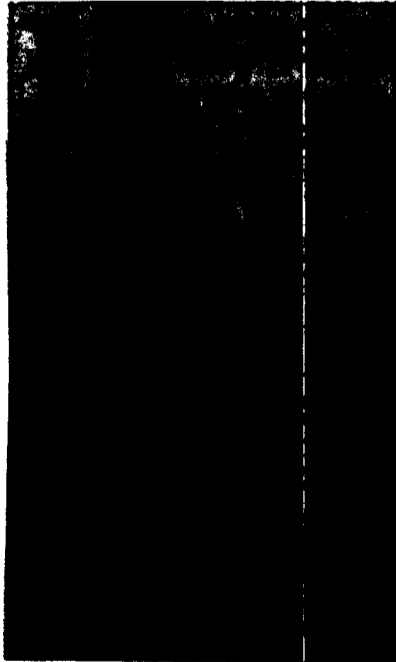

This report shall set forth the opinion of the County Engineer either for or against the granting of said vacation, which report, together with the plat and survey of the proposed vacation shall be deposited with the County Commissioners.

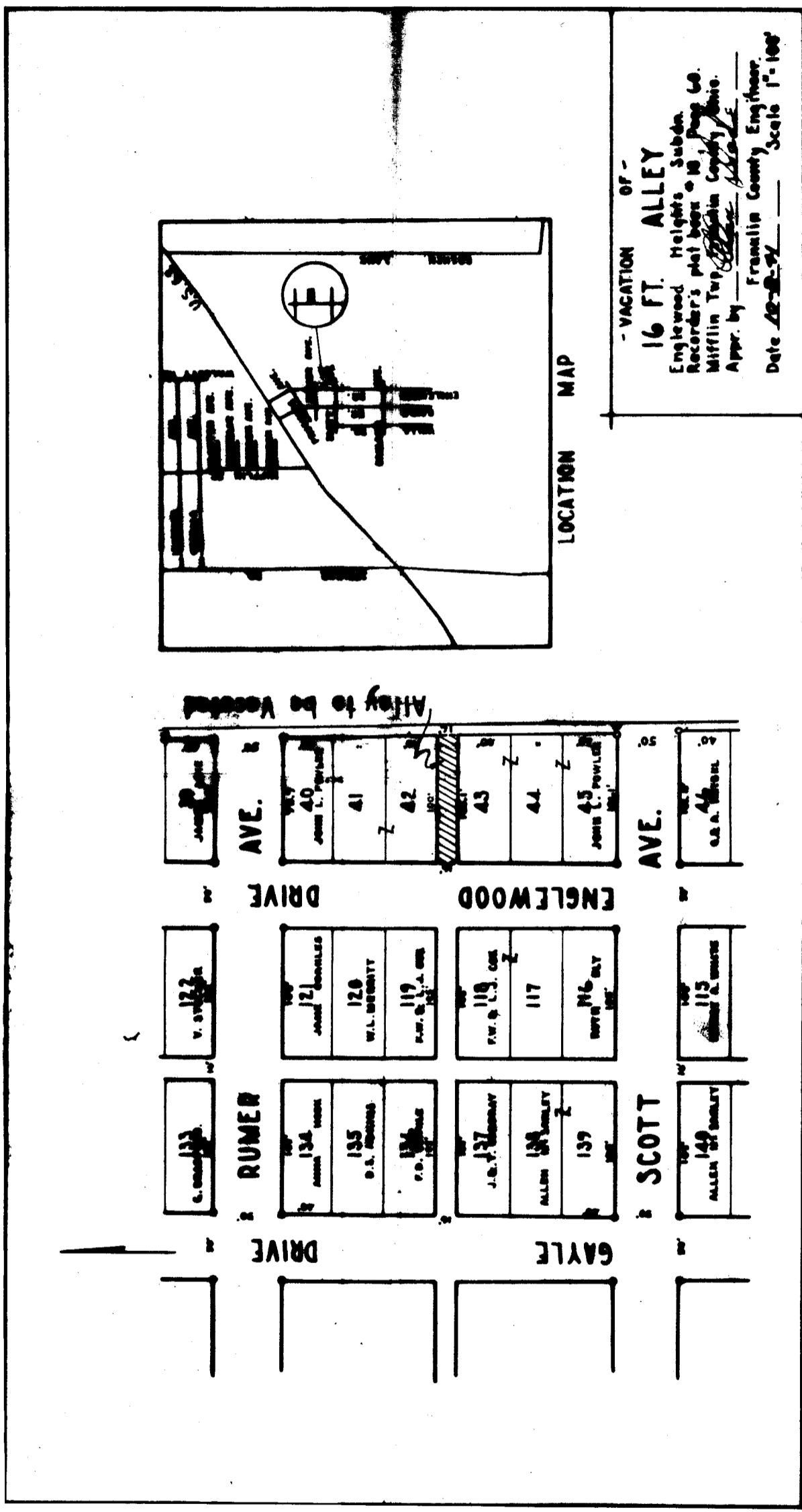
