6865 of the General Code; and

WHEREAS, On the 27th day of April, 1932, R. S. Blackford, Deputy County Surveyor, made report thereon; and

WHEREAS, This being the day and hour fixed by postponement for the consideration and action on said Surveyor's report, same came on; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, finds that the public utility and welfare require the establishment of said road as amended and as shown in the report and on the plat submitted by the county surveyor to a width of forty (40) feet; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that said O'Harra Road extension be and the same is hereby found and declared to be of sufficient importance to cause the establishment of said road to a width of forty (40) feet, on the line as shown on the plat submitted by the county surveyor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Friday, May 20, 1932, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and the office of the Board of County Commissioners the place for hearing claims for compensation and damages, and that claims for compensation and damages shall be filed in writing with the Board of County Commissioners on or before the time of said hearing; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of such time and place of hearing said claims shall be served on the owner or owners personally, or by leaving a copy of the same at the usual place of residence of such owner or owners at least five days before the time fixed for said hearing, and the clerk of the Board shall cause such notice to be given, and make due report thereon as provided in section 6870 of the General Code of Ohio.
