Beginning at the point of intersection of the center lines of Refugee Road and the Columbus Lancaster Road (U.S. #33); thence in an easterly direction along the center line of Refugee Road a distance of approximately 6100 feet to the point of intersection of the said center lines of Refugee Road with the center line of Barnett Road, a distance of approximately 1.15 miles;

and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Thursday, March 30, 1939, at ten o'clock A.M., Eastern Standard Time, on the line of said proposed improvement be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for viewing same; and that Wednesday, April 12, 1939, at 10:30 o'clock A.M., Eastern Standard Time, at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, be and hereby is fixed as the time and place for Final Hearing thereon, and that the Clerk of the Board be and hereby is directed to cause legal publication thereof to be made in the Ohio State Journal.

In the matter of the resolution of March 11, 1939, adopted by the Board of County Commissioners for the widening and alteration of Refugee Road, Truro and Madison Townships, Franklin County, Ohio, Mr. Schneider offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same, which was duly seconded by Mr. Vigor.

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of March, 1939, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to alter and widen Refugee Road along the Township Line dividing Truro and Madison Townships, Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of March, 1939, said Board of County Commissioners did fix the 30th day of March, 1939, at ten o'clock A.M., Eastern Standard Time, on the line of said proposed road alteration as the time and place for the viewing thereof, and did further fix the 12th day of April, 1939, at 10:30 o'clock A.M., Eastern Standard Time, at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, as the time and place for final hearing on said alteration; and

WHEREAS, legal notice by publication in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and of general circulation in said County was given of the time and place for the viewing of said location and of the final hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, on the 30th day of March, 1939, the day fixed for the viewing of the said proposed road alteration, meet on the line thereof, as described in the petition, and heard all the proof offered by parties interested in and affected thereby, and other persons competent to testify and did go over and along the line of said proposed road, and by actual view of same, and the premises along and adjacent thereto, which are to be affected thereby, does find that the alteration of Refugee Road is of sufficient importance to require that the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be instructed and directed to make a survey and plat thereof; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, be and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a plat and survey of the proposed road widening and alteration; an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which will be necessary to be taken together with the names of each owner; shall set stakes at the termini of each right of way line and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other points in the right of way lines, so that the bounds of the proposed road widening and alteration may be discernible to property owners and others interested, and make report to the Board of County Commissioners on or before the 12th day of April, 1939, at 10:30 o'clock A.M., Eastern Standard Time. Said report shall set forth the opinion of the County Engineer either for or against the granting of said improvement, which report, together with the plat and survey of the proposed improvement, shall be deposited with the County Commissioners.

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to your order of March 30, 1939, I have made a survey and plat, which I hereby submit, of a portion of Refugee Road in Truro and Madison Townships, showing the proposed alteration and widening of said road to a right of way width of fifty (50) feet and sixty (60) feet, said alteration and widening to be along the following described center line:

(X) Beginning at the point of intersection of the present center lines of Refugee Road and the Columbus-Lancaster Road (U.S.R. #33); thence in an easterly direction along the present center line of Refugee Road, said center line being also the Township Line dividing the Townships of Truro and Madison, a distance of 351 feet to a point; this portion of the road to be widened 10 feet on the south side only, due to existing structures located on the north side of said road, and the expense of removing the same; thence continuing along the center line of said Refugee Road in an easterly direction a distance of 1734.7 feet to a point; this portion of the road to be widened 10 feet on both north and south sides; thence in an easterly direction a distance of 682.1 feet to a point; this portion of road to be widened 10 feet on the south side only, as the said road has been previously widened 10 feet on the north side by Easement (See Deed Book #1106, Page #420, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio); thence continuing along the said center line of Refugee Road in an easterly direction a distance of 2222.4 feet to a point; this portion of the road to be widened 10 feet on both north and south sides; thence continuing along the said center line of Refugee Road in an easterly direction a distance of 1161.3 feet to the point of intersection of the center lines of Barnett Road and Refugee Road; this portion of the road to be widened 10 feet on the north side only as the said road has previously been widened 10 feet on the south side by Easement (See Deed Book #1106, page #422, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio).

I am also submitting a list of the property owners affected by the proposed alteration and widening, and the amount of land to be appropriated.

I am of the opinion that the proposed alteration and widening of the right of way width of Refugee Road, from a width of forty (40) feet to sixty (60) feet, excepting the western portion of 351 feet along the north side, where the expense of removing existing structures does not justify the widening along that said north side, will be of general public welfare and convenience, and I therefore recommend the said alteration and widening as shown on the accompanying plat.

WHEREAS, on the 30th day of March, 1939, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, by resolution duly adopted, authorize and direct the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, to make report in writing relative to the widening and alteration of Refugee Road to said Board on or before 10:30 o'clock A.M., Eastern Standard Time, of Wednesday, April 12, 1939; said report to be in manner and form prescribed in Section 6865 of the General Code; and

WHEREAS, this 12th day of April, 1939, was fixed as the final hearing in said matter, and the County Engineer having filed his report thereon; and

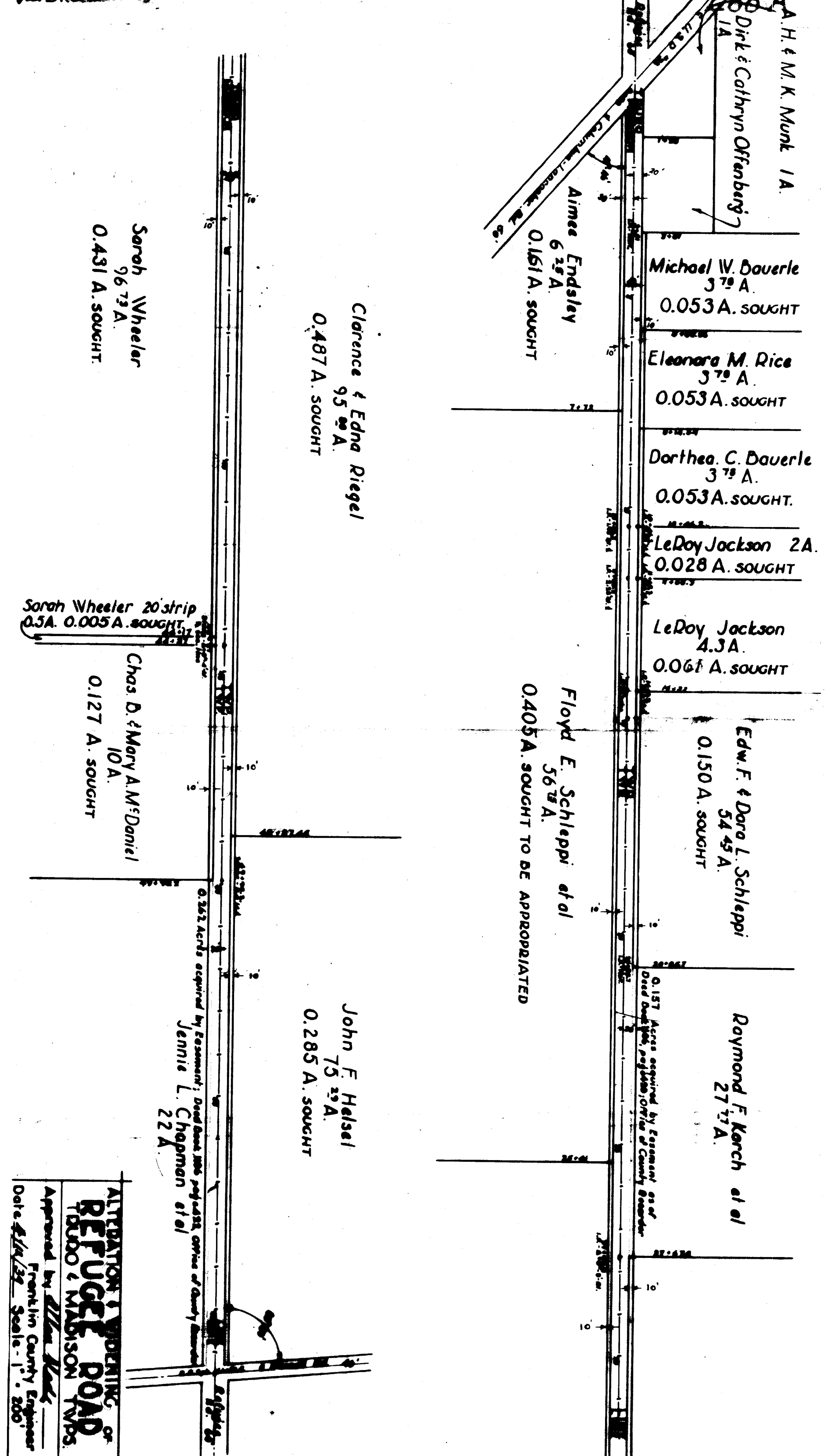
