

This road record entry is a combination of the original road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Tax Map Department and the WPA transcribed road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Records Department. The WPA information was added to the original record to aid in reading the text or plats.

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the establishing of a public road on the line hereinafter described; and make application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises for establishing such road; the same not being a road on the State Highway System.

The following is the general route and termini of said road:

Beginning at a point in the center of William Rowe Road, approximately 137 feet S. E. of the point where the center line of said Rowe Road crosses the section line between sections 10 and 3 of Range 22; thence in a northwesterly direction on a curve to the left, crossing the right of way of the Columbus Feeder of the Ohio Canal, to a point 40 feet north of said section line between sections 10 and 3 of Range 22 (said line being the property line between Lewis Morehead 47-A tract on the south and Rt. Rev. James J. Hartley 208.67 A tract on the north); thence westerly through the said 208.67 A tract of Rt. Rev. James J. Hartley, parallel to and 40 feet north of said section line between sections 10 and 3 and also 40 feet north of and parallel to the line between sections 9 and 4, Range 22, to the intersection of the Columbus and Chillicothe Road (State Highway No. 5) and there terminate, being in Hamilton Township, and about 1954 feet in length and sixty feet wide, 30 feet either side of the above described center line.

Mr. Vigor offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Shade.

WHEREAS, H W Wilcox et al on the 26th day of February 1936, presented a petition to the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, signed by at least twelve freeholders of Franklin County, Ohio, residing in the vicinity of the proposed establishment requesting said Board to establish Rowe Road, the general route and termini thereof to be as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of William Rowe Road, approximately 137 feet southeast of the point where the center line of said Rowe Road crosses the section line between sections 10 and 3 of Range 22; thence in a northwesterly direction on a curve to the left, crossing the right-of-way of the Columbus Feeder of the Ohio Canal, to a point 40 feet north of said section line between Sections 10 and 3 of Range 22 (said line being the property line between Lewis Morehead 47 acre tract on the south and Rt. Rev James J. Hartley 208.67 acres tract on the north); thence westerly through the said 208.67 acre tract of the Rt Rev. James J. Hartley, parallel to and 40 feet north of said section line between sections 10 and 3 and also 40 feet north of and parallel to the line between sections 9 and 4 Range 22, to the intersection of the Columbus and Chillicothe Road (State Highway No. 5) and there terminate, being in Hamilton Township, and about 1954 feet in length and 60 feet in width, 30 feet either side of the above described center line;

BE IT RESOLVED, By the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that Friday, March 13, 1936, at ten o'clock A. M., eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the date and hour when the Board of County Commissioners will view the proposed establishment along the general route thereof; and that Wednesday March 25, 1936, at ten o'clock A. M., eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the time and date for the final hearing on said petition and proposed establishment at the office of the Board of County Commissioners in the Court House of Franklin County, Ohio; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That notice of the time and place for both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and having a general circulation in Franklin County, Ohio, where the proposed establishment is located, and that said notice, in addition to the date and place of such view and place and time of the final hearing, shall state briefly the character of the proposed establishment.

WHEREAS, On the 26th day of February, 1936, a petition was filed with this Board by H W Wilcox, et al praying for the establishment of Rowe Road, Hamilton Township, Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, On the 26th day of February, 1936, said Board of County Commissioners did fix the 13th day of March, 1936, at ten o'clock A.M. eastern standard time, on the line of the proposed establishment as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 25th day of March, 1936, at ten o'clock A. M., eastern standard time at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for final hearing on said proposed establishment; and

WHEREAS, Legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said county was given of the time and place for the viewing of said proposed establishment and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did on the 13th day of March, 1936, the day fixed for the viewing of said proposed establishment, meet on the line of the said Rowe Road as described in the petition, and heard all proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said road and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto, which are affected thereby, does find that the said proposed establishment is of sufficient importance to require that the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a plat and survey of the said road proposed to be established, an accurate and detailed description of the lands bordering thereon, together with the names of each owner; shall set stakes at the termini of each right of way lines and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the road may be discernible to property owners and others interested, and make report to the Board of County Commissioners on or before the 25th day of March, 1936, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time. Said report shall set forth the opinion of the County Engineer either for or against the granting of the petition, which report, together with the plat and survey of said road shall be deposited with the Board of County Commissioners.

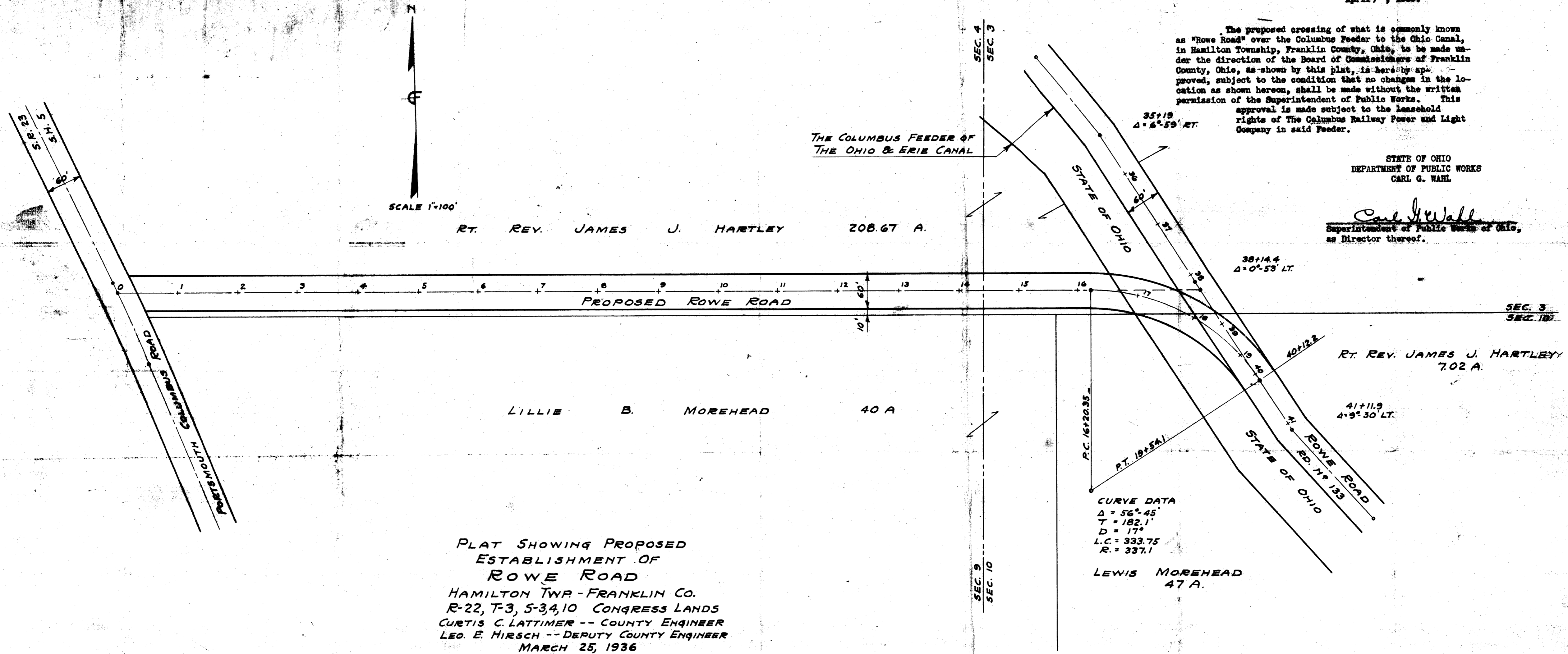

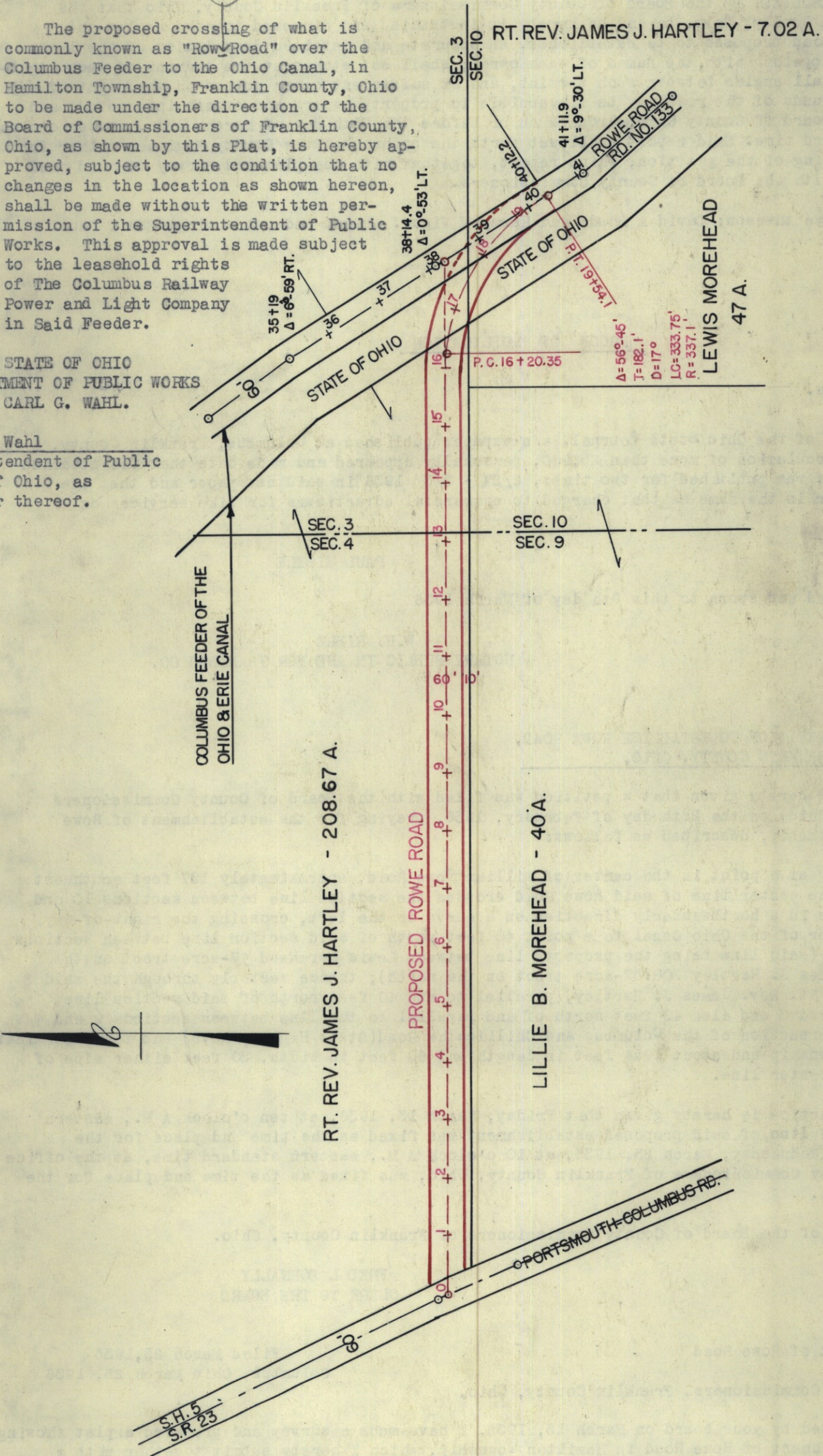

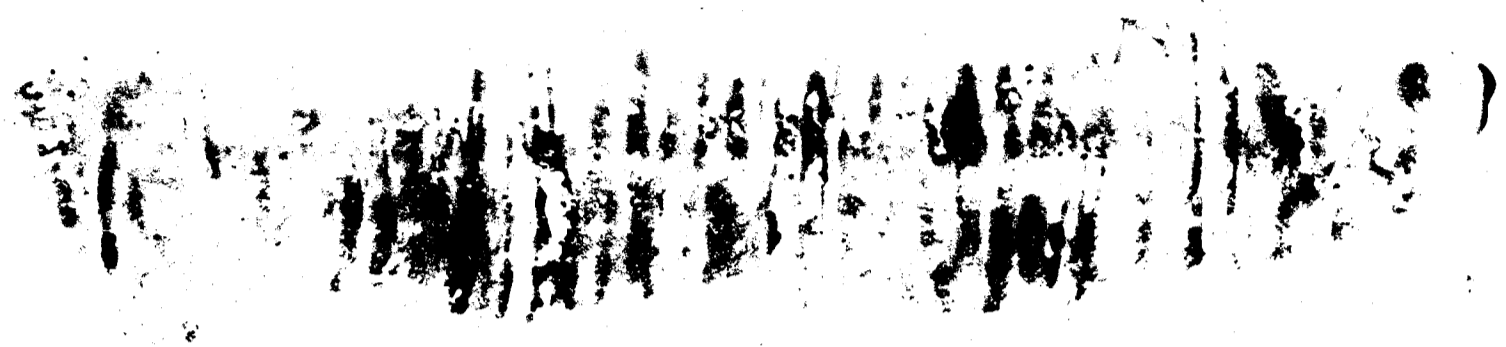
