

This road record entry is a combination of the original road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Tax Map Department and the WPA transcribed road record book found in the Franklin County Engineer's Records Department. The WPA information was added to the original record to aid in reading the text or plats.

The information below refers to the WPA transcribed entries and was included in the front of each of those books:

Mr. Schneider offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Trabue.

WHEREAS, Section 6862 General Code of Ohio, provides that when the board of county commissioners is of the opinion that it will be for the public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, they shall so declare by resolution; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, all of said board being present and voting thereon and in favor thereof, that they do hereby declare that it is necessary for the public convenience and welfare that proceedings be had and taken to widen a road to be known as Ackerman Road, Clinton Township, to a width of 60 feet, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection with the Lisle Road; thence in a northwesterly direction to the intersection with the Kenny and Fishingier Roads, approximately 0.45 miles in length and to be widened from 40 feet to 60 feet; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Thursday, May 6, 1937 at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, on the line of said proposed improvement be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for viewing same; and that Wednesday, May 19, 1937, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, be and hereby is fixed as the time and place for final hearing thereon, and that the clerk of the board be and hereby is directed to cause legal publication thereof to be made in the Ohio State Journal.

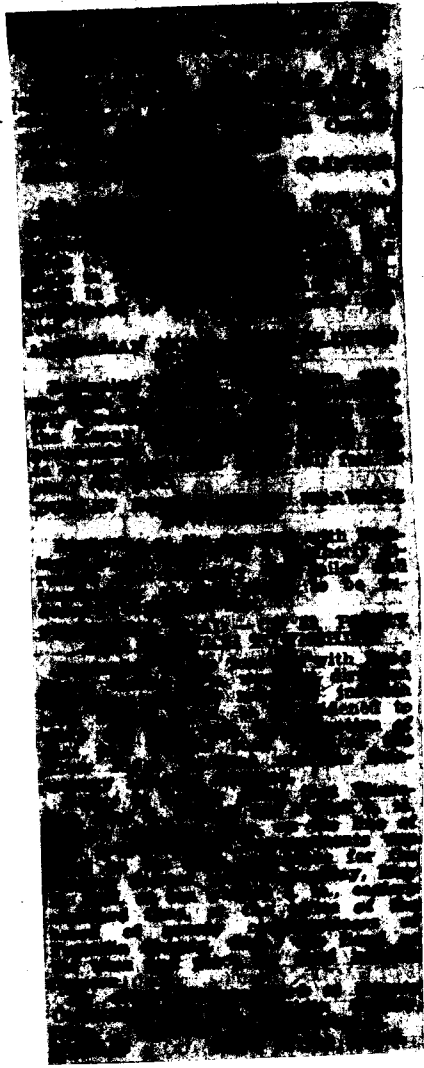

In the matter of the resolution of April 17, 1937, adopted by the Board of County Commissioners for the widening of Ackerman Road, Clinton Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Schneider offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Trabue.

WHEREAS, On the 17th day of April, 1937, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to widen Ackerman Road, Clinton Township, Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, On the 17th day of April, 1937, said board of county commissioners did fix the 6th day of May, 1937, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, on the line of said proposed road widening as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 19th day of May, 1937, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, at the office of the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for final hearing on said widening; and

WHEREAS, Legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said county was given of the time and place for the viewing of said location and of the final hearing thereon; and

Widening of Ackerman Road

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 6th day of May, 1937, the day fixed for the viewing of the said proposed road widening, meet on the line thereof, as described in the petition, and heard all the proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify, and did go over and along the line of said proposed road, and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto, which are to be affected thereby, does find that the widening of Ackerman Road is of sufficient importance to require that the engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the surveyor of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a plat and survey of the proposed road widening, an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which will be necessary to be taken, together with the names of each owner; shall set stakes at the termini of each right of way line and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed road widening may be discernible to property owners and others interested, and make report to the board of county commissioners on or before the 19th day of May, 1937, at ten o'clock A.M., eastern standard time. Said report shall set forth the opinion of the county engineer either for or against the granting of said improvement, which report, together with the plat and survey of the proposed improvement, shall be deposited with the county commissioners.

Subject: Proposed Widening of Ackerman Road.
Land sought to be appropriated

Hon. Board of County Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio. Gentlemen: Pursuant to your order of May 6, 1937, I have made a survey and plat which is submitted herewith showing the proposed widening of Ackerman Road, in Clinton Township to a width of 50 feet, together with a list of the property owners along the said road and the land to be taken.

I believe that a 50 foot width instead of a 60 foot road width as mentioned in the resolution of April 17, 1937, will be ample for the establishment of a proper roadway section, whereas the existing forty foot width would be inadequate. I am of the opinion that the proposed widening of the road to a 50 foot width will be of general public welfare and convenience and therefore recommend the proposed widening as shown on the accompanying plat. In the matter of the proceedings for the widening of Ackerman Road, Clinton Township, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Schneider offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Trabue.

WHEREAS, On the 6th day of May, 1937, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, by resolution duly adopted authorize and direct the engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, to make report in writing relative to the widening of Ackerman Road, to said board on or before ten o'clock A. M., eastern standard time, of Wednesday, May 19, 1937, said report to be in manner and form prescribed in section 6865 of the general code; and

WHEREAS, this 19th day of May, 1937, was fixed as the final hearing in said matter, and the county engineer having filed his report thereon; and

WHEREAS, the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, finds that the public welfare and convenience require the widening of Ackerman Road, as shown in the report and on the plat submitted by the county engineer, to a width of 50 feet; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the board of county commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that said Ackerman Road herein referred to, is hereby found and determined to be of sufficient importance to the public convenience and welfare to cause the widening thereof to 50 feet, and as shown on plat submitted by the county engineer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Wednesday, June 9, 1937, at ten o'clock A. M. eastern standard time be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and the office of this Board the place for hearing and considering claims for compensation and damages in said matter, and all claims shall be filed in writing with the board on or before the time of said hearing; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of the time and place for hearing said claims shall be served on the owner or owners personally or by leaving a copy of the same at the usual place of residence of such owner or owners at least five days before the time fixed for said hearing, and the clerk of the board shall cause such notice to be given and make due report thereon as provided in section 6870 of the general code of Ohio.

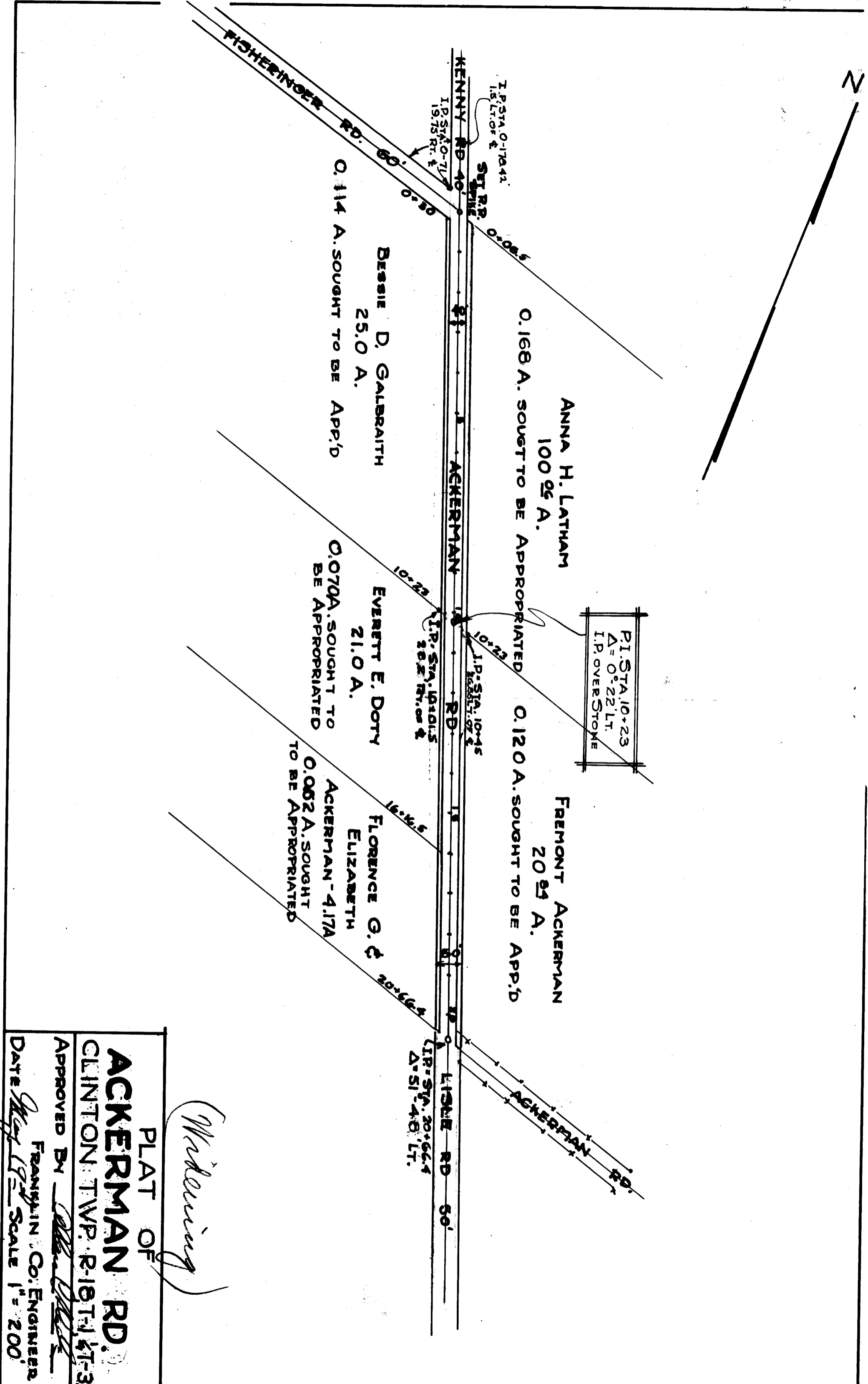

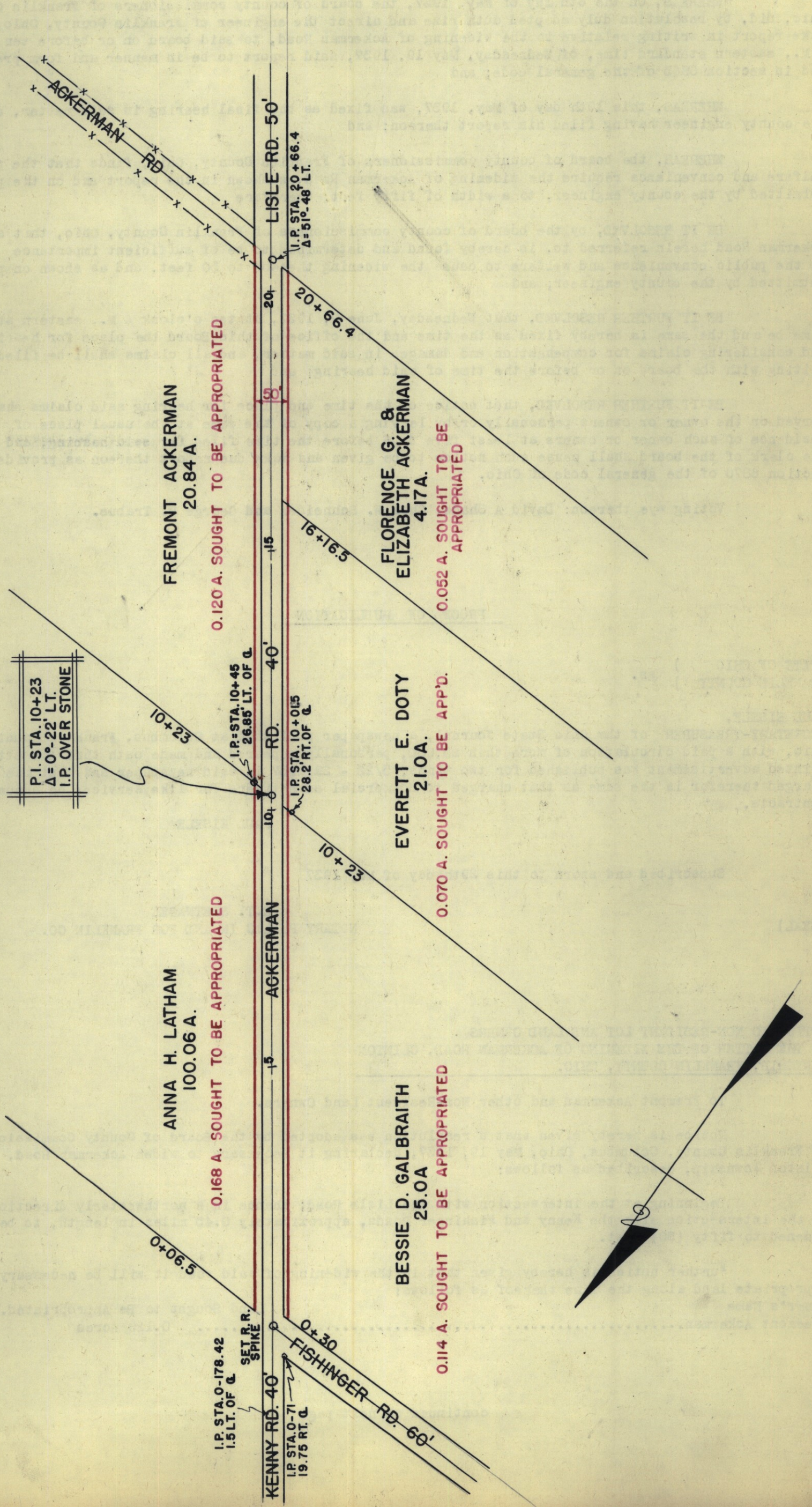
