PETITION

The undersigned petitioners, freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the vacating of a public Road on the line hereinafter described; and make application to you/ to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises, for vacating such road; the same not being a road on the State Highway System.

The following is the general route and termini of said road:

Being the 15foot alley south of Strimple Avenue and north of Kilbourne Avenue, in Villa Park Addition, Sharon Township, beginning at the west line of a 20 foot alley (formerly lots numbered 23 and 96, dedicated and accepted for public use, see Commissioners Journal 27, page 163); thence westerly to the east line of Avalon Avenue and there to terminate.

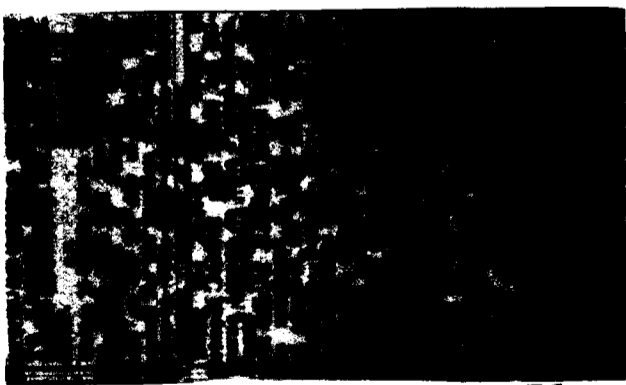

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, that Monday, March 24, 1948, at 10 o'clock A.M. eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the date and hour when the Board of County Commissioners will view the proposed vacation along the general route thereof; that Tuesday, March 30, 1948, at 10 o'clock A.M., eastern standard time, is hereby fixed as the time and date for the final hearing on said petition and proposed vacation at the office of the Board of County Commissioners in the Court House of Franklin County, Ohio; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That notice of the time and place for both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Ohio State Journal, a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Franklin County, Ohio, where the proposed vacation is located, and that said notice in addition to the date and place of such view, and place and time of the final hearing, shall state briefly the character of the proposed vacation.

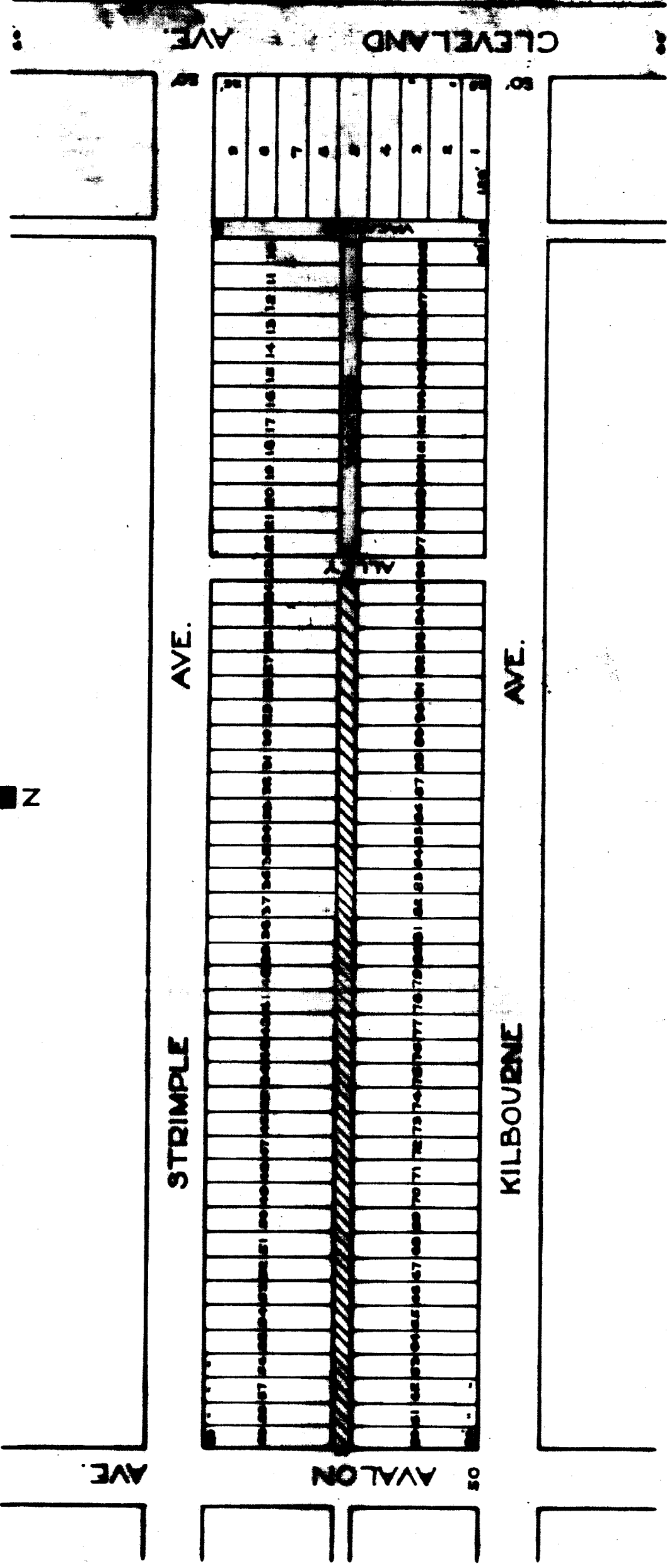

PRAYER OF PETITION TO VACATE ALLEY IN VILLA
PARK ADDITION, SHARON TOWNSHIP, GRANTED.

March 30, 1948

In the matter of the petition filed March 1, 1948, praying for the vacation of an alley in Villa Park Addition, Sharon Township, Mr. Matson offered the following preamble and resolution and moved the adoption of the same which was duly seconded by Mr. Lauderbaugh:

WHEREAS, On the 5th day of March, 1948, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, did, by resolution duly adopted direct the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio, to make a report in writing to this Board on or before 10 o'clock A.M. of Tuesday, March 30, 1948, relative to the petition for the vacation of an Alley in Villa Park Addition, Sharon Township; said report to be made in manner and form set forth and required by Section 6865 of the General Code of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Allan C. Slade, County Engineer, did on the 30th day of March 1948, report thereon in writing, which report contained the following recommendations, to-wit;

"Board of County Commissioners, Court House, Franklin County, Ohio,
Gentlemen: Pursuant to your order of March 5, 1948, I have made a survey and plat, which I hereby submit, of a certain alley in Villa Park Addition to the City of Columbus, Sharon Township, showing the proposed vacation of the said alley described as follows:

"Being the 15 foot alley south of Strimple Avenue and north of Kilbourne Ave. in Villa Park Addition, Sharon Township, beginning at the west line of a 20 foot alley (formerly lots numbered 23 and 96, dedicated and accepted for public use, see Commissioners Journal 27, page 163); thence westerly to the east line of Avalon Avenue and there to terminate."
