

This road record entry is a combination of the original road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Tax Map Department and the WPA transcribed road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Records Department. The WPA information was added to the original record to aid in reading the text or plats.

Llewellyn Avenue - vacation from Groveport Road going east

May 15, 1937

Mr. Schneider offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Trabue.

WHEREAS, Section 6862 General Code of Ohio, provides that when the Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that it will be for the public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, they shall so declare by resolution; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, all of said Board being present and voting thereon and in favor thereof, that they do hereby declare that it is necessary for the public convenience and welfare that proceedings be had and taken to vacate part of a road known as Llewellyn Avenue as of original Cambria Subdivision of 1895 Marion Township, described as follows:

Being the part of southeast corner of Llewellyn Avenue and Groveport Pike, beginning at the northeast corner of Lot No. 82 of the original plat of Cambria Subdivision as of record in Plat Book #5, page 286, Recorder's office, Franklin County, Ohio; thence north four (4) degrees 00 east, thirty five (35) feet to a point; thence north eighty six (86) degrees west, 279.10' to a point; thence southerly with a curve, the angle of which is 138 degrees and radius 20.05 feet, 48.34 feet to the northwest corner of said Lot #82; thence south eighty four (84) degrees east, 288.04 feet, to the place of beginning, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Thursday, June 3, 1937, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, on the line of said proposed improvement be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for viewing same; and that Saturday, June 12th, 1937, at 10:30 o'clock A.M. eastern standard time, at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County Ohio, be and hereby is fixed as the time and place for final hearing thereon, and the clerk of the Board be and hereby is directed to cause legal publication thereof to be made in the Ohio State Journal.

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to your order of June 3, 1937, I have surveyed and prepared a plat showing the proposed vacation of a part of Llewellyn Avenue, as of original Cambria Subdivision of 1895, Marion Township, Franklin County, Ohio, which I herewith submit. Following is a corrected description of the said vacation:

Being the part of southeast corner of Llewellyn Avenue and Groveport Pike, beginning at the northeast corner of Lot No. 82 of the original plat of Cambria Subdivision as of record in Plat Book #5 page 286, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio; thence north four (4) degrees east, thirty-five (35) feet to a point; thence north eighty six (86) degrees west, 279.01 feet to a point; thence southerly with a curve the angle of which is one hundred thirty eight (138) degrees and fourteen (14) minutes and radius 20.24 feet, 48.83 feet to the northwest corner of said lot #82; thence south eighty six (86) degrees east, 292.36 feet to the place of beginning.

I would recommend the said vacation as described above and as shown on the plat submitted herewith, to correct an error in plat of Heiman-dale Addition as shown in Plat Book #7, page 330, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, when the two foot (2') reserve in Cambria Addition east of Groveport Pike owned by A. H. Mallery, Trustee, is deeded to Franklin County. The vacation of said part of road would be of no inconvenience to the public, as same is no longer of general public utility.

In the matter of the resolution of May 15, 1937, adopted by the Board of County Commissioners for the vacation of part of Llewellyn Avenue as of original Cambria Subdivision of 1895, Marion Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Schneider offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Trabue.

WHEREAS, On the 15th day of May 1937, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to vacate a part of Llewellyn Avenue as of original Cambria Subdivision of 1895, Marion Township, Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, On the 15th day of May 1937, said Board of County Commissioners did fix the 3rd day of June 1937, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, on the line of said proposed road vacation as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 12th day of June, 1937 at 10:30 o'clock A.M. eastern standard time at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for final hearing on said vacation; and

WHEREAS, Legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said county, was given of the time and place for the viewing of said vacation and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 3rd day of June 1937, the day fixed for the viewing of the said proposed road vacation, meet on the line thereof, as described in the petition, and heard all the proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said proposed road, and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto, which are to be affected thereby, does find that the vacation of part of Llewellyn Avenue as of original Cambria Subdivision of 1895, is of sufficient importance to require that the engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, that the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a plat and survey of the proposed road vacation, an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which will be necessary to be taken, together with the names of each owner; shall set stakes at the termini of each right of way line and at sufficient other points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed road vacation may be discernible to property owners and others interested, and make report to the Board of County Commissioners on or before the 12th day of June, 1937 at 10:30 o'clock A.M., eastern standard time. Said report shall set forth the opinion of the County Engineer either for or against the granting of said vacation, which report, together with the plat and survey of the proposed vacation shall be deposited with the County Commissioners.

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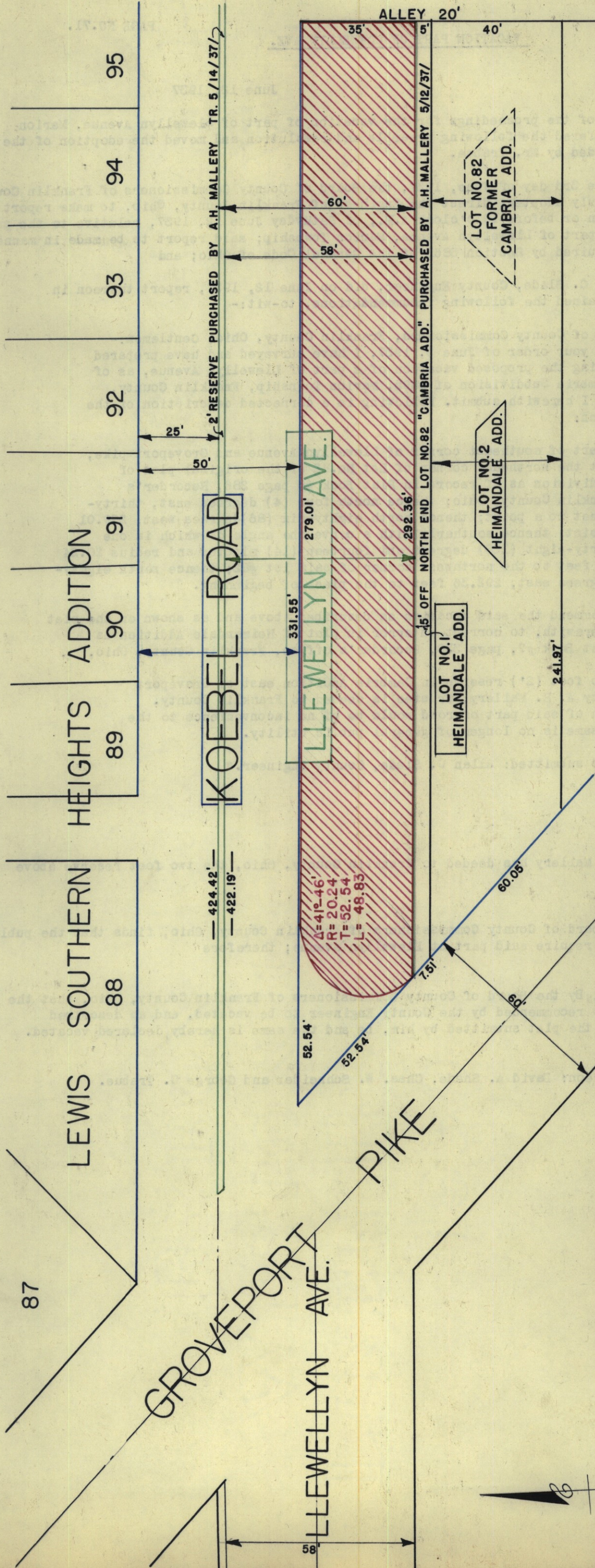




PORTION TO BE VACATED

 PLAT ACCORDING TO HEIMANDALE ADD.

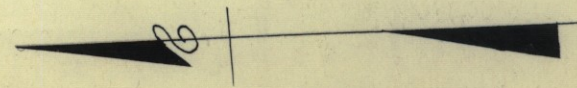


VACATION (PART)
