

This road record entry is a combination of the original road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Tax Map Department and the WPA transcribed road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Records Department. The WPA information was added to the original record to aid in reading the text or plats.

The information below refers to the WPA transcribed entries and was included in the front of each of those books:

To the Hon. Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio.

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said county, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the establishment of a part of a public road on the line hereinafter described; and make application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises for establishing such road; the same not being a road on the state highway system.

The following is the general route and termini of said road:

Beginning at a point in said Holton Road near the southeast corner of the David Davies 100 acre tract; thence in a northeasterly direction, crossing the David Davies 3 acre tract, to a point in said Holton Road near the southeast corner of the David Davies 23.97 acre tract, and there terminate, being in all a distance of approximately 800 feet, and located in Jackson Township. Said right-of-way to be 50 feet in width - 25 feet each side of the above described center line.

PETITION TO ESTABLISH HOLTON ROAD FILED. VIEW JUNE 11, 1935 FINAL HEARING JUNE 29, 1935

Mr. Shade offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Paul.

WHEREAS, John I Miller et al on the 25th day of May, 1935, presented a petition to the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, signed by at least twelve freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, residing in the vicinity of the proposed establishment requesting said Board to establish a portion of the Holton Road, Jackson Township, the general route and termini thereof to be as follows:-

Beginning at a point in said Holton Road near the southeast corner of the David Davies 100 acre tract; thence in a northeasterly direction, crossing the David Davies 3 acre tract, to a point in said Holton Road near the southeast corner of the David Davies 23.97 acre tract, and there terminating, being in all a distance of approximately 800 feet, and located in Jackson Township. Said right-of way to be 50 feet in width 25 feet each side of the above described center line.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that Tuesday, June 11, 1935, at ten o'clock A.M. eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the date and hour when the board of county commissioners will view the proposed establishment along the general route thereof; and that Wednesday June 26, 1935, at ten o'clock A.M. eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the time and date for the final hearing on said petition and proposed establishment at the office of the board of county commissioners in the court house of Franklin County, Ohio; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of the time and place for both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and having a general circulation in Franklin County, Ohio, where the proposed establishment is located, and that said notice, in addition to the date and place of such view and place and time of the final hearing, shall state briefly the character of the proposed establishment.

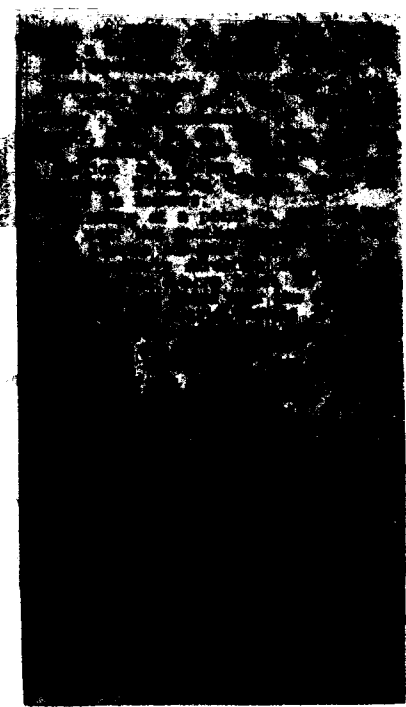

June 11, 1935

In the matter of the petition filed with the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, on the 25th day of May, 1935, for the establishment of a portion of Holton Road, Jackson Township, Mr. Shade offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Paul.

WHEREAS, On the 25th day of May, 1935, a petition was filed with this Board by John I Miller, et al, praying for the establishment of a portion of Holton Road, Jackson Township, Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, On the 25th day of May, 1935, said board of county commissioners did fix the 11th day of June, 1935, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, on the line of the proposed establishment as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 20th day of June, 1935, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, at the office of the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for final hearing on said proposed establishment; and

WHEREAS, Legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said county was given of the time and place for the viewing of said proposed establishment and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 11th day of June, 1935, the day fixed for the viewing of said proposed establishment, meet on the line of the said Holton Road as described in the petition, and heard all proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said road and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto, which are affected thereby does find that the said proposed establishment is of sufficient importance to require that the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a plat and survey of the road proposed to be established, an accurate and detailed description of the lands bordering thereon, together with the names of each owner; shall set stakes at the termini of each right of way lines and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the road may be discernible to property owners and others interested, and make report to the board of county commissioners on or before the 20th day of June, 1935, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time. Said report shall set forth the opinion of the county surveyor either for or against the granting of the petition, which report, together with the plat and survey of said road shall be deposited with the board of county commissioners.

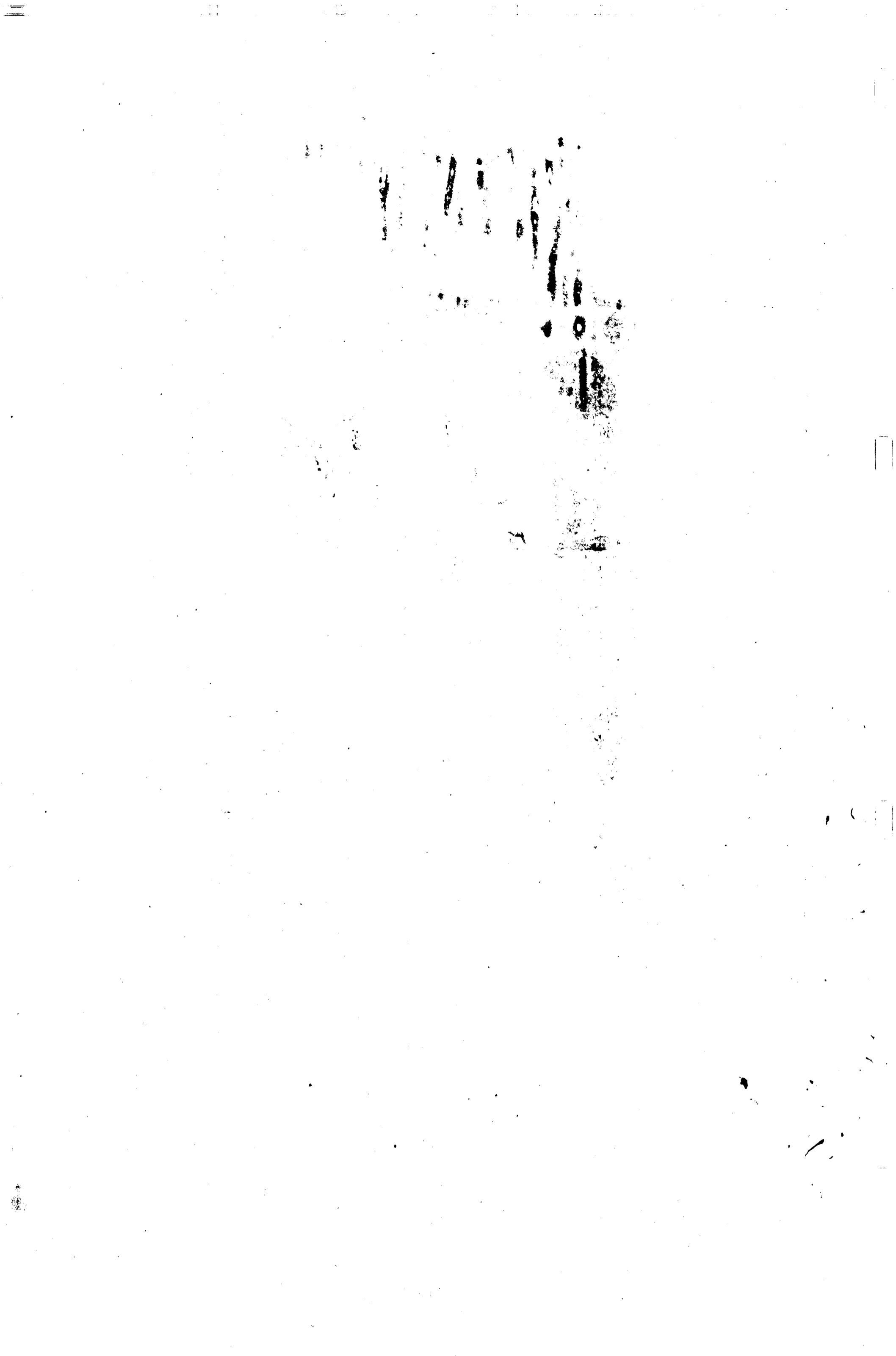

Establishment portion of Holton Road

June 6, 1935

In the matter of the establishment of a portion of Holton Road, Jackson Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Shade offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Paul.

WHEREAS, On the 11th day of June, 1935, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, by resolution duly adopted, authorize and direct the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, to make report in writing relative to the establishment of a portion of Holton Road, to this board on or before ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, of June 26, 1935; said report to be in manner and form prescribed by section 8365 of the General Code; and

AND WHEREAS, On the 26th day of June, 1935, Leo E Hirsch, Deputy County Surveyor, made a report thereon; and

AND WHEREAS, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, finds that the public utility and welfare require the establishment of a portion of said Holton Road, as shown in the report and on the plat submitted by the county surveyor to a width of fifty feet; therefore

IT IS RESOLVED, By the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that said portion of Holton Road herein referred to, be and the same is hereby found and declared to be of sufficient importance to cause the establishment of same to a width of fifty feet on the line as shown on the plat submitted by the county surveyor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Wednesday, July 3, 1935, at ten A. M., eastern standard time, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and the office of the Board of County Commissioners the place for hearing claims for compensation and damages, and that all claims for compensation and damages shall be filed in writing with the board of county commissioners on or before the time of said hearing and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of such time and place of hearing said claims shall be served on the owner or owners personally, or by leaving a copy of the same at the usual place of residence of such owner or owners at least five days before the time fixed for said hearing and that the clerk of the board shall cause such notice to be given and make due report thereon as provided in section 8370 of the General Code of Ohio.

NOTICE IN THE MATTER OF ESTABLISHMENT OF A PORTION OF HOLTON ROAD JACKSON TOWNSHIP FRANKLIN COUNTY OHIO.

Notice is hereby given that a resolution was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, June 26, 1935 declaring it necessary to establish a portion of Holton Road, described as follows:-

Beginning at a point in said Holton Road near the southeast corner of the David Davies 100 acre tract; thence in a northeasterly direction, crossing the David Davies 3 acre tract, to a point in said Holton Road near the southeast corner of the David Davies 25.37 acre tract, and there terminate, being in all a distance of approximately 600 feet, and located in Jackson Township. Said right-of-way to be fifty feet in width, 25 feet each side of the above described center line.

In the matter of the petition filed for the establishment of a portion of Holton Road, Jackson Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Shade offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Paul.

WHEREAS, This being the day and hour fixed by postponement for considering claims for compensation and damages that may be filed on account of the proposed establishment of a portion of Holton Road, same came on; and

WHEREAS, No objections to Plan "B" as submitted by the county surveyor on this day, nor claims for compensation or damages were filed in writing; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that it is the opinion of said board that said improvement is of sufficient importance to the public to cause the road to be established to a width of fifty feet on the line described below and on the line shown on plat submitted by the county surveyor, to wit:-

Beginning at a point in the center of Holton Road approximately 315 feet west of the southeast corner of David Davies 100 acre tract; thence in an easterly direction one degree and twenty minutes to the left of the center line of Holton Road 287.2 feet to the beginning of a six degree curve to the left; thence continuing along said curve 154.5 feet; thence continuing along a tangent to said curve 334 feet to the beginning of a twenty degree curve to the left; thence continuing along said curve 321.4 feet to a point in the center line of Holton Road, said point being approximately 130 feet north of the southeast corner of David Davies 23.97 acre tract and there terminate, being in all 1153.1 feet in length.
