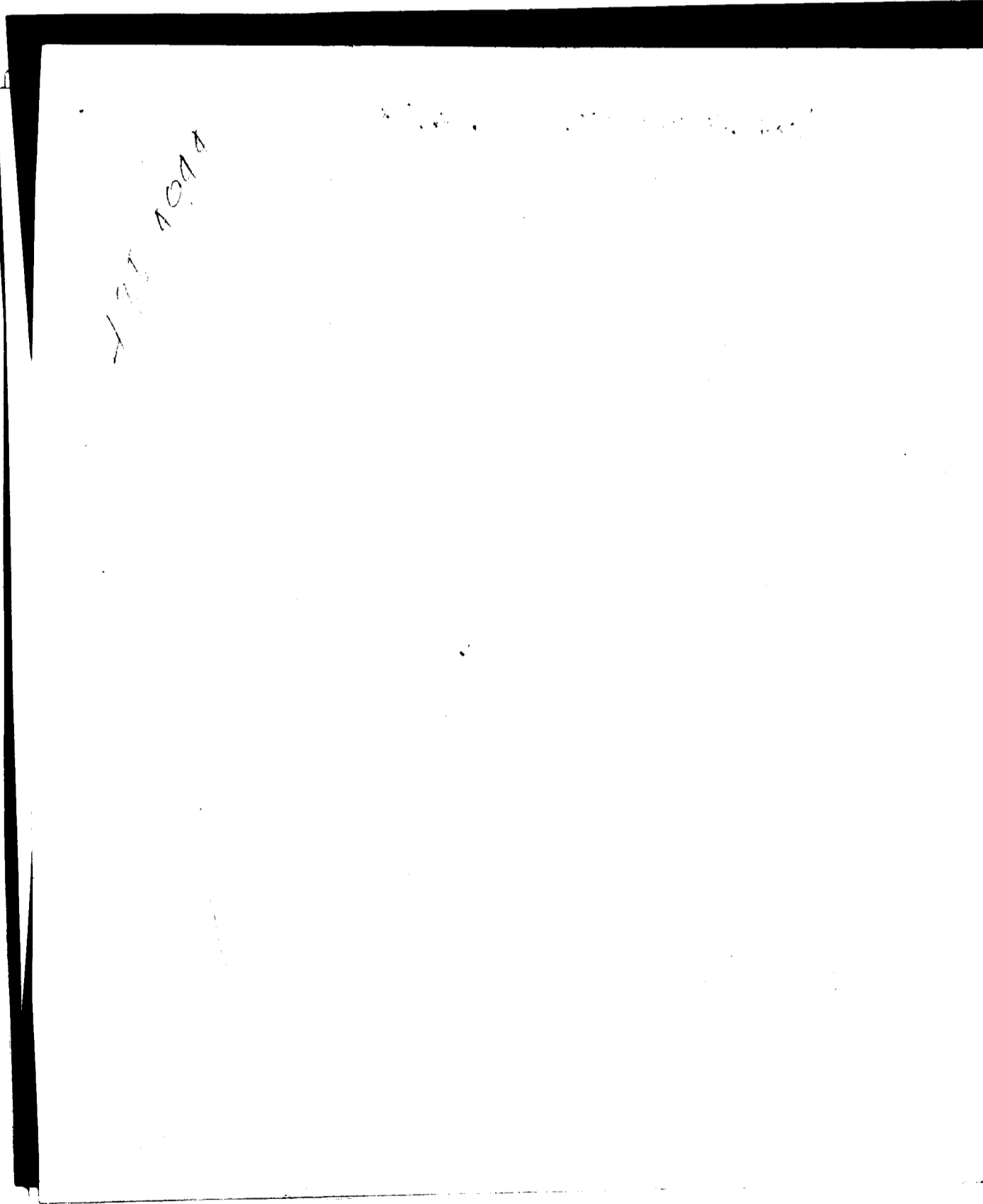
Hirth Road - dedication from Tuttle Road south to the south line of Virgil Jacobs

PLAT OF DEDICATION OF HIRTH ROAD  
WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP ACCEPTED BY  
BOARD

September 5 1942

On motion of Mr. Matson, seconded by Mr. Lauderbaugh, the Plat of dedication of Hirth Road, situated in survey No. 2418 and No. 3022, Virginia Military Lands, Washington Township, Franklin County, Ohio, being a strip of ground 50 feet wide, (10 feet off the west side of V. M. S. 2418 and 40 feet off the east side of V.M.S. 3022), beginning at the south right-of-way line of Tuttle Road and thence in a southeasterly direction to the south line and south line extended of Virgil E. and Cleo E Jacobs, 15 acre tract, presented by Virgil E. Jacobs, et al., be and the same is hereby accepted by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, and said Hirth Road therein dedicated to public use for road and other public purposes consistent therewith, accepted as such.
