 MARION TOWNSHIP ACCEPTED BY BOARD OF
 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

On motion of Mr. Lauderbaugh, seconded by Mr. Vigor, the plat of dedication of Twentieth Street, Marion Township, being a strip of land 50 feet in width to be known as Twentieth Street, extending from the north line of Woodrow Avenue to the south line of Markison Avenue, the center line of which 50 ft. strip runs N. 3 degrees 36' E. from a point in the center line of Woodrow Avenue 692.82' S. 86 degrees 24' E. from the intersection of the center lines of Woodrow Ave., and S. Eighteenth St., and the portions of Morrill Avenue 35' in width and Welch Ave., 25' in width lying between said Twentieth St. and the present East Corporation line of the City of Columbus, all of which are out of the land owned by the Columbus Metropolitan Housing Authority and known as the Lincoln Park Homes, Project Ohio-1-2, presented by Columbus Metropolitan Housing Authority, C. L. Doll, Jr. Vice-Chairman and Orlando Corzilius, Secretary, be and the same is hereby accepted by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, and said Twentieth Street therein dedicated to public use for streets and other public purposes consistent therewith, accepted as such.

Description of Land Dedicated

Situated in the County of Franklin, State of Ohio and Township of Marion, being a strip of land 50 ft. in width to be known as Twentieth Street, extending from the north line of Woodrow Avenue to the south line of Markison Ave., the line of which 50 ft. strip runs N. 3°36' E from a point in the center line of Woodrow Ave. 692.82' S 86° 24' E. from the intersection of the center lines of Woodrow Ave. and S. Eighteenth St.; and the portions of Corrill Avenue 35' in width and Welch Ave. 25' in width lying between said Twentieth St. and the present East Corporation line of the City of Columbus, all of which are out of the land owned by the Columbus Metropolitan Housing Authority and known as the Lincoln Park Project Ohio-1-2.
